SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 4-1-1 in series play. Game 1: 5-2, Game 2: 3-3, Game 3: 4-1, Game 4: 0-0 Sweep Wins (1): at NYM (3g. 3/29-3/31) Sweep Losses (-): None

AT HOME: The Brewers are 4-4 at home, going 1-1-1 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 8-2 on the road, going 3-0-0 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23. replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made four replay challenges this season, going 4-0.....their last challenge came on 4/7 vs. Seattle as a caught stealing at second base involving Oliver Dunn was overturned.

### TODAY'S STARTER: #37 - LHP DL HALL (3gs, 0-1, 7.11)

HALL AT A GLANCE: DL Hall, 25, will make his fourth start of the season.....Hall last started last Saturday at Baltimore and received no decision in the Brewers' 11-5 victory (3.1ip, 8h, 5r, 5er, 1bb, 4k, 3hr, 1hbp, 75 pitches)....the team is 2-1 in his starts....he does not have a quality start....opponents are batting .386 (22-for-57, 4hr).....Hall was acquired from Baltimore, along with INF Joey Ortiz and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A selection, in exchange for RHP Corbin Burnes on Feb. 1.....Hall entered the season as the fifth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*....the initials "DL" stand for Dayton Lane.

LAST SEASON: Hall appeared in 18 games with Baltimore, all in relief, and went 3-0 with a 3.26 ERA during two stints (4/29 and 8/26-end of season).....he made his postseason debut in the 2023 American League Division Series against Texas and struck out 6 of the 12 batters he faced over 3.1 scoreless innings during 2 relief appearances.

**CAREER:** Is 4-1 with a 5.12 ERA and 1 save in 32 games/4 starts (45.2ip, 26er).....is in his third Major League season with Baltimore (2022-23) and Milwaukee (2024).....his only career start prior to this season came with the Orioles in his Major League debut on 8/13/22 at Tampa Bay in an 8-2 loss (3.2ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 6k).....Hall was selected by Baltimore in the first round (21st overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Valdosta (GA) High School.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Is 13-22 with a 3.49 ERA in 96 games/81 starts, all in the Orioles organization (2017-23).....has held opponents to a .198 batting average with 499 strikeouts in just 353.1 innings pitched.....Hall was selected to the 2019 All-Star Futures Game.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Hall made his first career appearance in Milwaukee on 4/6 vs. Seattle, taking a 5-3 loss (5.1ip, 8h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 5k).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in 16 games/3 starts (26.2ip, 16er).....is 0-0 with an 8.59 ERA in 2 starts this season (7.1ip, 7er).
