## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (12-15) SAN DIEGO PADRES (16-13)

May 3, 2021 at Petco Park, San Diego, CA -- GAME #28/ROAD #16

LHP TYLER ANDERSON (2-2, 3.38 ERA) vs. RHP MIGUEL DIAZ (0-0, 7.11 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** have lost four straight games after winning a season-high three in a row and four-of-five...Have gone 11-9 in their last 20 games after losing a season-high six in a row from 4/3-8...Were 8-19 after 27 games in 2020 (9-19 after 28).

**ROAD TRIP BEGINS:** Tonight marks the start of a six-game, seven-day road trip to San Diego and Chicago...After this series, the Bucs will spend a day off in Chicago Thursday before starting a three-game series at Wrigley Field Friday afternoon...The Pirates have gone 7-8 on the road this season, winning six of their last nine after going 1-5 in their first six.

**BUCS/FRIARS:** The Pirates and Padres split their four-game series in Pittsburgh April 12-15 and will wrap up their season series on Wednesday...Dating back to the 2015 season, the Bucs have gone 22-15 against the Friars.

**PIRATES AT PETCO:** The Bucs have won each of their last three games played in San Diego and six of their last eight...They won three of the four games played here during their last visit May 16-19, 2019, hitting seven home runs in the four games while posting a 3.09 ERA (35.0ip/12er).

**FOR THE DOGS:** In 14 career games at Petco Park, **Gregory Polanco** is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with four doubles, a triple, four homers and eight RBI...He has homered twice in his last four games played in San Diego and has reached base safely in all 12 of his starts here.

**BULLISH PEN:** Dating back to April 8, Pittsburgh's bullpen has posted the lowest ERA among National League teams (2.59) and the fourth-lowest in the Majors behind Seattle (1.49), Oakland (2.42) and Cleveland (2.50).

**TA ON THE BUMP:** **Tyler Anderson** has won his last two decisions and has posted a 2.20 ERA (16.1ip/4er) in his last three starts...In three career starts at Petco Park, Anderson has produced a 3.12 ERA (17.1ip/6er)...He won his last start here on 5/14/19 while pitching with the Rockies (5.2ip/3er) and tossed 6.0 scoreless frames on 4/5/18.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** With the minor league season scheduled to start Tuesday, the Pirates announced their minor league rosters on Saturday for their four full-season affiliates in Indianapolis, Altoona, Greensboro and Bradenton...Double-A Altoona features eight of Pittsburgh's top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, including **Oneil Cruz** (#4)...The Pirates entered the 2021 season with the eighth-best minor league system in all of baseball according to MLB Pipeline.

**ON A SERIES NOTE:** The Pirates have won each of their last three series played on the road, marking the first time since 2018 (3-0 in Cincinnati, 2-1 in Cleveland and 2-1 in Colorado) in which the Bucs have won three straight road series...Overall, the Pirates have gone 4-1-2 in their last seven series after dropping their first two.

**CAPTAIN REDBEARD:** **Colin Moran** leads the team in RBI (19) and shares the team lead in home runs (4)...His 18 RBI from the fourth spot of the lineup rank second behind Arizona's David Peralta (19) for the most among all MLB players and his 18 RBI as a first baseman are tied for second among N.L. players at that position...In addition, Moran is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with runners in scoring position and .462 (6-for-13) with RISP and two outs.

**HISTORY MAKER:** **Richard Rodríguez** has made seven straight hitless outings (8.0ip) and has surrendered just one hit overall in his first 11 appearances (11.1ip)...Rodríguez is the first pitcher in Pirates history to allow no more than one hit over his first 11 appearances of a season.

**HOT ROD:** Dating back to June 1, 2019, **Richard Rodríguez** has produced a 2.09 ERA (77.2ip/18er) in his 81 games - that is the lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances...Rodríguez has allowed just two baserunners (one hit and one walk) in his first nine outings this season (35 at bats) and has made 22 consecutive scoreless appearances (22.0ip) dating back to August 30 of last season.

**PEN PALS:** **David Bednar** has made eight straight scoreless appearances (6.2ip) and has been scored upon once in his first 11 outings...**Kyle Crick** has allowed one hit in his first 10 games (28 at bats) and **Sam Howard** has stranded all eight of his inherited runners this season.

**SHELTY'S CREW:** Manager **Derek Shelton** and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021...**Christian Marrero** has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include **Tarrik Brock** (First Base), **Joey Cora** (Third Base), **Rick Eckstein** (Hitting), **Don Kelly** (Bench), **Oscar Marin** (Pitching), **Justin Meccage** (Bullpen), **Mike Rabelo** (Field Coordinator) and **Glenn Sherlock**...Catching coaches **Herbie Andrade** and **Jordan Comadena** have returned.

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 3, 1999: Jason Kendall went 5-for-5 and Brian Giles hit two home runs, but Brant Brown proved to be the hero after his single with two outs in the ninth inning capped a four-run comeback over San Francisco closer Robb Nen for a 9-8 Pirates win at Three Rivers Stadium. Warren Morris' leadoff homer in the ninth began Pittsburgh's comeback before Brown's two-out single capped off the comeback.
