PITTSBURGH PIRATES (13-16) vs. SAN DIEGO PADRES (17-14)

May 5, 2021 at Petco Park, San Diego, CA -- GAME #30/ROAD #18

RHP JT BRUBAKER (2-2, 2.63 ERA) vs. RHP YU DARVISH (3-1, 2.13 ERA)

THE PIRATES...snapped their five-game losing streak with a 2-1 win Tuesday night in San Diego...Have lost five of their last six games after winning a season-high three in a row and four-of-five...Have gone 12-10 in their last 22 games after losing a season-high six in a row from 4/3-8...Were 9-20 after 29 games in 2020 (9-21 after 30).

WHAT'S BRU-ING: JT Brubaker is making his fourth road start of the season tonight...He has posted a 2.12 ERA (17.0ip/4er) in his first three road assignments, pitching a career-high 7.0 innings on 4/23 at Minnesota and winning a 6-1 decision on 4/16 at Milwaukee...Brubaker has not walked a batter in his last three starts (18.0ip) and has issued just one free pass in his last four outings (23.1ip)...At the plate, JT singled in his first career plate appearance on 4/5 at Cincinnati and he collected three RBI on 4/11 against the Cubs...He has gone 2-for-6 overall as a batter this season.

PERFECTO: Richard Rodríguez has retired each of the last 28 batters he has faced since giving up a single to Eric Hosmer at PNC Park on 4/12...He has allowed just two baserunners overall while posting a 0.16 WHIP in his 12 appearances.

OFF TO CHICAGO: Following the game tonight, the Pirates travel to Chicago for the start of a three-game series at Wrigley Field starting Friday afternoon (day off tomorrow)...It will mark Pittsburgh's third series of the season against the Cubs - the second in Chicago...The Bucs have gone 3-3 against the Cubs this season, winning two-of-three at PNC Park and losing two-of-three at Wrigley Field, where they have gone 2-15 in their last 17 games dating back to 9/26/18.

THE PRIDE OF POWAY: Bucco shortstop **Kevin Newman** is from nearby Poway, CA...He is a 2013 graduate of Poway High School, where was named the team MVP during his senior season...Entering today's action, Newman was one of just three MLB shortstops (min: 20 games) without an error this season (also San Francisco's Brandon Crawford and Miami's Miguel Rojas)...Newman has reached base safely in eight straight games.

CURRENT BUCS: The Pirates are 1-1 on this six-game, seven-day road trip after splitting the first two games in San Diego...Following a day off in Chicago Thursday, the trip concludes with a three-game series at Wrigley Field over the weekend...The Pirates have gone 8-9 on the road this season, winning seven of their last 11 after going 1-5 in their first six.

ON THE ROAD: The Pirates have gone 7-4 in their last 11 games played on the road while posting a 2.84 ERA (92.0ip/29er)...The starting pitchers have produced a 3.68 ERA (58.2ip/24er) while the bullpen has turned in a 1.35 ERA (33.1ip/5er).

BUCS/FRIARS: The Pirates and Padres have split the first six games of their season series which wraps up tonight...Dating back to the 2015 season, the Bucs have gone 23-16 against the Friars...The Bucs have won four of their last five games played in San Diego and seven of their last 10.

BULLISH PEN: Dating back to April 8, Pittsburgh's bullpen has posted the lowest ERA among National League teams (2.55) and the third-lowest in the Majors behind Seattle (1.91) and Oakland (2.41).

HISTORY IN THE MAKING: Richard Rodríguez has made eight straight hitless outings (9.0ip) and has surrendered just one hit overall in his first 12 appearances (12.1ip)...Rodríguez is the first pitcher in Pirates history to allow no more than one hit over his first 12 appearances of a season.

HOT ROD: Dating back to June 1, 2019, **Richard Rodríguez** has produced a 2.06 ERA (78.2ip/18er) in his 82 games - that is the lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances...Rodríguez has allowed just two baserunners (one hit and one walk) in his first nine outings this season (38 at bats) and has made 23 consecutive scoreless appearances (23.0ip) dating back to August 30 of last season.

PEN PALS: Kyle Crick has made eight straight hitless outings (7.2ip) and has allowed just one hit in his first 11 games (31 at bats) overall...**Sam Howard** has stranded all 10 of his inherited runners this season; he is only pitcher in MLB who has stranded all 10 or more of his inherited runners...**Clay Holmes** has stranded all five of his inherited runners and has been charged with one earned run in his last eight appearances (10.2ip).

SHELTY'S CREW: Manager **Derek Shelton** and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021...**Christian Marrero** has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include **Tarrick Brock** (First Base), **Joey Cora** (Third Base), **Rick Eckstein** (Hitting), **Don Kelly** (Bench), **Oscar Marin** (Pitching), **Justin Meccage** (Bullpen), **Mike Rabelo** (Field Coordinator) and **Glenn Sherlock**...Catching coaches **Herbie Andrade** and **Jordan Comadena** have returned.
