TODAY'S GAME: The Giants are set to face the Padres for the third game of this four-game series after winning the first two contests...the teams are in the midst of a stretch where they will go head-to-head in 10 of SF's last 19 games to end the regular season...SF has won a season-high nine straight and 11 of their last 12 games overall entering play today.

NATIONAL LEAGUE: The Giants' 95-50 current record puts them in contention for the best record by an NL team in the divisional era...their 95 wins through their first 145 games are second-most in the NL since 1969...the 1975 Reds and 1986 Mets each finished the year with 108 wins, which is the best mark for any NL team since 1969...the Giants would need to go 13-4 (.765) for the rest of the season to reach that total...SF has gone 13-4 or better over a 17-game stretch 13 times this year.

BEST IN THE BIGS: The Giants (95-50, .655) enter today with the best record in the Majors, just ahead of the Dodgers (93-53, .637)..the .655 winning percentage through 145 games is the club's best in the SF-era and the best by a Giants team since 1913, when they went 97-48 (.669) through their first 145 decisions.

ON CLOUD NINE: SF enters today with a nine-game winning streak, their longest since 2004, when they won 10 straight from May 20-31...the Giants have scored 77 runs during the streak, tied for second-most in any nine-game span since the franchise moved to San Francisco...the span trails only a stretch of 82 runs scored in nine consecutive games in 1993 (July 4-15).

SIX PACK: The Giants have scored at least six runs in each of their last nine games, their longest such streak in SF era...the nine games trail only a franchise-best 15 consecutive games done in 1929, the longest such streak in MLB history since at least 1901... the Giants became the first MLB team to score at least six runs in nine straight games since Houston did so in 2017 (May 28-June 6)...the last team to achieve a streak of 10 games or longer was

also Houston, when they scored six runs or more in 11 consecutive games in 2004 (Aug. 27-Sep. 7).

DE-FENSE: In addition to scoring at least six runs, the Giants have also held their opponents to fewer than six runs on each of their last nine games, becoming the first MLB team to score at least six runs while allowing fewer than six in nine straight games since the Yankees did it in 1939 (Stats, LLC).

LET'S START AGAIN: RHP Dominic Leone will serve as the opener today after starting the first game of this series just two days ago...he will be the first Giants pitcher to start twice in same series since Gaylord Perry did so in 1969 (July 3 and 6)... he is also the first Giant to start twice in a span of three days within the same series since **Bob Shaw**, when he took the mound on July 24 of 1965, and then did so again the next day...the last Giant to start two games in three days overall was **Rick Reuschel** (Aug. 30 and Sep. 1, 1987), and the last player in MLB to start twice in same series was Justin Bruihl, who started for the Dodgers on August 16 and 18 earlier this year (Elias).

ROBERTO CLEMENTE: Today is Roberto Clemente Day, where Major League Baseball honors the life of late Roberto Clemente by recognizing the players with philanthropic and humanitarian efforts...MLB has announced the nominees for baseball's most prestigious recognition, and the Giant nominated was shortstop and 3x All-Star **IF Brandon Crawford**... Quality Assurance Coach **Nick Ortiz**, a Cidra, Puerto Rico native will wear Clemente's No. 21 today to honor the legacy of the first Latino-American Hall of Famer...today also marks the start of Hispanic Heritage Month.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

RHP Joe Musgrove faces the Giants for the fifth time in his career and third time this season... he is 1-3 with a 5.14 ERA in the four outings overall and has received the loss in both starts vs SF this year, allowing a combined 10 runs over 10.0 innings (8.10 ERA) ...the 28-year-old is 10-9 with a 2.93 ERA in 28 games this season, with his ERA currently ranking 11th-best in MLB... Musgrove has five wins over his last nine starts, posting a 2.56 ERA with 61 strikeouts in the stretch (9.75K/9ip).

RHP Dominic Leone takes the mound for just his fourth career start and second in the last three days...the right-hander started SF's last bullpen game on Monday, tossing $2.0\,\mathrm{scoreless}$ innings with a hit and a strikeout...Leone has thrown $5.0\,\mathrm{scoreless}$ innings in three starts overall, allowing just one hit (.063) with three strikeouts...he is 3-3 with a 1.41 ERA in 46 appearances for the Giants this year.

#48 JOSE ALVAREZ > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider, Sinker, Cutter **Last Game:** 9/13 vs. SD; 1.0ip, 1h, 2so (15 pitches)

- Last 26 appearances: 2-1, 1.03 ERA (3er, 26.1ip), .151 BAA
- Hasn't allowed a run in 38 of his last 42 outings dating to May 23.
- Since June 1, he owns a 1.35 ERA (6er, 40.0ip) with 23 strikeouts and a .151 BAAin 39 games...the 1.35 ERA is second lowest in MLB (min. 32g) in that time...NYM's Aaron Loup is first (0.47 ERA)
- ▶ Has also not allowed a homer in his last 40.0 innings dating to June ...the last homer he allowed was to Albert Pujols on May 29 at LAD.
- His 0.33 HR/9ip ratio is the tenth-best among qualified NL relievers.
- ▶ Has stranded 25 of his 32 inherited runners this season (78.1%)... his 21.88% of inherited runners scored is tied for the sixth-lowest in the NL (min. 25 inherited runners)
- ▶ Batters are 17-for-99 (.172) off his sinker.

#76 KERVIN CASTRO ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-seam FB, Curveball, Changeup Last Game: 9/13 vs. SD; 2.0ip, 2h, 2so (36 pitches)

- ▶ Made his Major League Debut Sept. 7 at Colorado...pitched 2.0-scoreless innings and held hitters to two hits with a strikeout
- Recalled from Triple-A on 9/6 ...first name is pronounced kerr-VEEN.
- ▶ Went 6-1 with a 2.86 ERA in 30 relief outings for the River Cats struck out 60 batters in 44.0 innings while holding hitters to a .197 clip.
- Since August 1, he had a 0.82 ERA (1er, 11.0ip) with seven hits allowed, four walks and 16 strikeouts in eight MiLB appearances.
- Added to SF's 40-man roster this past offseason and had never pitched above Short-Season prior to this season when he was used as a starter in 2019 with Salem-Keizer.
- ▶ At 22 years old, he's the youngest player on the Giants active roster.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-seam FB, Slider **Last Game:** 9/14 vs. SD; 1.0ip, 2so (16 pitches)

- Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on 9/5, his fourth recall of 2021....has worked 3.2 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts in four games since being recalled.

- Last five apps w/SF dating to 8/12: 5.2ip, 3h, 0r, 2bb, 11so.

 Is 2-1 with a 4.96 ERA in 18 games for SF this season.

 Was 3-0 with a 4.99 ERA (17er, 30.2ip) along with 44 strikeouts and 24 walks allowed in 28 games for the River Cats
- ▶ Pitched to a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks over his last nine Triple-A appearances dating to July 27.

#66 JARLÍN GARCÍA > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Changeup, Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider **Last Game:** 9/13 vs. SD; 1.1ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 1so (23 pitches)

- Has walked five batters since July 2 (26 games, 33.2ip)Held LHB to nine hits in their last 76 ABs (.118) dating to May 22.
- ► Hitters are just 9-for-48 (.188) with 17Ks off his slider this season. ► Hitters are 7-for-55 (.127) in at-bats ending in his changeup.
- ▶ Has struck out a career-best 65 batters in 61.1 innings...owns a 27.5% strikeout rate, by far the highest of his career (last year was his best year at 19.2%)
- Stranded 11-of-20 inherited runners this season (55.0%).

#65 JAY JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Four-Seam FB, Changeup **Last Game:** 9/10 at CHC; 1.0ip, 1bb (11 pitches)

- Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on September 10 when LHP Jose Quintana went on the Paternity List, marked his third recall of the season.
- Last 11 outings as a reliever: 0-0, 0.90 ERA (1er, 10.0ip), 4bb, 14so.
- ▶ Opened a game for SF on 9/4 vs. LA and allowed three runs in 0.1 ip. ▶ Has registered 26 strikeouts in 18.2 innings (12.54 SO/9)
- ▶ Is holding LHBs to a .160 clip and RHBs to a .220 figure.
- Stranded 10-of-13 inherited runners (76.9%).
- Selected from Triple-A Sacramento on July 16 and made his first MLB appearance since Sept. 27, 2019 on the same night.

#52 DOMINIC LEONE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Four-Seam FB, Sinker **Last Game:** 9/13 vs. SD: 2.0ip, 1h, 1so (18 pitches)

- Is scheduled to start tonight's bullpen game vs. San Diego...has started SF's last three bullpen games (last Friday at Chicago, September 5 vs. Los Angeles-NL and Monday night vs. San Diego)...has worked 5.0 innings allowing one hit with three strikeouts in those outings.
- Has a 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip) and .216 avg. against in his past 15g.
- Has walked 10 in his last 20 outings...walked 10 in his first 26.
- Batters are 26-for-154 (.169) off him.
- Batters have just three hits in 48 at-bats (.063) ending with his slider.
- ▶ Holding opponents to a .114 clip (4-for-35) with RISP.

#46 ZACK LITTELL > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-seam FB, Slider, Splitfinger Last Game: 9/13 vs. SD; W, 1.2ip, 2so (17 pitches)

- Was recalled from Triple-A on 8/7 and has not allowed an earned run in 12 of his 15 outings since...is 3-0-2 with a 1.35 ERA (3er, 20.0ip) with six hits allowed and 23 K since rejoining the Giants.
- Has held opponents scoreless in 41 of 53 outings
- Stranded 12-of-16 inherited runners this season (75%)
- Has used his four-seam fastball 55.4% of the time...opponents are 16-for-99 (.162) with 38 strikeouts.

#17 JAKE McGEE > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB , Slider **Last Game:** 9/12 at CHC; SV, 1.0ip, 1h (12 pitches)

- His 31 saves are a career-high and are tied for fifth-most in MLB.
- Is just the second Giants left-handed pitcher to record 30-or-more saves in a season since 1969 when saves became an official stat (also: Will Smith in 2019 with 34 saves)
- Last 10 outings: 6/8 in Save Opps, 2.70 ERA (3er, 10.0ip)
- LHB are 13-for-66 (.197) off him, while RHB are 31x158 (.196)
- Before he takes the mound he looks at the inside his hat where he has written inside: "Feel the ball. Take a Breath. Pound the zone." Plus the names of his wife, Morgan, and daughter, Rowen.
