## WASHINGTON NATIONALS (7-11) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (7-12)

### April 17, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 12:35 EDT - Game #20/Home #10

#### RHP Trevor Williams (1-1, 7.36 ERA) vs. LHP Andrew Heaney (0-1, 3.00 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** won the third game of their four-game series against Washington with a 6-1 victory here at PNC Park on Wednesday night...Have a chance to secure their second series victory of the season with a win this afternoon (won two of three vs. St. Louis from April 7-9)...Will welcome Cleveland to town for a three-game series this weekend...Are in a stretch of 13 out of 16 games being played at PNC Park (were swept in a three-game series at Cincinnati last weekend).

**HEY 1900:** Today's game will be the 1900th regular-season game played here at PNC Park...The ballpark hosted the Reds on April 9, 2001, in the first regular-season game...Tomorrow night, three of the top-four home run hitters in the ballpark's history will be at PNC Park, when 2004 National League Rookie of the Year Jason Bay is on hand to honor Paul Skenes, who took home BBWAA N.L. Rookie of the Year honors last season...Bay ranks third in stadium history with 61 home runs...Andrew McCutchen is the all-time leader in home runs at PNC Park with 107, followed by Pedro Alvarez (62)...Bryan Reynolds ranks fourth on the list with 57.

**TURNPIKE SERIES:** Following this afternoon's contest, the Pirates will welcome the Guardians to town for a three-game series...Pittsburgh is 14-10 all-time against Cleveland here at PNC Park and has won six of the eight all-time series played in this stadium.

**IN GRAND STYLE:** Oneil Cruz capped off Pittsburgh's five-run seventh inning in Wednesday's 6-1 victory with a grand slam off Eduardo Salazar...It was the first grand slam of Cruz' career and the first by any Pirate since Joey Bart on July 9, 2024, at Milwaukee...It was also Cruz' second time recording four RBI in a game...He also did that on June 20, 2022, vs. Chicago (NL) here at PNC Park.

**SUPER SOUTHPAW:** Bailey Falter tossed 7.0 scoreless innings while surrendering just two hits and one walk in Wednesday's 6-1 win over Washington...It marked the first-such start of Falter's career, the first-such start by a Pirates pitcher since Paul Skenes on July 11, 2024, at Milwaukee, and the first-such start by a Pirates left-handed pitcher since Jeff Locke on July 4, 2015, vs. Cleveland.

**HEY, HENRY:** Henry Davis hit his first home run of the season and first since June 12, 2024, at St. Louis with his solo shot off Mitchell Parker on Wednesday...Davis has hit safely in three straight games...He also drove in a run with a groundout that scored Isiah-Kiner Falefa...It was his first multi-RBI game since April 12, 2024, at Philadelphia.

**HUNT THE GOOD:** Double-A Altoona's Hunter Barco extended his scoreless streak to begin the 2025 season to 13.0 innings after tossing 5.0 innings of one-hit baseball (one walk and six strikeouts) in the Curve's 10-1 win vs. Somerset on Wednesday...Barco is one of only seven qualified pitchers at the Double-A level with a 0.00 ERA coming into today...Barco is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 7 prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.

**DE-PEN-DABLE:** Pittsburgh's 3.31 ERA (68.0ip/25er) from its bullpen ranks fifth in the National League and ninth in all of Major League Baseball...The Pirates' 1.07 ERA (25.1ip/3er) from the bullpen in their last eight contests (since April 8) ranks first in MLB...Pittsburgh has four relievers with 8.0-plus innings and sub-2.20 ERAs (Caleb Ferguson at 0.90, Joey Wentz at 0.93, Justin Lawrence at 1.04, Dennis Santana at 2.16).

**DIFFERENT WAYS TO WIN:** Pittsburgh defeated Washington on Wednesday while only striking out three Nationals...It marked the Pirates' first time winning a 9.0-inning contest while striking out no more than three batters since also doing just that in a 7-2 victory on August 21, 2020, vs. Milwaukee.

**LEAN ON THE LEFTIES:** Eight of Pittsburgh's 9.0 innings (Falter 7.0, Ferguson 1.0) in Wednesday's 6-1 win over Washington came from left-handed pitchers...The Pirates' 75.1 innings pitched from left-handed pitchers so far in 2025 are second-most in all of Major League Baseball (Cubs, 80.2), while the 61 strikeouts are the eighth-most in MLB (the Nationals rank seventh with 64).

**KEEPING UP WITH CATCH:** Andrew McCutchen enters today two at-bats shy of tying Tommy Leach (5913) for ninth on the Pirates' all-time at-bats list...His 7913 career at-bats are the most at-bats among all active Major Leaguers.

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 17, 1991: John Smiley tossed the second one-hitter of his career, striking out four and not issuing any walks, as the Pirates beat the Mets, 4-0, at Three Rivers Stadium. The Pirates held a 1-0 lead heading into the bottom of the seventh inning before Jeff King's two-run home run off New York's Ron Darling highlighted a three-run seventh inning that put the game out of reach.

HOW ACQUIRED: Signed as a free agent (one-year contract) on February 22, 2025.

**STARTING OFF:** The 33-year-old southpaw is in his 12th Major League season...He signed a one-year contract with the Pirates on February 22 after spending each of the previous two years with the Texas Rangers...Was the Angels’ nominee in both 2018 and 2019 for the distinguished Roberto Clemente Award for his community involvement.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Heaney suffered his first loss of the season after allowing four runs on three hits over 6.0 innings on Saturday at Great American Ball Park against the Reds... All four of those runs were surrendered on a third-inning grand slam to Elly De La Cruz.

**VS. WASHINGTON:** Heaney will make his sixth career appearance (fifth start) against the Nationals...He last faced Washington on May 1, 2024, as a member of the Rangers, suffering a 1-0 loss after allowing one run on four hits with four strikeouts in 7.0 innings...Heaney has a 0.64 ERA (14.0ip/1er) and 10 strikeouts in three career home outings (two starts) against the Nationals, and a 14.14 ERA (7.0ip/11er) on the road.

**RIGHT AT HOME:** In his last home outing on April 6 vs. New York (AL), Heaney pitched in PNC Park for the first time in his career...He struck out 10 Yankees and allowed only one run over 7.0 innings (his 21st career game with 10-plus strikeouts)...With that start, he became the first Pirates left-handed pitcher to toss 7.0-plus innings and strikeout 10-plus batters while allowing one run or fewer since Francisco Liriano struck out 12 batters and didn’t allow a run over 8.0 innings on June 15, 2015 vs. Chicago (AL).

**WHERE HE RANKS:** Heaney’s 18 strikeouts and 18.0 innings entering today's game rank tied for 10th and 13th, respectively, among National League left-handed pitchers.

**ON POINT:** Over 1032.1 innings pitched in his career, Heaney has averaged 3.59 strikeouts for every walk issued...Since 1901, that is the seventh-best K/BB ratio among Major League lefties (min. 1000.0ip), behind Chris Sale (5.31), Clayton Kershaw (4.38), Hyun Jin Ryu (3.96), Cliff Lee (3.93), Madison Bumgarner (3.81) and David Price (3.69).

**FOUR YOUR INFO:** Heaney is one of four Major League left-handed pitchers to record 150-plus strikeouts in each of the last two seasons, along with Yusei Kikuchi, Framber Valdez and MacKenzie Gore...He is also one of five lefties to throw 145.0-plus innings in each of the last two years, along with Valdez, Kikuchi, Patrick Corbin and JP Sears.

**THIS AND THAT:** Heaney has 21 career outings with 10-plus strikeouts, the sixth-most among all active Major League southpaws...The only ones with more are Chris Sale (87), Clayton Kershaw (68), Robbie Ray (40), Blake Snell (35) and Carlos Rodón (26).

**SIGN HERE, PLEASE:** Heaney signed a one-year contract with the Pirates on February 22...He posted a 5-14 record, 4.28 ERA (160.0ip/76er) and 159 strikeouts in 32 games (31 starts) with Texas in 2024...Heaney’s 159 strikeouts and 160.0 innings pitched both ranked second on the Rangers, trailing Nathan Eovaldi (166 strikeouts & 70.2 innings).

**WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS:** Heaney spent the 2023 campaign as a member of the World-Champion Rangers, where he posted a career-high 10 wins...His 9.22 strikeouts per 9.0 innings figure was the highest ever by a left-handed Texas starting pitcher in a season (min. 15 starts)...He finished the year 13th among American League pitchers (min. 140.0ip) in Ks/9.0 innings (9.22) and 19th in strikeout percentage (23.6 percent).
