#### TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs Luke Henne's Pirates and the fifth game (4-0) of the season's final homestand, which includes a 4-game series sweep over the Cubs (Thu-Sun).
- The Reds are in the midst of their fourth season-high 5-game winning streak...it's their first 5-game run since June (6/6-6/10).
- Haven't won 6 straight games since their 7-game winning streak from 6/2-6/8, 2024 (at Chc, at Col, vs Chc).
- Following Thu's game vs Pit, the Reds will put a bow on the regular season with a 3-game series vs the Brewers at American Family Field.

TAKE A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: With Sun's 1-0 victory over the Cubs paired with the Mets' 3-2 loss vs Wsh, the Redlegs have moved into a tie for the NL's final Wild Card spot with 6 regular season games remaining...Cin owns the head-to-head tiebreaker over NYM, having won the season series (4-2).

- The Reds, Mets, Diamondbacks (-1.0), Giants (-3.5), Cardinals (-3.5), and Marlins (-4.0) enter today's games vying for the National League's final Wild Card spot.
- After the All-Star break, Cin got to within a half-game of that last spot on 8/22 before losing 10 of 13 and falling 6.0 games off the pace.
- Had been "the first team out" until they were leapfrogged in the Wild Card standings by both SF and AZ during a 3-11 run.
- Since the 5-4 loss vs NYM on 9/5 (Cin had the bases loaded with no outs in the 9th inning), the Reds have gone 10-5 to tie the Mets, who are 4-11 over that same span.

MATCHSTICK MEN: The Reds (4-4) have played in a Major League-most 8 games this season decided by a 1-0 score.

- For the Reds, 4 of those 8 came within the first 12 games of the season.
- Won 2 games decided by a 1-0 score during the recently-completed 4-game sweep of the Cubs (Thu & Sun)...marked the first time Cin won multiple 1-0 games in a single series since 9/24 & 9/26, 2002 at Chc.
- Dropped 3 straight games by a 1-0 score from 4/1-4/3.
- Cin's eight 1-0 games this season are the most since 2014 (10).

HEART & HUSTLE: CF TJ FriedI has been recognized as the Reds' 2025 recipient of the annual Heart & Hustle Award.

- FriedI will represent the Reds for the second time (2024) as a finalist for the overall Heart & Hustle Award which will be presented by the MLBPA in New York this coming November.
- 2025 marks the 20th year for the Heart & Hustle Award, which is presented to active players who "exemplify a true passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and tradition of the game.
- The award is voted on by former players/committee of team's alumni.

REMEMBERING THE COBRA: During tonight's pregame ceremonies the Reds will honor the life and career of Hall of Famer Dave Parker, who passed away in June after a 13-year battle with Parkinson's disease

SERIES NOTES: In the last meeting between the Reds and Pirates, the division rivals split a 4-game series at PNC Park from 8/7-8/10...Cin lost 2 of 3 at Pit from 5/19-5/21 but swept the Pirates in 3 games at Great American Ball Park in their first meeting (4/11-4/13)...it was Cin's first sweep of Pit since 8/5-8/8, 2021 at GABP (4q).

- Cin has played the **Pirates** 505 times since both teams became charter members of the National League Central in 1994 (263-242, .521). more than any other Pit opponent.
- Cin owns a 105-85 record all-time vs Pit at Great American Ball Park... the Reds and Pirates played the first regular-season game at GABP on 3/31/03 (10-1 Pirates triumph).
- The 2-0 loss at Pit on 4/23/23 was the Reds' 100th loss at PNC Park... are 98-109 overall there...the Reds and Pirates played the first regularseason game at PNC Park on 4/9/01 (8-2 Reds triumph).
- The Redlegs have lost 45 of the last 66 and 14 of the last 21 games they've played at PNC Park, including an 11-game losing streak spanning 9/3/18 to 9/27/19 and an 8-game losing streak to begin the 2019 season (4/4-9/27, 2019).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the 6-2 win on 9/17 at StL (5.2ip, 3h, 2r/1er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 97TP).

- His 6th-inning strikeout of Alec Burleson marked the 800th of his career.
- Snapped a streak of 6 consecutive quality starts.
- His career-high 14th win is the most by a Reds pitcher since RHP Luis Castillo won 15 games in 2019.

**SEPTEMBER 12 at STL:** Suffered the 3-0 loss on 9/12 at Ath (6.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr, 90TP).

- Allowed a home run to the first batter he faced, Lawrence Butler, to end his homereless-innings streak at 32.2.
- Was his sixth-straight quality start, extending his career-high streak...is the longest quality-starts streak by a Reds pitcher this season (also: RHP Nick Martinez posted 6 consecutive QS from 4/28-5/26)...the last Reds pitcher to produce 7 straight quality starts was RHP Hunter Greene, who did it last year from 7/6-8/13.

**SEPTEMBER 6 vs NYM:** Earned the 6-3 win on 9/6 vs NYM (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 4bb, 5k, 0hr, 99TP).

- Was his fifth-straight quality start, the longest-such streak
   of his career.
- Extended his single-season career high with his 13th win.
- Extended his homerless innings streak to 32.2ip.
- Was his third straight start in which he held opponent to 3 or fewer hard-hit balls (balls-in-play at or above 95mph).

**AUGUST 31 vs STL:** Earned the 6-1 win on 8/31 vs StL (6.0ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 0bb, 8k, 102TP).

• Was his fourth-straight quality start, matching a career high for the fourth time (most recently: 9/5/22-9/23/22).

**AUGUST 24 at AZ:** Did not factor in the decision in the 6-1 win on 8/24 at AZ (6.0ip, 1h, 1r/1er, 3bb, 9k, 95TP).

- It marked the second time this season in which he pitched as many as 6.0 innings and allowed no more than 1 hit (also: 3/31 vs Tex, 7.0ip, 1h).
- Was his third straight quality start...is his longest quality start streak of the season and his longest since 7/20-7/31, 2024 for KC (3 straight qs).
- Retired his last 10 consecutive batters.
- Was his third-straight outing in which he didn't allow a home run...was his 12th homerless app of the season.

**AUGUST 18 at LAA:** Earned the 4-1 win at LAA on 8/18 (6.0ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 1bb, 4k, 88TP).

- Was his second straight quality start, his third over his last 4 apps, and his fifth over his last 7 apps.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 16 of his 23 batters.

**AUGUST 12 vs PHI:** Earned the 6-1 win vs Phi on 8/12 (6.0ip, 3h, 0r, 0bb, 6k, 71TP).

- Was perfect before allowing a leadoff single in the 5th inning to Nick Castellanos...at 4.0ip, marked the second-longest perfect game bid of his career (4.2ip, 8/14/23 vs Sea).
- Matched his career high with his 10th win (also 10w in 2022).
- Is the first Reds pitcher with 10 wins through his first 24 games with the team since Mat Latos (10, 2012).
- Was the second time over his last 3 starts in which he produced 6.0 scoreless innings (also 8/1 vs Atl).
- Over his last 2 home apps, has fanned 16 over 12.0 scoreless innings...became the seventh Reds pitcher since 1900 with at least 16k and 0r in any single-season span of 2 home starts (last: Nick Lodolo, 2022).
- Was his 10th quality start of the season, the 59th of his career.

AUGUST 7 at PIT: Opposed Paul Skenes and suffered the 7-0 loss at Pit on 8/7 (3.2ip, 6h, 4r/4er, 4bb, 2k, 1hr, 86TP).

• Threw 36 pitches in the 1st inning, 9 pitches in the 2nd inning, 20 pitches in the 3rd inning, and 21 pitches in the 4th inning before he was lifted for reliever Sam Moll.
