**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**APRIL 24**  
**1965 - 3B Bob Aspromonte** hits the Astros first regular season home run in the Astrodome in the club's 5-0 victory over the Pirates...it comes in the club's third home game at their beautiful new ballpark...**CF Jimmy Wynn** also homers...**RHP Turk Farrell** tosses a complete game shutout, blanking the Pirates on seven hits and a walk.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros will welcome in the rival Yankees tonight for the first game of a three-game weekend series at Daikin Park...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (1-1), who's facing the Yankees for the first time since Game 4 of the 2022 ALCS, will get tonight's series-opening start for the Astros opposite **RHP Will Warren** (2-0).

**MCCULLERS VS. THE YANKS:** **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** has a rich history against the Yankees, a team that his father, **Lance Sr.**, pitched for in the 1989-90 seasons...some of McCullers' on-field history against the Yankees:

- McCullers is 2-0 with a 2.78 ERA (14ER/45.1IP) in eight career games (seven starts) against the Yankees, which includes postseason action (3g).
- he last faced the Yankees in Game 4 of the 2022 ALCS (3ER/5IP), which was won by the Astros 6-5, giving Houston a four-game series sweep.
- notably, McCullers holds the distinction of earning the save in Game 7 of the 2017 ALCS, an appearance in which he tossed 4.0 scoreless innings, finishing off the Yankees with 24 consecutive curveballs to end that outing and the series.

**RIVALRY RENEWED:** The Astros went 3-3 against the Yankees in 2025, but have had their struggles vs. the Yankees since the start of the 2023 season, going 6-14 in their regular season matchups, including a 1-9 record at home...in the postseason, the Astros and Yankees have played 18 games against each other since 2015, the most playoff games between any two teams in that span, with the Astros going 13-5 in those games with wins in all four postseason series (2015 WC; 2017 ALCS; 2019 ALCS; 2022 ALCS).

**ON THE OFFENSIVE:** The Astros lead the AL in most key offensive categories, including runs (137), batting average (.259), OBP (.349), SLG (.434), OPS (.783), hits (229), doubles (59) and total bases (383)...the Yankees rank second to the Astros in SLG (.408) and OPS (.730).

**ON THE RADIO:** Due to a scheduling overlap with the Houston Rockets, tonight's Astros radio broadcast can be heard on **KTRH 740 AM**...the popular combination of **Robert Ford** and **Steve Sparks** will be on the radio call tonight.

**WINDAY IN CLEVELAND:** The Astros won the rubber game of their three-game series in Cleveland on Wednesday with a 2-0 shutout victory...**RHP Peter Lambert** (0ER/6IP) was great in his start, before giving way to a lockdown bullpen...**DH Yordan Alvarez** provided all the Astros offense, as he connected for his 11th homer of the season, a two-run shot in the 1st inning.

**ROA CLAIMED:** Announced yesterday, **RHP Christian Roa** was claimed off waivers by the Twins...Roa, who was on the Astros Opening Day roster, was designated for assignment on Tuesday.

**MINOR LEAGUE UPDATE:** Prospect **OF Zach Cole** began a minor league rehab assignment last night at Class A Fayetteville, going 0x3 with a walk in a start at DH...Cole is currently on the minor league IL with a fifth toe fracture on his right foot.

**FROM THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** The Astros have 16 players on the Major League Injured List...updates on each:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) continues his bullpen progression in West Palm Beach.
- **RHP Cody Bolton** (rt. mid-back inflammation) tossed 2.0 innings and approx. 30 pitches in a live BP session on Tuesday...he is scheduled to throw a bullpen today.
- **RHP Hunter Brown** (rt. shoulder sprain) began his throwing program on Tuesday in Houston, playing catch from approx. 75 feet.
- **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (rt. arm fatigue) threw a bullpen on Monday in Houston, his first bullpen since going on the IL...he is scheduled to throw a bullpen today.
- **RHP Cristian Javier** (rt. shoulder strain) is currently preparing to commence a throwing progression.
- **LHP Josh Hader** (lt. biceps tendinitis) threw his second live BP on Tuesday, tossing approx. 17 pitches... he is scheduled to throw another live BP on Saturday.
- **RHP Nate Pearson** (rt. elbow surgery) began a rehab assignment last night for Triple A Sugar Land, working 2.0+ innings on 53 pitches.
- **LHP Bennett Sousa** (lt. oblique strain) was scheduled to pitch Tuesday and Wednesday at Triple A Sugar Land, but both games were rained out...he instead threw bullpens on both days.
- **LHP Brandon Walter** (lt. elbow surgery) began a throwing progression this week in West Palm Beach.
- **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) continues his bullpen progression in West Palm Beach.
- **IF Nick Allen** (mid-back spasms) and **OF Taylor Trammell** (left groin strain) are rehabbing in Houston, focusing on rehabilitation exercises.
- **OF Zach Dezenzo** (rt. elbow sprain) had his rehab assignment transferred to Triple A Sugar Land on Tuesday...he went 0x3, with a walk in a start at DH in his first game with the Space Cowboys last night.
- **OF Joey Loperfido** (rt. quad strain) has begun light baseball activity as he prepares to commence a running progression.
- **OF Jake Meyers** (rt. oblique strain) has begun light baseball activity.
- **SS Jeremy Peña** (rt. hamstring strain) started baseball activities and a running progression this week.

**THE ORDER:** The Astros have used 26 different batting orders in their 26 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

**STALKING THE PUMA:** **LF Yordan Alvarez** has matched the Astros franchise record with 11 home runs in the club's first 26 games of a season, also reached one other time, by **OF Lance Berkman** in 2002...should Alvarez homer tonight, he would be the first player in franchise history to hit 12 homers within the club's first 27 games.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING!:** **LF Yordan Alvarez** is on an active nine-game hitting streak in which he's hit .385 (15x39) with five homers, 12 RBI and a 1.300 OPS...Alvarez's streak is the longest active streak in the AL and the longest by an Astro this season.

**TUVE'S 2000:** Pregame tonight, the Astros will recognize **2B Jose Altuve** for playing in his 2,000th career game on Tuesday...Altuve joined **Craig Biggio** (2,850) and **Jeff Bagwell** (2,150) as the only players in club history to reach 2,000 games.

**LAST START, 4/18 vs. STL:** In his 4th start of the year, allowed 4 runs on 5 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts (91 pitches-58 strikes)...suffered his first loss of the season in a 7-5 Astros defeat.

**VS. THE YANKS:** including the postseason, holds a 2.78 ERA (14ER/45.1IP) in 8G/7GS vs. the Yankees in his career...will be facing the Yankees for the first time since an ALCS start on October 23, 2022, when he gave up 4 runs (3 ER) on 8 hits through 5.0 IP with a walk and 6 strikeouts; the Astros would rally back to clinch a World Series berth...his most memorable appearance against the Yankees came in Game 7 of the 2017 ALCS, when he pitched in 4.0 shutout innings in relief, allowing 1 hit and a walk with 6 strikeouts, earning the save...closed out the game with 24 consecutive curveballs, retiring the final 6 batters he faced...was the 7th save of at least 4.0 scoreless innings in postseason history...since 2015, McCullers' regular + postseason ERA of 2.78 ranks 8th among active pitchers (min. 45 IP).

**CUT ABOVE:** Has thrown his cutter at a 29.1-percent rate, the highest of any of his pitches this season...per Baseball Savant, he only began to throw a cutter last season and threw it at a 4.5-percent rate.

**APPROACHING 800:** enters tonight start with 794.1 innings pitched...he's looking to become the 25th player in Astros history to reach 800 career innings with the club, and the 1st to do so since **LHP Framer Valdez**.

**SEASON DEBUT:** had a spectacular debut to his 2026 season, striking out 9 over 7.0 innings while allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk (96 pitches-63 strikes) on March 30 vs. LAA...was his longest start since also tossing 7.0 innings on Sept. 21, 2022 at TB...was his longest start while allowing 1-or-fewer runs since allowing 1 run through 7.0 innings on July 16, 2021 at CWS...was his longest start in a season debut in his 9-year MLB career and were his most strikeouts in a season debut since striking out 10 batters on March 31, 2018 at TEX...is also the longest start by an Astro and tied for the 7th-longest start by an AL pitcher this season.

**2025 RECAP:** made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.

**GROUNDLED:** is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.1 ground-ball percentage ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP Framer Valdez** (62.2%) and **RHP Logan Webb** (58.0%).

**ABOUT MCCULLERS JR.:** the 2017 All-Star has made 150 apps. (144 starts) in 9 MLB seasons with Houston (2015-18, 2020-22, 2025-26), posting a 52-38 record with a 3.76 ERA (332ER/794.1IP) and 882 strikeouts (9.99 SO/9IP)...missed the 2019 and 2023-24 seasons due to injury.
