ROAD WARRIORS

The Washington Nationals take on the Miami Marlins tonight in game two of this three game set from loanDepot park today...Washington defeated the Marlins, 3-2, last night with all the offense for both teams coming in the first inning.

- **Jacob Young** hit his third home run of the year, matching his career high for homers in a season through just 37 games in 2026...**CJ Abrams** delivered an RBI-single in the first inning.
- **Foster Griffin** struck out a career high nine and spun 7.0 innings of two-run ball (one earned run) to earn his fourth win of the season...**Brad Lord** (Hold, 1.2 IP, H, 2 SO) and **PJ Poulin** (Save, 0.1 IP, BB) nailed down the victory.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals have won three straight, four of five and 8 of 12 games since April 25.

- With a win today, the Nationals would secure their fourth series win out of their last five...It would also be Washington's first series win in Miami since they took three straight in South Florida from 2023-2024.
- A win today would also give us our first four-game winning streak since Sept. 6-9, 2025.

ROAD SWEET ROAD

The Nationals come into tonight's game with a 13-7 record on the road, tied for the second-highest win total away from home in Major League Baseball, trailing only the Atlanta Braves (14 wins)...Washington has taken at least a share of five of their first six series away from home, including four straight.

- The Nationals rank fourth in MLB (third in NL) with 108 runs scored on the road.
- Washington's pitching staff is seventh in MLB (fifth in NL) with a .230 opponents batting average away from Nationals Park.

PITCH PERFECT

Simon Mathews' pitching staff ranks third in the National League (4th in MLB) with a 2.92 ERA in 13 games since April 24...The staff has pitched to a 3.73 ERA in 23 games since April 14 after entering play that day with a 6.21 ERA through the first 15 games of the season...Since April 25, the staff has surrendered just eight home runs, tied for third-fewest in Major League Baseball over this span (0.66 HR/9.0 IP).

- The starters rank second in the National League (3rd in MLB) with a 3.18 ERA since April 24.
- The bullpen has pitched to a 2.05 ERA in 11 games since April 26, the third-best mark in the National League.

SPECIFICALLY...

Some pitching performances of note include:

- **Foster Griffin** ranks third in the National League with a 2.12 ERA...His ERA is the third lowest by a Nationals pitcher (2005-pres.) through his first eight starts with the team, trailing only **Max Scherzer** (1.75 in 2015) and **Stephen Strasburg** (2.03 in 2010).
- **Cade Cavalli** ranks seventh in the NL (min. 30.0 IP) with 10.38 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- **Richard Lovelady** has offered scoreless relief in his last seven games (6.2 IP), going 1-0 with a save, three holds, seven strikeouts and just five hits allowed.
- Left-handed batters are 3-for-22 (.136) with zero extra-base hits against **Mitchell Parker** this season.
- **PJ Poulin** has been The Opener five times...He's allowed just one earned run on five hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.
- Over his last 10 games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) with three holds, four saves, 11 strikeouts and one walk.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams is 13-for-37 (.351) with three doubles, two homers, 13 RBI, five walks, two stolen bases and seven runs scored over his last 10 games...He's reached safely in eight of the 10 (.429 OBP) and has hits in seven of the 10.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (T1st, 34), on-base percentage (5th, .394) and OPS (6th, .931).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank fourth in Major League Baseball (3rd in NL) with 208 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 36 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 78 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 23 times this season, second-most in Major League Baseball.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.2 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (95.6).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 46 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for fifth in Major League Baseball.

HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington has played 23 games against teams with a record of .500 or better, the most in Major League Baseball.

- 13 of the Nationals 19 home games have come against teams .500 or better.

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 26 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 60 starts and maintain an ERA under 4.05 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.
- His 4.2% walk rate since the start of 2023 is the third-best mark in MLB.

LAST APPEARANCE

Littell earned his first win of the season after he allowed one earned run on one hit and walk, striking out one in 3.2 innings of work out of the bullpen against the Milwaukee Brewers on May 3.

vs. MIAMI

Littell is set to make his second career start against the Marlins...Miami is tied for the team he has faced the fewest times, with three appearances.

- He has gone 2-0, holding a 0.96 ERA on nine hits and one earned runs through 9.1 innings.

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).

2024

In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season.

- Led the Rays in wins (11st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (11st, 10)...All were career highs.
- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 BF without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
- Went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (10 ER/49.1 ER) over his final nine starts from July 27 on and ranked second in the AL (4th in MLB) in ERA.
- Received two or fewer runs of support in 22 of 29 starts, including 17 of his final 20...His 3.22 run support average was the lowest in MLB and lowest in Rays history (prev. Tony Saunders, 3.51 in 1998).
