RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals open a three-game series against the Miami Marlins tonight at Busch Stadium. The Marlins are the second opponent during the homestand after splitting a four-game series with the San Diego Padres. This seven-game homestand runs the Cardinals into the end of July and the trade deadline on Thursday, July 31 at 5:00 p.m. Central.

BIRD WATCHING: St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the National League Central, 9.0 games behind Chicago and Milwaukee, tied for the top spot in the Division and 2.5 games behind 3rd place Cincinnati. The Cardinals currently are 3.5 game behind San Diego for the final Wild Card spot in the National League with Cincinnati and San Francisco in the median.

MILE POST 2: Tonight is game No. 108 of the Cardinals schedule, marking two-thirds of the regular season schedule is complete. This is also the Cardinals 54th home game to go with their 54 road games pulling an even split on games.

SVANSON RECALLED; GRANILLO OPTIONED: Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals recalled RHP **Matt Svanson** from Memphis (AAA). RHP **Andre Granillo** was optioned to Memphis (AAA).

HELLO, ROOMIE: The St. Louis Cardinals and Miami Marlins share the Roger Dean Chevrolet complex in Jupiter, Fla., for Spring Training. Due to proximity, the Cardinals have played the Marlins the most of any team in Spring Training with 125 games since the Marlins moved to Jupiter in 2003 (*records since 2005*).

WE'VE MISSED YOU: Tonight's game on July 28 marks the 3rd-latest into the season these two teams have played their first game. The latest initial meeting was August 11, 2008 at SunLife Stadium, and now 2nd-latest in St. Louis on Aug. 1, 2005 at Busch Memorial Stadium.

FISHING IN THE DARK: The Cardinals all-time .603 win pct. (135-89) vs. the Marlins (1993-present) is their 2nd-highest against any opponent behind only the Diamondbacks (.609, 112-72). The winning percentage is the best of any National League team against the Marlins since they joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993 (*see chart right*).

BUSCH WHACKED: The Cardinals have won each of their last five home series against the Marlins dating back to 2019 with a 12-4 record over that period. Miami took 2-of-3 in 2018 and split a four-game series in St. Louis in 2019.

FISH STICKS: Cardinals third baseman **Nolan Arenado** has a string of success at Busch Stadium against the Marlins hitting safely in his last six games posting a .478 BA (11-23) with a home run and nine RBI. Over that period, Arenado drilled a walk-off three-run home run (July 18, 2023) in the 10th inning off **A.J. Puk** and had four straight multi-hit games (7/17-23-4/4/24).

HOME COOKING: **Iván Herrera** ranks 5th among Major League players in home batting average with a .337 mark (30-89) trailing only **Will Smith** (LAD, .368), **Jeremy Pena** (HOU, .358), **Jonathan Aranda** (TB, .345) and **Jacob Wilson** (ATH, .341). Herrera has also been solid in the clutch at Busch Stadium batting .478 (11-23) with runners in scoring position.

GROUND HERO: RHP **Andre Pallante** enters tonight's game ranking first among National League pitchers with a 62.0 ground ball percentage, 3.25 ground ball/fly ball ratio and with 224 ground balls. Since ground balls have been tracked beginning in 1987, Pallante's 61.5 ground ball percentage ranks 5th in all of Major League Baseball over 275 innings pitched.

TAYLOR EARNS INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE HONORS: Memphis (AAA) right-handed pitcher **Curtis Taylor** (minor league free agent sign, Feb. 2025) was named International League Pitcher of the Week (July 21-27). The 30-year old Canadian fired 7.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with seven strikeouts and one batter faced over the minimum. He ranks 2nd in the I.L. in ERA (3.16) opponent BA (.225) and 3rd in WHIP (1.15).

MIAMI CONNECTIONS

Miles Mikolas was born in nearby Jupiter, Fla...graduated from Jupiter (Fla.) HS and Nova South-eastern University...made MLB debut vs. the Marlins on May 5, 2012 at Petco Park (as a Padre).

Miles Mikolas (Jupiter), **Jordan Walker** (Jupiter), **Masyn Winn** (Jupiter) and **Nolan Gorman** (Pompano Beach) reside in the South Florida area.

Brant Brown served as the Marlins hitting coach in 2023.

Jon Jay was born in and resides in Miami...attended Christopher Columbus High School and the University of Miami...served as the First Base/Out-field Coach for Miami for two seasons (2023-24).

Garrett Hampson played in 98 games for the Marlins in 2023.

Pedro Pagés resides in Doral, Fla...graduated from Gulliver Prep High School in Miami...played college baseball at Florida Atlantic Univ...made MLB debut vs. Marlins (April 7, 2024 at Busch).

Iván Herrera caught his first MLB shutout against the Marlins, June 27, 2022 at Busch Stadium from **Adam Wainwright** (7 IP), **James Naile** (1 IP) and **Jake Woodford** (1 IP) in a 9-0 win.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 High School Home Run Derby at Marlins Park during All-Star Week.

Sandy Alcántara pitched in eight games for St. Louis in 2017...Originally signed with the Cardinals as an International free agent on July 2, 2013 (signed by **Moises Rodriguez**)...traded to Miami with **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Magneuris Sierra** for **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

Marlins Minor League Operations Assistant **Lizzy Millner** previous served as a Cardinals Baseball Operations Fellow in 2023.

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter, Fla. as their Spring Training site...RDGS is also the home to the Palm Beach Cardinals and Jupiter Hammerheads of the Single-A Florida State League.

Miami and St. Louis played the first regular season game at then Marlins Park (April 4, 2012), a 4-1 Cardinals win.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Making his 21st start of the season tonight and his 51st career start (159th career appearance). Establishes a new single-season high with 21 games started and is just 11.1 IP shy of matching his MLB career-high of 121.1 in 2024.
- Is aiming to snap his 4-game losing streak (matches career high) and his consecutive games started steak of 5-straight starts that have resulted in Cardinals losses; His last win, and also the last time the Cardinals won a game that he started, came on 6/20 vs. CIN (6-1).
- The Cardinals have provided Andre with just 1 run of support over his last 5 starts** & only 2 runs over his last 6 starts.
- His 0.40 run support average in the month of July (1 run in 4 starts) ranks as 2nd lowest among MLB pitchers (min. 4 GS) to the Nationals **Mike Soroka** (0.00).
- St. Louis is 8-1 in starts in which Pallante has received 2 or more runs of support, with the lone loss coming in his 6/3 start vs. KC, a 10-7 Cardinals defeat.
- Entered today leading all National League pitchers in Ground Balls, Ground Ball Pct. and Ground Ball/Fly Ball ratio, trailing only Angels RHP Jose Soriano in each category for MLB lead.**
- Career 9-6 with a 3.86 ERA (149.1 IP) and 96 strikeouts in 66 career games (15 starts) Post All-Star.
- The Cardinals are 9-11 in his 20 games started this season.
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 26, 2024, leads team in qualifying ERA (4.12) and is 2nd in wins (13) behind Sonny Gray (16 & 4.14).
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, has the best ground ball percentage (65.1%) in MLB (min. 150 appearances).
- Pallante's 61.5 groundball pct. as a starting pitcher (275.2 IP) is 5th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 250.0 IP as starter).**
- Has allowed home runs in 11-of-20 starts this season and his 14 HR's allowed have passed his total (8) for all of last season.
- Has had 32 total chances in the field, ranking 3rd among MLB pitchers.
- Is 16-17 as a starting pitcher in his 50 career starts (275.2 IP) with a 4.18 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT: Making his 2nd start since the All-Star break, dropped a 6-0 decision to the Rockies at Coors Field last Wed.. (7/23); allowed 5 runs on 9 hits, with 4 of the runs and 5 hits coming in the Rockies 2nd inning; the Cardinals were blanked in Denver for just the 4th time ever & were shut out for the 3rd time this season in a Pallante start.

2025 NOTES:

- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-2025).
- Received a no decision in a 1-0 Cardinals loss at Pittsburgh (July 1) as he exited after 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball, his lowest hit total in a start in his career. Ran his scoreless inning streak vs. PIT to 17.0 innings.
- His 2.28 run support average in April was MLB's 6th-lowest & 2nd among Cards starters to Miles Mikolas (1.90 - 3rd in MLB) for the month.
- Yielded a pair of singles over 6.0+ shutout frames in 6-1 win over the Reds on 6/20; exited with a runner on first in the 7th inning and St. Louis leading 1-0. Improved to 6-2 over the Reds in his career.
- Allowed a pair of runs over a season-high 7.1 innings for 4-2 win over Washington at Nationals Park on 5/10. Also fanned a season-best seven while walking none. Yielded 2-run HR to Dylan Crews as his final batter faced in the 7th inning.
- Suffered his 1st loss of the season on 4/17 at NYM; threw a season-high 95 pitches over 6.0 IP with all 4 of his runs allowed in the 4-1 defeat coming in the Mets 2nd inning
- Improved his record to 2-0 in a combined 2-0 shutout win over the Philadelphia Phillies 4/11 at Busch Stadium, allowing just 2 hits in his 7.0 IP (93 pitches). After an injury to Masyn Winn, catcher Pedro Pages played 4 innings (2nd thru 5th) of that game at 2nd base.

CAREER NOTES:

- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.
- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Graduated from San Clemente High School that also produced teammate RHP Michael McGreevy and Braves 2015 1st round pick Kolby Allard.

PALLANTE vs. MIAMI:

- Makes his 2nd career start and 6th career appearance vs. the Marlins; Is 0-1 with a 2.19 ERA covering 12.1 innings pitched.
- His lone start against the Marlins came on 6/29/22 at Busch Stadium and he took a no-decision in the Cardinals 4-3 loss; at the time it was just the 5th start of his young career and marked the 1st time that he had worked 7.0 IP; was in line for the win before the Marlins plated two in the 9th on a two-run Avisail Garcia HR.
- Has no HR's allowed vs. Marlins in his 12.1 career IP.
- Cardinals are 3-2 in his five career appearances vs. Miami.

HELZ BELLS: The Cardinals are 28-8 when he pitches this season, and have won 22 of his last 25 appearances since May 4.
