TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 4 (0-3) of a 4-game series against **Jesse Feldman's Cubs** and the seventh game (0-6) of a 7-game road trip that began with a 3-game series sweep at the hands of the **Pirates** at **PNC Park**.

- The Reds have lost a season-high 6 consecutive games, marking their longest losing streak since an 8-gamer from 4/30-5/9, 2024.
- Following Thu's game at **Chc**, the Redlegs will return to **Cincinnati** for a 6-game homestand against the **Astros** (5/8-5/10) and **Nationals** (5/12-14).

CLOSE CALLS: The Reds have suffered 3 straight walkoff losses for the fourth time in franchise history, also done in 1967 (5/24g2-5/26 at **Chc**, **Pit**), 1989 (9/12-9/14 at **LAD**, **SF**), and 2010 (7/8-7/10 at **Phi**)...the Reds have never lost 4 consecutive games in walkoff fashion.

- After opening the 2026 season on a 12-game winning streak in games decided by 2 runs or fewer, the Reds have lost 4 straight games by exactly 1 run...marks the eighth time since 1900 that they have dropped 4 consecutive team games by exactly 1 run (last: 4/1-4/4, 2025)...have not suffered 5 straight losses by exactly 1 run since 1900.
- Also marks the fourth time since 1900 that they have lost 4 straight games in their opponent's final at-bat (last: 8/17-8/19, 2014).

TRIUMPHANT RETURN: In his first Major League appearance in 759 days (since 4/7/24 vs **NYM**), **RHP Tejay Antone** worked a perfect 8th inning with 2 strikeouts in the Reds' 7-6, 10-inning loss on Wed at **Chc**.

- Antone**, who was selected from **AAA-Louisville** earlier in the day, has undergone "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow 3 times during the course of his career (April 2017, August 2021, April 2024).
- Antone** left Wed's game in line to earn his third career win after the Reds plated 4 runs in the top of the 9th inning.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have hit 28 homers over their last 13 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), second-most in MLB during that time, behind only **NY** (29).

- The Reds' 50 home runs this season are tied with the **Dodgers** for third-most all Major League teams, behind the **Yankees** (57) & **Braves** (54).
- Their 50 homers this season are also tied for their ninth-most through the first 37 games of a campaign in club history, the most since the 2021 team had 54 homers through its first 37 contests.
- Have hit multiple homers in a game 15 times this season, tied with the **Braves** for the fourth-most instances in MLB, behind the **Cubs** (17), **Yankees** (17), and **White Sox** (16).
- Of the Reds' 153 runs scored this season, 76 have come on homers (49.7%), second to only the **White Sox** for the highest rate in the majors.

ROOKIE RECOGNITION: **INF Sal Stewart** on Mon was named **National League Rookie of the Month** for March/April...became the ninth Red to ever earn the monthly honor, which was introduced in 2001 (last: **Spencer Steer**, May 2023).

- In 31 games between March and April, **Stewart** slashed .281/.373/.570 with 9 homers, 6 doubles, 20 runs, 29 RBI, and 18 walks.
- Stewart** entered May leading MLB in RBI (29), while also ranking among National League leaders in home runs (T4th), extra-base hits (15, T5th), slugging percentage (6th), OPS (.943, 6th), and total bases (65, T7th).
- His 29 RBI were the most by a Red before May since the stat became official in 1920, surpassing the previous mark of 26 set by Reds and **National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Perez** in 1970.

ELLYTRICITY: **SS Ely De La Cruz** this season leads all Major League shortstops in homers (10), runs (27), and total bases (75)...is the second Red since 1900 with at least 10 homers and 8 stolen bases through the team's first 37 games of a season (also: **Eric Davis**, 1987).

- Of his 10 homers this season, 5 have come off left-handed pitching, tied with **Hou's Yordan Alvarez**, **NY's Aaron Judge**, **NY's Ben Rice**, and **Sea's Julio Rodriguez** for most among all Major League batters.
- Is 3 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 115 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark since 1900 (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the first time this season...last year, Cin went 8-5 vs **Chc** to secure its third straight season series victory.

- Cin is looking to avoid being swept by **Chc** in a series of any length since 9/30-10/2, 2022 (3g) here at **Wrigley Field**...the Reds haven't been swept by the **Cubs** in a 4-game set since 8/23-8/26, 2018 (also at **Wrigley Field**).
- In their final meeting of 2025 (9/18-9/21), Cin swept the 4-game series at **Great American Ball Park**...it was its first 4-game sweep of **Chc** since 6/21-6/24, 2018 at GABP...in that set, recorded multiple 1-0 wins in a single series for the first time since 2002 at **Wrigley Field** (9/24, 9/26).
- The Reds led 5 of the 13 games of the 2025 season series by 4 or more runs (4-0 & 6-2 on 5/23, lost 13-6; 6-1 on 5/24, won 6-4; 8-3 on 5/25, lost 11-8; 6-0 5/30, won 6-2; won 5-1 on 8/5).
- The Reds are 196-193 vs **Chc** since 2003 and 93-111 since 2014...are 469-504 (.482) all-time here at **Wrigley Field**.

NATE THE GREAT: **INF Nathaniel Lowe** hit his sixth homer as a Red, all of which have come in the team's last 12 games (since 4/24 vs **Det**), on Tue at **Chc**.

- Since 4/24, **Lowe** ranks among Major League leaders in homers (6, T2nd), slugging percentage (.767, 4th), total bases (33, 4th), extra-base hits (8, T4th), OPS (1.142, 5th), and RBI (11, T7th).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Reds have grounded into 18 double plays this season, tied with the **Brewers**, **Mariners**, and **Phillies** for fewest in MLB...hit into 106 double plays last year, 12th-most among all Major League clubs.

STATE OF THE REDS: At 20-17 (.556), the Reds are tied with the **Pirates** for fourth place in the NL Central Division standings...their 20-17 record is also tied for the eighth-best mark in MLB this season.

- The Reds entered May in first place in their division for the ninth time in the divisional era (since 1969)...last did so in 2006, when they finished April tied with the **Cardinals** for the top spot in the NL Central.
- Of the 9 Reds teams to enter May atop their division, 3 qualified for Postseason play, including each of the last 2 World Series championship squads (1976, '90).

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Ely De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 255 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fourth-longest streak of consecutive games played by a Red since 1970.

- His streak of 37 BF without a hit also tied the sixth-longest streak by a Red at any point of a season since 1961, behind Jim Maloney (43, 1965), Don Gullett (42, 1971), Tom Browning (40, 1988), Homer Bailey (39, 2013), & Connor Phillips (38, 2025).
- Also matched Hideo Nomo (2001) for the fourth-longest streak of consecutive batters faced without a hit by any ML pitcher to open a season since 2000, behind Ronel Blanco (50, 2024), Josh Hader (47, 2020), and Austin Cox (39, 2023).
- His season-opening streak of 8 hitless relief appearances (3/26-4/12) trailed only John Franco (11g, 1987) for the longest by a Red to begin a season since 1900.

- The Reds are the only team to have three pitchers with 18+ app this season (Graham Ashcraft, Brock Burke, Connor Phillips).
- On 4/20, the Reds bullpen led the majors with a 2.23era...in 14 games since 4/21, they have pitched to a 7.33era (54ip, 44er), which ranks 29th in MLB over that time.
- In Sat's 2nd inning at Pit, Reds pitchers tied an MLB record by issuing 7 consecutive walks, matching the mark set by the **Pirates** (5/25/83 vs Atl) and **Washington Nationals** (8/28/1909g1 vs CWS).
- On Sat vs Pit became the first team to allow 5 or more runs in an inning without surrendering a hit since the **Mariners** did so on 4/27/94 vs NYY.
- This season, the **Reds** rank first among all Major League teams with 140 combined relief apps (Tor, 139)...last year, they ranked T6th in MLB with 550 combined relief outings.
