- θ The Birds have not won back-to-back games this season.
- (b) Félix Bautista registered his first save since August 24, 2023 vs. Toronto, spanning 597 days...The Orioles had gone 13 straight games to begin the season without a save, the team's longest since 1988 (21 G)...This was also the first save opportunity for the club in 2025, the first team to go the first 13 games without a save chance since the 2019 Colorado Rockies.

COMEBACK KIDS: Baltimore registered its second comeback win of the year yesterday, rallying from a 3-0 deficit entering the fifth inning...The Orioles have 83 come-from-behind victories since the start of 2023, tied for third in MLB with the Twins while trailing the Dodgers (89) and Phillies (85).

ALL ABOUT ADLEY: Adley Rutschman has reached base safely in each of his first 13 games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since Anthony Santander (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...Aaron Hicks also reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

- θ_{A} His 13-game on-base streak is the fourth-longest active stretch in the AL...It's tied for the fifth longest of his career and his longest since a career-high 16-gamer from June 12-29, 2024.
- (b) Rutschman has gone a career-high 20 straight games with one strikeout or fewer since September 21, 2024...lt is tied for the second-longest active streak by an Oriole, trailing Ramón Urías (33 G, since 8/16/24).

<u>'PEN PALS</u>: Baltimore relievers have posted a 3.24 ERA (18 ER/50.0 IP), third best in the AL and sixth in MLB.

- (b) Gregory Soto has thrown 6.0 scoreless innings with one hold over six appearances, allowing three hits, two walks, and one hit batter while fanning nine...In 26 appearances since August 8, 2024, he has a 0.81 ERA (2 ER/22.1 IP) with six walks and 29 strikeouts.
- $\theta_{\rm b}$ Seranthony Domínguez is 1-0 with two holds, tossing 5.2 scoreless innings across six appearances while allowing one hit and six walks with seven strikeouts.

HOME COOKING: The Orioles are 95-71 (.572) at home since the start of 2023, the fifth-best winning percentage in the AL during that time...However, the team is 17-23 (.425) at Oriole Park since June 30, 2024, third worst in the AL and fourth worst in MLB over that period.

 θ » Ramón Urías has hit safely in eight straight home games since August 23, 2024, while slashing .400/.423/.600 (10-for-25) with one triple, one homer, two runs scored, and five RBI during that time.

<u>ALL RISP, NO REWARD</u>: In six wins, Baltimore hitters are 21-for-58 (.362) with three doubles, one triple, and two home runs with runners in scoring position, compared to 4-for-33 (.121) with no extra-base hits in eight losses.

 θ O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .202 (26-for-129) RISP average, the fourth-lowest mark in the AL and fifth lowest in MLB.

<u>DOUBLE TROUBLE</u>: The O's have grounded into an MLB-leading 16 doubles plays, ahead of the Athletics and Cardinals (both 15)...In 2024, Baltimore's 71 double plays set a record for the fewest in a full season (min. 154 G) in MLB history.

 $\theta_{\rm A}$ The Birds had their streak of 10 straight games with a GIDP snapped yesterday, which was the team's longest since August 27 to September 6, 2019 (10 G).

<u>POWER OUTAGE</u>: The O's hit two home runs yesterday after going deep twice in the previous 10 games...Baltimore's four home runs since March 30 are the fewest in the majors during that time ahead of the Blue Jays and Royals (both 5 HR).

 $\pmb{\theta}_{\!\scriptscriptstyle A}$ The Birds have hit 12 homers in five games against Toronto this season...That's more than nine MLB teams have all season.

BATTLE OF THE BIRDS: The O's and Blue Jays complete their second series of the year today... Baltimore hosts Toronto again for a four-game series from July 28-30, before three games at Rogers Centre from September 12-14...The clubs split a four-game set north of the border to open the season from March 27-30.

- θ_{A} The O's went 7-6 against the Blue Jays last season, their second consecutive winning season against Toronto...Baltimore has won back-to-back season series against the Jays for only the second time since 1997, joining 2012 (11-7), 2013 (10-9), and 2014 (11-8).
- Adley Rutschman's 1.003 OPS against the Jays is the third best among active players behind Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout (1.032) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (1.007)... Rutschman tied the game with a solo home run in the sixth inning yesterday, his 13th career home run against the Blue Jays, more than double the next closest team (6, Athletics).

QUICK HITS: Set to make his third start of the season and the 18th of his career...Was dealt the loss on April 6 after allowing four runs (one earned run) on a career-high 12 hits with four strikeouts...Marked his first quality start of the season...Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his major league debut in 2024 when he started on June 6 at Toronto...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL and the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, along with Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)... On June 12, 2024 vs. Atlanta, became the 11th Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP)...At 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23-249) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24-144) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martinez (24-081) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nuñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS: Will be facing the Blue Jays for the third time in his major league career...Owns a 0-2 record against the club with a 8.38 ERA (12 ER/9.2 IP) with three strikeouts against nine walks...Made his major league debut at Toronto on June 6, 2024, allowing six earned runs on five hits (1 HR) with two strikeouts against four walks in the loss.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: He is 0-5 with a 5.66 ERA (22 ER/35.0 IP) in seven career starts against the division...Last faced a divisional opponent on March 31 versus Boston, allowing three earned runs on five hits with a season-high eight strikeouts...Did not factor in the decision.

<u>DAY AND NIGHT</u>: Povich was 0-4 with a 9.15 ERA (21 ER/20.2 IP) with 17 walks (1 IBB) and 19 strikeouts in five day starts last season...He went 3-5 with a 3.81 ERA (25 ER/59.0 IP) with 17 walks and 50 strikeouts in 11 night starts in 2024.

FOREVER YOUNG: At 25 years, 1 day old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the third-youngest player overall behind Jackson Holliday (21-130) and Gunnar Henderson (23-288).

GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE: Povich went 2-1 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER/14.2 IP) with nine hits (1 HR), four walks, and 15 strikeouts in four starts in Spring Training...In his last outing on March 18 vs. Toronto, working 5.0 no-hit innings with three walks and six strikeouts... Retired 15 of the final 16 batters faced after walking the first two batters of the game.
