BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues its six-game, six-day road trip through Minnesota (0-3) and Los Angeles-AL (1-0, 2 to play) tonight at Angel Stadium...The Birds look to earn back-to-back road victories for the first time since completing a three-game sweep of Minnesota to complete the 2024 season.

👉 Last night's 4-1 win snapped a season-high five-game losing streak, with Baltimore avoiding its first six-game losing skid since May 13-18, 2022.

👉 **Tomoyuki Sugano** improved to 4-2 after tossing 7.1 innings of one-run ball, permitting three hits with zero walks and five strikeouts...Entering play today, he ranks among all qualified MLB rookie hurlers in innings (1st, 46.1), wins (T-1st), WHIP (2nd, 1.01), and ERA (3rd, 2.72)...His 2.72 ERA is the sixth lowest by an Oriole through eight career starts in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Jerry Walker** (1.63), **Josh Towers** (1.76), **Billy O'Dell** (2.39), **Zack Britton** (2.42), and **Bob Milacki** (2.62).

👉 **Gunnar Henderson's** first-inning home run marked the first time in 16 straight games since April 19 vs. Cincinnati that the O's plated a run in the opening frame...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it marked the longest such streak by a Baltimore club since the 2022 O's went 18 straight games without scoring a run in the first inning from May 9-27...Henderson added an RBI-triple in the ninth, marking his fourth career game with a triple and a homer, including his second against the Angels (also 3/30/24).

👉 With its four runs last night, Baltimore snapped a single-season franchise-record-tying streak of 11 straight games in which it scored three runs or fewer on the road (also 4/25 [G1]-5/23 [G2]/54).

ANGELS IN THE OUTFIELD: The Birds are 16-5 (.762) against the Angels since 2022, including an 8-2 mark at Angel Stadium, the second-highest winning percentage by any club against the Angels during that stretch (min. 10 G) behind only the Dodgers (10-2, .833)...The .762 winning percentage against the Halos since 2022 is their highest against any opponent during that stretch ahead of the White Sox (15-5, .750) and Rangers (14-5, .737).

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** has reached base safely in 13 of 14 career games against Los Angeles, including hits in 12 of the contests, slashing .364/.429/.855 (20-for-55) with four doubles, four triples, five home runs, 14 RBI, and five walks...His 1.1283 OPS opposite the Halos is fourth highest among all active players (min. 50 PA), trailing PHI's Bryce Harper (1.385), DET's Jake Rogers (1.335), and PHI's Trea Turner (1.311).

👉 **Ryan Mountcastle** has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games against Los Angeles since May 16, 2023, slashing .349/.392/.488 (15-for-43) with three doubles, one homer, and 10 RBI.

HENDERSON HEATING UP: **Gunnar Henderson** has reached base safely in each of his last 15 games, slashing .305/.359/.492 (18-for-59) with three doubles, one triple, and two home runs... It marks the third-longest stretch of his career behind runs of 36 games (5/22-6/29/24) and 16 games (7/1-20/23).

👉 The 15-game run is tied for the fifth-longest active stretch in the AL and tied for ninth in the majors.

👉 Henderson's 94.7 mph average exit velocity is tied for fifth highest in the majors behind LAD's Shohei Ohtani (97.3), PIT's Oneil Cruz (96.3), and BOS' Rafael Devers/ NYY's Aaron Judge (95.5).

LET'S GO STREAKING: **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached base safely in 12 straight games, slashing .341/.426/.659 (14-for-41) with one double, four home runs, and eight RBI during that stretch... Marks the second-longest on-base streak of his career behind a 15-game run from June 15-July 3, 2024.

👉 **Jackson Holliday** has reached base safely in a career-best nine straight games, slashing .367/.406/.600 (11-for-30) with a double, two home runs, and four RBI...He has seen year-over-year improvements from 2024 to 2025 in whiff rate (-11.4%, 34.1 to 22.7), strikeout rate (-9.5%, 33.2 to 23.7), and chase rate (-6.7, 27.2 to 20.5).

👉 **Félix Bautista** has made nine straight scoreless appearances since April 7, limiting the opposition to an .069 (2-for-29) average and posting a 0.56 WHIP...He has registered a save in a career-best six straight appearances, striking out eight batters with zero walks during that stretch...The last Oriole with a save in seven straight appearances was Craig Kimbrel (7 G, 6/26-7/7/24).

HOLD ON TIGHT: Each of the O's last five wins have been decided by three runs or fewer, three of which were one-run victories (4/24 at WSH, 4/28 & 4/30 vs. NYY)...11 of their 14 wins overall have been by four runs or fewer, with the largest margin of victory coming on Opening Day at Toronto (+10, 12-2).

👉 Of Baltimore's 23 losses, however, 13 have been by four or more runs, tied with Los Angeles-AL for second most in the majors ahead the Rockies (15).

MAGIC NUMBER: The O's are 12-3 when scoring at least four runs this season, including wins in six of their last seven when doing so...Baltimore is 2-20 when plating three or fewer runs and 2-29 in those situations since September 7, 2024.

👉 The Birds have scored 4+ runs in 10 of their last 11 games against the Angels since May 18, 2023, going 8-3 in those contests and averaging 6.3 runs per game during that stretch.

RISPY BUISNESS: The Orioles are batting .132/.169/.199 (18-for-136) with runners in scoring position over the last 17 games since April 20...Their .189 RISP average overall is the lowest in MLB, with the next closest teams being the Rockies (.198) and White Sox (.201)...The 1988 Orioles are responsible for the lowest RISP average in franchise history (.217).

👉 In 14 wins this season, Baltimore is 35-for-121 (.289) with runners in scoring position, compared to 15-for-144 (.104) in 23 defeats.

SPLITTING HAIRS: The Birds are slashing .249/.312/.447 with a .759 OPS against right-handed pitching, compared to .177/.257/.236 with a .493 OPS against southpaws...The .759 OPS off righties ranks sixth in MLB, while the .493 OPS off lefties is last, with the next closest team being the Angels (.551).

👉 The O's have an MLB-best .866 OPS against right-handed starters, slashing .282/.342/.524 with 31 homers, compared to .200/.267/.329 with nine long balls and a .596 OPS off right-handed relievers...The .596 OPS is second lowest in the majors ahead of only the Rangers (.566).

QUICK HITS: Set to make his third start of the season and the 36th of his career as an Oriole...Signed a one-year contract with the Birds on March 22, 2025...Made three minor league appearances between Triple-A Norfolk (2 GS) and High-A Aberdeen (1 GS), going 1-1 with a 3.75 ERA (5 ER/12.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts against two walks... Made 33 starts with the O's in 2023, going 15-9 with a 4.73 ERA (101 ER/192.0 IP) on 198 hits (23 HR), 55 walks, and six hit batters with 157 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on May 4 vs. Kansas City after working 4.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits (1 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts... Has allowed at least one home run in five straight starts since September 14, 2024, one shy of his career-long streak of six starts from June 13-July 9, 2017.

🌀 Worked around two-out double by Vinnie Pasquantino in the opening frame... Permitted a one-out solo homer to Maikel Garcia in the second...In the fourth, conceded a one-out single to Salvador Perez and two-out double to Hunter Renfroe before Drew Waters plated both with a two-out, two-run single.

WEST COAST VIBES: Has made 15 career starts against Los Angeles, going 4-5 with a 5.83 ERA (54 ER/83.1 IP)...Earned the win in his last outing on September 6, 2023 at Angel Stadium after tossing 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR) and two walks with three strikeouts.

🌀 Is 22-19 with a 4.13 ERA (177 ER/386.0 IP) in 67 career starts against AL West opponents.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Gibson is set to make his first appearance on the road since September 26, 2024 at Colorado (w/STL)...In his last 19 road starts since August 18, 2023, he is 9-3 with a 3.89 ERA (48 ER/111.0 IP) and a 1.17 WHIP...During that same period, he is 3-8 with a 5.26 ERA (66 ER/113.0 IP) and a 1.58 WHIP in 21 home starts.

🌀 Gibson is winless in 12 straight home starts since May 22, 2024, going 0-5 with a 6.38 ERA (39 ER/55.0 IP) during that stretch...His five-decision home losing streak is tied with teammate Charlie Morton for the third-longest active run among all MLB starting pitchers behind BOS' Garrett Crochet (7 GS) and PIT's Mitch Keller (6 GS).

WORK HORSE: Gibson was one of seven pitchers, along with current teammate Charlie Morton, to make at least 30 starts in each season from 2021-24, joining TOR's José Berrios, CHW's/SD's Dylan Cease, WSH's Patrick Corbin, TOR's/SF's Kevin Gausman, and PHI's Aaron Nola.

🌀 Gibson's 33 starts in 2023 were the most by an Oriole hurler since Gausman (34) in 2017.

🌀 His 326 career starts are seventh most among all active MLB pitchers, trailing SF's Justin Verlander (534), TOR's Max Scherzer (458), LAD's Clayton Kershaw (429), BAL's Charlie Morton (388), MIL's Jose Quintana (339), and TEX's Patrick Corbin (330).

2024 REVIEW: Gibson made 30 starts for the Cardinals last season, going 8-8 with a 4.24 ERA (80 ER/169.2 IP) on 161 hits (23 HR), 68 walks (1 IBB), and four hit batters with 151 strikeouts.

🌀 Worked at least 5.0 innings in 24 starts, including 6.0+ in 17 outings.

🌀 Posted a 20.9 percent strikeout rate, his highest since a career-best 22.7 percent mark in 2019.

🌀 Signed with St. Louis as a free agent on November 21, 2023.
