TODAY'S GAME: The Giants have reached the third and final stop on this road trip after going 1-0 in Atlanta and dropping the series in Pittsburgh 2-1 with a 5-2 loss yesterday at PNC Park.

- ▶ The Giants are in the midst of a stretch in which they play 23 games in 24 days from August 18-September 9...SF's lone off day, which they used to fly to Atlanta, was last Sunday...the Giants are 7-10 in the first 17 games of this stretch.

NEW YAWK CITY?: It's been a while since the Giants and Mets squared off with their first series of the year being a four-gamer in SF for the Giants' third series of the season...after the Giants won Game 1, the Mets took the next three games to take the series.

- ▶ Only seven players currently on the Giants roster were on the roster for the first game of this season series in SF on April 2.
- ▶ SF has won each of its last two series here at Citi Field and has won three of its last five dating to 2021 (series wins in 2021, 2024 and 2025)...however, the Giants have finished with a losing record to the Mets in three of the last four years (2024 being the exception).
- ▶ **OF Jung Hoo Lee** will be playing in his second series here in Queens...he went 7-for-12 (.583) with three doubles and one RBI in three-game series here last year...he's actually played very well in his two series in NYC with the other being a three-gamer at Yankee Stadium last year where he was 4-for-9 with a double, three homers and seven RBI.

ON THE BUMP: **LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson** makes his fourth career Major League start tonight in search of his first win.

- ▶ The 23-year-old turned in his first quality start in the first game of a doubleheader last Saturday at Oracle Park...after dealing 6.0 scoreless innings he walked the first two batters of the 7th and was lifted for a reliever...both runs came around to score in an eventual 7-1 Giants loss.

CALL RAFI: **IF Rafael Devers** had both his 10-game hitting streak and 15-game on-base streak snapped yesterday with his 0-for-4 day.

- ▶ Despite the hitless day, Devers is still 16-for-42 (.381) over his last 11 games with a .490 OBP, .833 SLG and a 1.324 OPS...he's homered six times, doubled once, driven in 13 runs and scored 13 runs...SF is 6-5 in those games.
- ▶ His 25 home runs since June 6 are second-most in MLB, behind only CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (30).
- ▶ Through 70 games (a stretch ending June 12), Devers hit .230 with nine HRs and a .409 SLG...in the 71 games that have followed, he's hit .276 with 23 homers and a .591 SLG.
- ▶ Devers has logged a go-ahead RBI in three of the four-games on this road trip so far...Devers' 28 go-ahead RBI are most in the Majors and most by a Giant in a single season since **Buster Posey's** 31 in 2012 (*Stats, LLC*).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Giants enter today tied for the MLB lead with 15 players having made their debuts this season (also: White Sox)...the club can match their San Francisco era (since 1958) record of 16 players if **C Zach Morgan** gets into a game.

- ▶ Of the 28 players on SF's active roster today, nine have made their MLB debut this season... additionally, 13 of the 28 players on the Giants active roster still have rookie status.
- ▶ Entering the first game of this series, the Giants' roster has an average age of 26 years, 343 days old...it marks the second-youngest average age of any active rosters, behind only the Nationals (26y, 76d), and the first time since at least 2013 that SF had a game roster with an average age of under 27 years old (*Stats, LLC*)
- ▶ On Tuesday, **LHP Cesar Perdomo** became the 63rd player to appear in a Giants uniform this year...SF is approaching the club record 66 players used in 2022 .

PATIENCE AND POWER: **IF Bryce Eldridge** drew four walks in the Pirates series and has walked 51 times overall in 2026...he's the first Giants rookie with at least 50 walks and 15 home runs in a season since **Dave Kingman** in 1972 (29 homers, 51 walks) (*Stats, LLC*).

FEELS LIKE THE FIRST TIME: Giants 2026 first-rounder **RHP Jackson Flora** is slated to make his organizational debut tonight for Single-A San Jose at Fresno.

YOUNGIN': 23-year-old **LHP Matt Wilkinson** is scheduled to make the the fourth start of his young MLB career tonight and his first against the Mets...a 10th round pick by Cleveland in 2023 out of Central Arizona JC, he was acquired by the Giants in early May alongside the 29th overall pick in this past draft (**LHP Carson Bol-emon**) in exchange for C Patrick Bailey.

LAST TIME OUT: Was a tough-luck loser in his first career start at Oracle Park, allowing two earned runs on three hits, two walks, and four strikeouts over 6.0 innings versus the Diamondbacks...SF lost the game 7-1 after Wilkinson worked 6.0 scoreless innings before issuing two walks to start the 7th.

O CANADA: Was used as an opener in his MLB debut on August 19 at Cleveland, tossing 2.0 scoreless frames and allowing one hit with no walks or strikeouts against his former organization... became the fifth Canadian-born Giants pitcher to start a game all-time, joining **Tip O'Neill** (1883), **Bill Magee** (1901-1902), **Bob Steele** (1918-19), **Georges Maranda** (1960) and **Ken MacKenzie** (1964)...Wilkinson joined O'Neill as the only Canadian-born Giants pitcher to make their MLB debut as a starting pitcher.

TO THE LEFT: The southpaw dominated left-handed hitters in the minors this season...he held left-handed hitters to a .127 average (13x102) with three extra-base hits, 26 strikeouts and a .384 OPS... his success against lefties has continued in the Majors, as they've gone 0-for-9 (.000) against him through his first three starts.

EVERYTHING ALL RIGHT?: Was solid against righties in the minors this year as well, as they recorded .215 (46x214) average with 23 extra-base hits, 70 strikeouts and a .695 OPS...however, eight of his nine homers allowed were to righties...he's struggled a bit against righties to start his MLB career, as they're 11-for-36 (.306) off him with two doubles, a triple, and a homer (.842 OPS).

PUNCH OUT: Has 390 strikeouts in 313.2 MiLB innings (70 games, 69 starts)...his 11.14 K/9 since 2024 was fifth-best in the minor leagues over that span (min. 300 innings)...has six strikeouts over his first three Major League starts (4.63 K/9).

EXTENDO: Wilkinson throws a low-90s fastball, which he's used 54.7% of the time over his first three starts...it is often called the "in-visibilityball" for the perceived speed with which it gets to the plate despite being well below average in terms of average velocity (90.3 mph)... this could be due to Wilkinson's elite extension to home plate when he delivers a pitch, which at 6.8 feet is in the top 21% of Major League pitchers and can make pitches appear to move at a higher velocity than in they are in reality.

ESCAPE ARTIST: Wilkinson has shown his mettle when in a jam to start his career, as opponents are just 3-for-20 (.150) with men on-base against him.

IN DOUBLE-EH: Pitched six games for Akron (Cleveland) and three games for Richmond (SF) before being promoted to Triple-A...was 3-2 with a 1.87 ERA (9er, 43.1ip), 49 strikeouts and a 0.83 WHIP in nine combined Double-A starts this season.

IN TRIPLE-EH: Was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on June 2, where he went 3-4 over 10 appearances (all starts) and recorded a 5.15 ERA (25er, 43.2ip) with a 1.21 WHIP.

TUGBOAT: Wilkinson was nicknamed "Tugboat" by his father's best friend, Phil McNeil, after he saw him running at a slow speed around the bases while Matt was playing in the 2015 Little League World Series.

▶ Earned the win in his last outing, a start at Atlanta on August 31, striking out six while allowing three runs on six hits (one homer) and no walks over 5.0 innings.

▶ Has earned the win in both of his two outings for SF thus far, posting a 2.89 ERA (3er, 9.1ip) and seven strikeouts.

▶ Acquired from Atlanta the night prior to the trade deadline in exchange for RHP Tyler Mahle.

▶ This will be his third career game vs. the Mets...he has allowed four runs (three earned) in 3.0 innings vs. NYM...he surrendered two runs (one earned) in an inning vs. NYM on June 14, 2026 while with Atlanta.
