RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude the regular season with the second game of a three-game series vs. the division-rival Cincinnati Reds as the club honors and celebrates **Adam Wainwright's** career this weekend at Busch Stadium.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals will finish in last place in the National League Central for the first time in the Wild Card Era and first time since finishing 6th in the National League East in 1990 ... St. Louis has spent 144 of 178 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... The Cardinals 69-91 record is their lowest at the 160-game mark since 1978 when they were 68-92 (.425) ... St. Louis has recorded its first 90-loss season since going 70-92 in 1990.

COMEBACK CARDS: Since 1913, the Cardinals have lost 90 or more games only five times (1913, 1916, 1976, 1978, 1990), but finished above .500 the year after each of those seasons: 81-72 in 1914; 82-70 in 1917; 83-79 in 1977; 86-76 in 1979; and 84-78 in 1991.

ROSTER UPDATE: Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals optioned RHP **Jake Woodford** to the Florida Complex League (R) and recalled RHP **James Naile** from Memphis (AAA) ... Since Spring Training began, St. Louis has made a total of 262 transactions this season.

FRESHMAN FINISHES: Rookie **Jordan Walker** has hit safely in 20-of-24 games played in September (.280/.346/.452, 26-93), and with four more hits this weekend, would become just the 4th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 30+ hits in Sept./Oct ... The 21-year-old recently became the only Major Leaguer this season with three separate hitting streaks of 12 games or longer (12, 17, 12), and just the 15th Cardinal overall (5th rookie) with three or more different double-digit hitting streaks in the same season. - *Elias*

BOOKEND BOMBERS: Only three players in Major League history have homered in their first and final career regular season game: **Eric Soderholm** (Sept. 3, 1971 with Twins and Oct. 5, 1980 with Yankees), **Dave McKay** (Aug. 22, 1975 with Twins and Oct. 3, 1982 with A's), and **Will "The Thrill" Clark** (April 8, 1986 with Giants and Oct. 1, 2000 with Cardinals) ... 2017 Silver Slugger Award winner **Adam Wainwright**, (and **Willson Contreras**) are members of the exclusive club of players who have homered on the first pitch of their MLB careers (May 24, 2006 at San Francisco off **Noah Lowry**, a game started by **Brad Thompson**). - *Elias*

PITCHERS ARE HITTERS TOO!: After pinch hitting for designated hitter **Luken Baker** last night, **Adam Wainwright** became only the 4th pitcher in the DH Era (1973-present) to pinch hit for the designated hitter, joining Milwaukee's **Jamie Easterly** for **Ted Simmons/Mookie Haas** (May 23, 1983), Oakland's **Rick Honeycutt** for **Dave Henderson** (July 6, 1990-2), and Washington's **Joe Ross** for **Yunel Escobar** (June 16, 2015).

WAINO'S WORLD: Of the 10,343 total players who have made Major League debuts in the Divisional Era (since 1969), 2,398 players have hit 10 or more career home runs, while 36 pitchers have won 200 or more games in that timespan ... The only player to achieve both milestones is **Adam Wainwright** (10 HR and 200 wins). - *Stats Perform*

PINCH-HITTING PITCHERS: The last time a primary pitcher pinch hit in their final career game was LHP **Mike Chris** for the 1983 Giants ... On May 1, 1983 at Busch Stadium II against the Cardinals, Chris pinch hit for the starting pitcher **Fred Breining** (flew out to CF) in the top of the 4th inning, threw 2.0+ innings in relief, and then never made it back to The Show. - *Elias*

WHERE'S GIBBY: St. Louis is in danger of becoming the final team in MLB history without a pitcher throwing a complete game in a 162-game season (the Cubs, Mariners, and Royals all last season recorded their first campaign in franchise history without a complete game) ... **Jordan Montgomery** (Aug. 22, 2022 at Chicago Cubs) threw the last complete game for the Cardinals.

BUSCH STADIUM III SINGLE-SEASON RECORDS: With last night's game, the Cardinals and their opponents have combined to break the single-season Busch Stadium III (2006-23) records for home runs (186), runs scored (758), and stolen bases (97) ... With five more extra-base hits this weekend, the 486 XBH from the 2008 season will be surpassed.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 30, 2005): **Albert Pujols** hits his 40th homer of the season and 200th of his career in a 12-6 win over the Reds at Busch Stadium, a grand slam in the 7th inning off **Matt Belisle** ... Pujols becomes the 2nd-fastest to reach 200 career homers based on days since his MLB debut (4 yrs, 181 days) behind **Ralph Kiner** (4-119) and the 3rd youngest player to reach 200 career homers in terms of age (25-257) behind **Mel Ott** (25-144) and **Eddie Mathews** (25-242).

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

David Bell served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiserman** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Turner Ward served as hitting coach for Cincinnati during the 2019 season.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ. (1995-97).

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Nick Martini was selected by St. Louis in the 7th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons in the Cards organization (2011-17).

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over the last two seasons (2022-23).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2017-22) where he won the 2021 NL Gold Glove in center field.

Reds Hitting Coach **Joel McKeithan**, is a brother of minor league catcher **Aaron McKeithan** in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, **Jerry Sr.**, spent seven years in the Cardinals organization ... Brother, **Tim**, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Rookie LHP is making his 8th career start for the Cardinals, and his 2nd career start and appearance against the Reds.
- Looking to snap a two-game losing streak, having allowed 13 runs on 17 hits in his past two starts (6.2 IP combined).
- The Cardinals have provided 2 runs or fewer in support in five of his seven starts.
- Is making his 3rd career start at Busch Stadium, losing 7-6 vs. PIT and 7-3 vs. MIL in his two previous starts on home turf.
- Was acquired from the Orioles at the trade deadline with minor league infielder **Cesar Prieto** and right-handed pitcher **Zack Showalter**, in exchange for RHP **Jack Flaherty**.
- Was recalled for two days (May 9-10) by Baltimore earlier in the year, but did not see any game action.
- Became the 7th Cardinal to make his Major League debut this season and third pitcher with RHP **Guillermo Núñez** (5/2 vs. LAA) and RHP **Kyle Leahy** (7/7 at CWS).
- Made two starts in Memphis (AAA) following trade, and held his opposition to one hit in each start, throwing five and six innings.
- Struck out 10 batters in his Memphis Redbirds debut (8/9 at Durham), the second double-digit strikeout game of his career.

LAST TIME OUT

- Failed to get past the 4th inning for the 2nd-consecutive start as the Padres erupted for 12 runs last Sun. (9/24) at PETCO Park, including a three-run homer by Juan Soto in the opening inning.

CAREER

- Became the first Cardinals LHP to throw 5.1 or more scoreless IP with two hits or less and 7 or more strikeouts in one of his first 5 starts at BAL (9/13). Earned his 1st MLB win at Oriole Park at Camden Yards against his original drafting team (2018, 4th round).
- Made his MLB debut in front of over 40 family and friends at PNC Park in Pittsburgh (8/21) and allowed four 1st inning runs en route to eight runs over 3.2 innings in an 11-1 loss. Was the most runs allowed by a Cardinals pitcher in his debut since **Mike Mayers** allowed nine vs. LAD (7/24/16) at Busch Stadium. Most runs allowed by a left-handed pitcher in his Cardinals MLB debut in records dating back to 1901.
- Cincinnati area native was selected by the Orioles in the 4th round (115th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Ky.
