STL FLY: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their six-game, seven-day homestand with the opener of a three-game series against the Washington Nationals tonight ... The Cardinals opened their homestand by dropping two of three to division-rival Milwaukee ... St. Louis (5-4) begins the day tied with Milwaukee for 2nd place in the NL Central, 1.0 game back of first place Cincinnati (6-3).

LET'S HEAR IT FOR THE NEW GUY: Nolan Arenado's 12 hits (12-36, .333) through his first nine career games as a Cardinal to begin a season are the most since outfielder Jeremy Hazelbaker started 13-for-27 (.481) in 2016 ... After 10 Cardinals games, Hazelbaker was 13-for-31 (.419) ... Arenado's hit streak is the 2nd-longest to open a season by a new Cardinal behind only Charley Smith, who began the 1966 season hitting .486 (18-37) in his first 10 games ... The last Cardinal to start their career hitting safely in their first nine games was Magneuris Sierra, who hit in nine straight from May 7-July 16, 2017 (15-36, .417) ... Arenado is one of three MLB players with nine-game hitting streaks, joining Philadelphia's Didi Gregorius and Baltimore's Cedric Mullins.

JOHN GANT IS GOOD AT BASEBALL: John Gant enters tonight's game with a homerless innings streak of 39.1 innings dating back to July 18, 2019, matching the Yankees Zach Britton for the majors longest active homerless streak. Gant did not allow a home run to 61 total batters faced in 2020. Elias

NATIONAL NEWS: Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals' .725 home winning percentage (30-12) against the visiting Washington Nationals is their 2nd-best against any opponent, trailing only the Colorado Rockies (.745, 38-13). St. Louis has won the home series vs. the Nationals in 11 of 13 visits.

WORKING FOR THE WEEKEND: St. Louis (5-0) is the only undefeated Major League team on weekdays but one of three to go winless on weekends (0-4) with Washington (0-2) and the New York Mets (0-1) ... During the work week, St. Louis sports the lowest combined ERA (1.80), but the highest ERA (10.06) on weekends ... Since 2019, St. Louis is combined 19-6 on Mondays, best in MLB.

Y2K: Yadier Molina (1,998) is two games caught away from reaching 2,000 for his career, becoming one of six catchers in MLB history to catch 2,000 career games, and the only backstop to do so exclusively with one team ... Hall of Famer Gabby Hartnett ranks 2nd to Molina in career games caught for any franchise (1,754 for Chicago Cubs), while Hall of Famer Johnny Bench ranks 2nd to Molina in most career games caught for only one team (1,743 for Cincinnati Reds).

STATCAST STATS: Paul Goldschmidt ranks 4th in Major League Baseball with 19 hard-hit batted balls this season, trailing Ronald Acuña Jr. (20), Manny Machado (20), and Corey Seager (20) ... Goldy also ranks 4th in hard hit percentage (70.4), behind Tyler Naquin (78.3), Machado (74.1), and Byron Buxton (72.7) ... Tommy Edman's lineout to third base (112.9 mph) yesterday was the 2nd hardest-hit ball in MLB, behind Xander Bogaerts (113.6 mph). h/t Langs

250 GOLDY DINGERS: Paul Goldschmidt's next homer will be the 250th of his career, as he seeks to become the 9th player to hit home run #250 in a Cardinals uniform and join Stan Musial (9/4/53 at Mil. Braves), Ken Boyer (7/10/65 at Cubs), Orlando Cepeda (6/9/67 at LA Dodgers), Jim Edmonds (7/18/03 at LA Dodgers), Reggie Sanders (4/9/04 at Arizona), Albert Pujols (10/1/06 vs. Milwaukee), Scott Rolen (8/23/06 at NY Mets), and Matt Holliday (9/27/13 vs. Cubs).

BIRD BYTES: Dylan Carlson's team-leading three homers share the MLB Rookie lead with Pittsburgh's Phillip Evans and Colorado's Dom Nunez ... Giovanny Gallegos has struck out nine of 16 batters faced for the 9th-best strikeout percentage (56.3%) in MLB (Aroldis Chapman is 1st, .818, 9 of 11) ... Tyler Webb's six appearances rank T4th-most for a Cardinal through the first nine games of a season, behind Clyde Shoun (7 in 1940) and Steve Kline (7 in 2001 and 7 in 2002) ... Tommy Edman's 11 hits are tied for 4th-most among MLB leadoff hitters.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (April 12, 1965): Left-hander Steve Carlton makes his Major League debut in the 1965 Season Opener, walking his only batter faced in the 11th inning at Wrigley Field. The Cards and Cubs played to a 10-10 standoff in 11 innings (4:19) before the game was called due to darkness.

Tyler Webb was born in Nassawadox, Va...graduated from Northampton High School in Eastville, Va.

John Gant made his Major League debut against the Nationals (April 6, 2016) while with Atlanta.

Austin Dean recorded his first career MLB hit at Washington (with Miami), a solo homer off Trevor Gott (August 17, 2018).

Andrew Knizner was born in Glen Allen, Va... graduated from Hanover (Va) High School, where he was a quarterback and punter for the football team and was an All-State shortstop on the 2013 Virginia AAA State Championship team.

Knizner was teammates with Trea Turner at North Carolina State University in 2014.

Nationals broadcaster Bob Carpenter worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals on both radio and television before joining Washington...graduated from nearby McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, Judy Carpenter-Barada, previously served as Cardinals Director of Major League Administration.

Mike Maddux was Nationals pitching coach for two seasons (2016-17) prior to St. Louis...also pitched parts of two seasons (1998-99) for the Expos.

Bryan Eversgerd pitched in 25 games for Montreal in 1995...became an Expo via trade with St. Louis (April 5, 1995), packaged with pitcher Kirk Bullinger and outfielder DaRond Stovall to Montreal for pitcher Ken Hill.

Joe Ross' older brother, Tyson Ross, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Max Scherzer is a native of Chesterfield, Mo... graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by St. Louis in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign... pitched at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

Nationals Manager Dave Martinez made his Major League debut vs. St. Louis (June 15, 1986) while with the Chicago Cubs.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster Tim McCarver played in 92 games for Montreal (1972).

Nationals broadcaster Charlie Slowes worked three years at KMOX (1984-86).

Nationals Vice President of International Operations Johnny DiPuglia worked as an area scout for the Cardinals from 1990-98.

TONIGHT’S GAME

- Making his 2nd start of the season and 30th career (136th career appearance).
- Made his first regular season start since 9/26/18 vs. Milwaukee on 4/6 at Miami in his 2021 season debut
- He had made 81 straight relief appearances between his 2018 and 2021 starts (11-4, 3.43 ERA, 3 SV, 23 Holds).
- Enters tonight’s game with a homerless innings streak of 39.1 innings dating back to July 18, 2019, matching the Yankees Zach Britton for the majors longest active homerless streak. Did not allow a home run to 61 total batters faced in 2020. *Elias*
- Is making his first start at Busch Stadium since 9/26/18 (L, 2-1 vs. MIL) He’s 3-8, 4.71 ERA in 16 career starts at Busch, including a 6-4 win vs. the Nationals on 8/14/18.
- In the batters box, has hit two home runs since 8/14/18, T-3rd most among Major League pitchers trailing only Zack Greinke (3) and Steven Matz (3).

2021 SPRING TRAINING

- Made four appearances during the Grapefruit League schedule with the last three as starts. Faced Max Scherzer in his two starts vs. the Nationals (3/5 & 3/15).
- Ranked 4th among Cardinals pitchers with 14.1 innings pitched.

2020 SEASON

- Placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right groin strain suffered vs. Milwaukee (9/25[1]) after facing one batter causing him to miss the postseason.
- Led the Cardinals with 7 Holds.
- Did not allow a home run to 61 total batters faced.
- Stranded all five inherited runners during 2020 season.
- Held opposing batters to an .088 BA (3-34) with no extra base hits on two-strike counts.
- Did not allow a run in seven road appearances (7.2 IP) with two hits, one walk and 12 strikeouts.
- Finished the season with three game losing streak (8/25-end of season), one shy of his career high.

CAREER

- His .621 winning percentage as a member of the Cardinals is the best among teammates with 100 or more appearances over that span (2017-20).
- Made 81 straight relief appearances between his 9/26/18 and 4/6/21 starts.
- Has a career record of 6-10 with 3.88 ERA in 29 career starts and a 13-5 record with a 3.60 ERA and three saves in 106 career relief appearances.
- Missed pitching in the postseason each of the last two years, most recently on the injured list in 2020 and was not added to the postseason roster in 2019.
- Ranks T-3rd among MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins over the last two seasons (2019-20).
- Led all MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins in 2019. The 11 wins by a relief pitcher were the most in the National League since Tyler Clippard (11-8) had 11 for the Nationals in 2010.
- His .917 winning percentage in 2019 was the 3rd-highest among relief pitchers in Major League history (min. 12 decisions) behind Roy Face with the Pirates in 1959 (18-1, .947) and Phil Regan with the Dodgers in 1966 (14-1, .933), while tied with former Cardinals pitcher Eddie Yuhas in 1952 (11-1).
- Tied Eddie Yuhas (1952) for highest winning percentage by a Cardinals pitcher with 10 or more decisions with a .917 mark (11-1) in 2019.
- Became the 8th pitcher in Cardinals history to record double-digit wins in relief posting an 11-1 record in 2019.
- His seven wins prior to the All-Star Break in 2019 were the most by a National League relief pitcher since Tyler Clippard’s eight in 2010 with the Nationals.
- Joined Roy Face (12-0, 1959, PIT), Lew Burdette (7-0, 1953, MIL), Aurelio Lopez (7-0, 1984, DET) and Ron Robinson (7-0, 1986, CIN) as the only pitchers in MLB history with a perfect mark and at least seven wins pre All-Star Break making all relief appearances.
- Was the winning pitcher for the St. Louis Cardinals 10,000th franchise win on June 25, 2018 vs. Cleveland, tossing a 7.0 scoreless IP of one-hit ball in a 4-0 win opposite Mike Clevinger. Allowed his lone hit on an infield single to Yan Gomes in the 2nd inning.
