May 2, 1961: Mickey Mantle goes 2-for-5 with 5RBI in the Yankees' 6-4, 10-inning win at Minnesota's Metropolitan Stadium. With the game tied at 2-2, Mantle hits a two-out grand slam that holds up as the game winner.

May 2, 1939: Lou Gehrig's streak of 2,130 consecutive games played ends when he does not play in the Yankees' 22-2 win vs. the Detroit Tigers at Briggs Stadium. Babe Dahlgren plays first base, contributing a double and a home run.

AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their seven-game homestand today with the second game of a four-game wrap-around series vs. Baltimore (1-0 thus far)...will also face Texas in a three-game set from Tues.-Thurs....went 7-2 on their recent road trip after sweeping the Red Sox in a three-game set and winning two-of-three games against both the Astros and Rangers.

- ▶ **Their 21-11 (.656) record is the best in the American League and the second-best in the Majors**, trailing only Atlanta (23-10, .697).
- ▶ **Have won 11 of their last 13 games (since 4/17), 12 of their last 15 games (since 4/15) and 13 of their last 17 games (since 4/13).**
- ▶ Are a season-high-tying 10 games over .500 (also 10G over .500 at 20-10 on 4/28).
- ▶ Have won or split eight of their 10 completed series this season (7-2-1), including each of their last five (4-0-1).
- ▶ The Yankees' +52 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the third-best in the Majors.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Orioles, 7-2, in their series opener on Friday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Will Warren** (6.1IP, 3H, 2R/1ER, 1BB, 9K, 1HR) earned his fourth win of the year after allowing only 2R/1ER over 6.1IP...**LF Cody Bellinger** (2-for-4, 2 doubles, 1RBI, 1BB) hit a go-ahead RBI double in the first inning...**SS José Caballero** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his fourth HR of the season with a go-ahead solo shot in the second inning...**DH Ben Rice** (2-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI) hit his 11th home run of the year with a three-run shot in the second inning...**3B Amed Rosario** (1-for-3, 1RBI, 1BB) hit an RBI single in the seventh inning...**RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-3, 2R, 1RBI, 2BB) reached base a season-high-tying four times and hit an RBI single in the eighth inning...**Yankees relievers** combined to toss 2.2 scoreless innings (1BB, 3K).

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers have posted a Major League-best 3.05 ERA this season...have allowed only 3R-or-fewer in nine of their last 11 games (since 4/19) and 10 of their last 13 games (since 4/17)...have allowed only 1ER-or-fewer in eight of their last 13 games, posting a 2.11 ERA (115.0IP, 27ER) over that span.

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge reached base a season-high-tying four times and hit an RBI single in the eighth inning on Friday vs. Baltimore...**has reached base multiple times in eight of his last 10 games (since 4/21), hitting .344/.533/.688 (11-for-32) with 9R, 2 doubles, 3HR, 5RBI, 12BB/11BB, 1HP and 1SB.**

- ▶ **Has reached base in 24 of his last 26 games (since 4/3), batting .300/.447/.689 (27-for-90) with 25R, 5 doubles, 10HR, 18RBI, 22BB/11BB, 2HP and 5SB over that span.**
- ▶ **His 12HR this season are tied with Houston's Yordan Alvarez for the second-most in the Majors, trailing only Chicago-AL's Muneeta Murakami (13HR)**...also ranks second in the Majors in pitches per PA (4.50, second in AL), fourth in OPS (1.018, third in AL), fifth in SLG (.623, third in AL) and total bases (71, fourth in AL), tied for fifth in XBH (17, tied for third in AL), runs scored (27, tied for second in AL) and WAR among position players (1.6, tied for fourth in AL - FanGraphs).
- ▶ **Has hit 9HR in his last 18 games (since 4/12).**
- ▶ In 121 career games vs. Baltimore, has hit .324/.460/.733 (137-for-423) with 116R, 20 doubles, 51HR, 110RBI, 101BB/71BB, 7HP, 2SF and 5SB...his 51HR against Baltimore are his most vs. any opponent...marks the most by any Major League player vs. a single opponent since 2017...also marks the most home runs among active players vs. Baltimore.
- ▶ Has reached base safely in 423 of his last 23 games vs. Baltimore (since 5/2/24), hitting .423/.580/.944 (30-for-71) with 22R, 1 double, 12HR, 25RBI, 25BB/31BB, 3HP and 1SF over that span.
- ▶ Has 2HR in his last four games vs. the Orioles (since 9/26/25), 3HR in his last six games (since 9/20/25), 6HR in his last 13 games (since 4/29/25) and 12HR in his last 21 games (since 6/20/24).
- ▶ 17 of his 30H this season have been XBH (12HR, 5 doubles).

SUPER ROSARIO: INF/OF Amed Rosario hit an RBI single in the seventh inning on Friday vs. Baltimore...has hit .375/.400/.938 (6-for-16) with 3HR, 12RBI, 2BB and 2SF with RISP this season.

- ▶ Has reached base safely in 15 of his last 18 games with a PA (since 4/1), batting .281/.333/.544 (16-for-57) with 7R, 1 double, 1 triple, 4HR, 13RBI, 5BB and 1SF over that stretch.

BRONX BOMBERS: Yankees batters hit 2HR on Friday vs. Baltimore...have hit multiple home runs in three of their last four games (since 4/27) and five of their last seven games (since 4/24)...lead the Majors with 50HR this year.

- ▶ Have scored at least 4R in 13 of their last 15 games (since 4/15) and 16 of their last 19 games (since 4/11)...the Yankees are 18-5 this season when scoring at least 4R.

MATCHING UP: The Yankees are 9-1 in their last 10 games vs. Baltimore (since 6/21/25).

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice hit his 11th home run of the year with a three-run shot in the second inning on Friday vs. Baltimore...**has hit 7HR in his last 14 games (since 4/16).**

- ▶ Four of his last five home runs and five of his last seven home runs have come against left-handed pitching...his 5HR vs. lefties this season are tied for the most in the Majors.
- ▶ **Has hit .330/.441/.728 (34-for-103) with 27R, 8 doubles, 11HR, 26RBI, 21BB/21BB, 1HP, 2SF and 15B in 31 games this season**...has reached base safely in 24-of-27 starts.
- ▶ 19 of his 34H this season have gone for extra bases (8 doubles, 11HR).
- ▶ **Has hit 8HR in his last 11 games vs. Baltimore (since 7/14/24)**...has hit .378/.417/1.000 (17-for-45) with 12R, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 8HR, 17RBI, 2BB and 1HP during those games.
- ▶ **Leads the Majors in SLG (.728) and OPS (1.169), ranks second in OBP (.441, second in AL)**, is tied for second in go-ahead RBI (seven, tied for second in AL) and WAR among position players (1.7, tied for second in AL - FanGraphs), third in XBH (19, second in AL), tied for third in total bases (75, tied for second in AL), tied for fourth in HR (11, fourth in AL) and game-winning RBI (five, second in AL), tied for fifth in RBI (26, tied for second in AL) and runs scored (27, tied for second in AL), and eighth in BA (.330, fourth in AL)...ranks eighth in the AL in times on base (56), ninth in PA/BB (6.05) and tied for ninth in walks (21).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a Major League-best 2.70 ERA (183.2IP, 55ER) and 184K in 32 starts this season...have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 12 of their last 13 starts (since 4/17), posting a 1.79 ERA (80.1IP, 16ER) over that span...have tossed at least 6.0IP in 10 of their last 13 starts.

- ▶ Have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 28 of their 32 starts this season.
- ▶ **Have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 21 of their 32 starts, their second-most through their first 32 games of a season in franchise history**, trailing only their 24 starts in 2022.
- ▶ Have tossed at least 6.0IP in 16 of their starts, their most through their first 32 starts of a season since recording 17GS in 2018.
- ▶ **The Yankees have three of the Major's top-10 lowest ERAs:** RHP Cam Schlichter (1.51, second in Majors), LHP Max Fried (2.09, eighth in Majors) and RHP Will Warren (2.39, 10th in Majors).
- ▶ **Lead the Majors in ERA (2.70), opponents' BA (.202), opponents' OBP (.264), opponents' SLG (.319), opponents' OPS (.583) and WHIP (1.00)**, tied for first in strikeouts (184, tied for first in AL), rank second in K/BB (3.76, second in AL) and BB/9.0IP (2.40, second in AL), third in innings pitched (183.2, second in AL) and strikeout rate (25.3%, second in AL), fourth in HR/9.0IP (0.83, third in AL) and eighth in K/9.0IP (9.02, fourth in AL).

DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (12HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (11HR) are only the second pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 11HR in the club's first 32 games of a season, joining Yogi Berra (12HR) and Mickey Mantle (16HR) in 1956.

- ▶ Judge and Rice have combined to hit 23HR this year, more than three Major League teams (San Francisco-19HR, Boston-22HR and Milwaukee-22HR).

WEATHERS REPORT: LHP Ryan Weathers will make his seventh start of the season today...has gone 1-2 with a 3.21 ERA (33.2IP, 12ER) and 40K in six starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in five of his six starts, including 1R-or-fewer in three starts...is tied for sixth in the Majors in K/BB (5.00, tied for fifth in AL) and ranks 10th in K/9.0IP (10.69, fifth in AL).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Yankees batters have scored 27R in the first inning this season, the most in the AL and the second-most in the Majors, trailing only Washington (32R)...their 7HR in the first inning are the fourth-most in the AL and tied for the sixth-most in the Majors...the Yankees have gone 10-4 when scoring in the first inning this year.

- ▶ **The Yankees are 17-3 this season when scoring first.**

HIP HIP JOSÉ: INF/OF José Caballero hit his fourth HR of the season with a go-ahead solo shot in the second inning on Friday vs. Baltimore...has hit 3HR in his last seven games (since 4/24).

- ▶ Has hit 4HR in 31G this year after hitting 5HR in 126G in 2025.
- ▶ Has reached base safely in 15 of his last 17 games (since 4/13), batting .344/.385/.590 (21-for-61) with 10R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 8RBI, 2BB, 2HP and 7SB over that span.

GOOD WILL WARREN: RHP Will Warren earned his fourth win of the year on Friday vs. Baltimore after allowing only 2R/1ER over 6.1IP (3H, 1BB, 9K, 1HR)...has gone 4-0 with a 2.39 ERA (37.2IP, 10ER) and 46K in seven starts this season...the Yankees are 6-1 in his starts this year.

- ▶ Has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of his seven starts this season, the most in the Majors...is only the seventh Yankees pitcher (eighth time) in the last 66 years (since 1961) to allow 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts of a season (excluding openers), joining Max Fried (first 11GS in 2025), Michael King (first 8GS in 2023), Gerrit Cole (first 8GS in 2021 and first 7GS in 2023), Nestor Cortes (first 7GS in 2022), Michael Pineda (first 9GS in 2014) and Hideki Irabu (first 7GS in 1998).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP RYAN WEATHERS (1-2, 3.21 ERA)

LHP Ryan Weathers will make his seventh start of the season today vs. Baltimore...the 26-year-old will make the start on extended six days' rest...made his sixth start of the season on 4/25 at Houston, allowing 2R/ER over 5.1IP without recording a decision (6H, 0BB, 4K, 1HR, 1PO)...has gone 1-2 with a 3.21 ERA (33.2IP, 33H, 12R/ER, 8BB, 40K, 5HR) in six starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in five of his six starts, including 1R-or-fewer in three starts...has recorded at least 7K in four of his starts...went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Miami Marlins in 2025...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA (158.2IP, 148H, 71R/64ER, 44BB, 157K, 23HR) in 30 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 24 of those 30 starts...since 2021, his 18 pickoffs are fourth-most in the Majors...has pitched in over parts of six Major League seasons with the San Diego Padres (2021-23), Miami Marlins (2023-25) and the Yankees (2026)...has made four career Opening Day rosters (2021 and '23 with San Diego, '24 with Miami and '26 with the Yankees)...began the 2025 season on the injured list...is the son of David Weathers, who pitched in parts of 19 seasons in the Majors (1991-2009), including two seasons with the Yankees from 1996-97, where he won the World Series with the club in '96...became the fifth father/son duo in Yankees history to both play for the club, joining Clay Bellinger and Cody Bellinger, Mark Leiter and Mark Leiter Jr., Ron Davis and Ike Davis, and Yogi Berra and Dale Berra...was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the first round (seventh overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...was acquired by Miami from San Diego in exchange for INF Garrett Cooper, RHP Sean Reynolds and cash considerations on 8/1/23...was acquired by the Yankees from Miami in exchange for OF Dillon Lewis, OF Brendan Jones, INF Dylan Jasso and INF Juan Matheus on 1/13/26.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his sixth start of the season on 4/25 at Houston, allowing 2R/ER over 5.1IP without recording a decision (6H, 0BB, 4K, 1HR, 1PO)...retired 12 of his first 14BF (2H).

HOME SWEET HOME: In four starts at Yankee Stadium this season, has gone 1-2 with a 3.38 ERA (24.0IP, 23H, 9R/ER, 6BB, 29K, 4HR)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in three of his four starts.

- ✦ Made his first start at Yankee Stadium with the Yankees on 4/4 vs. Miami, allowing 3R/ER over 3.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 3BB, 4K, 0HR).
- ✦ Made three starts at home with the Marlins in 2025, going 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0IP, 15H, 5R/ER, 3BB, 15K, 2HR)...tossed at least 5.0 innings in all three starts...allowed 1R-or-fewer in two of his three starts.
- ✦ **Over the last two seasons (2025-26), has gone 2-3 with a 3.15 ERA (40.0IP, 38H, 14R/ER, 9BB, 44K, 6HR) in seven home starts.**

2026: Has gone 1-2 with a 3.21 ERA (33.2IP, 33H, 12R/ER, 8BB, 40K, 5HR) in six starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in five of his six starts, including 1R-or-fewer in three starts...has recorded at least 7K in four of his starts.

- ✦ Among Major League pitchers this season, is tied for sixth in K/BB ratio (5.00, tied for fifth in AL) and ranks 10th in K/9.0IP (10.69, fifth in AL)...also ranks seventh in the AL in strikeout rate (29.2%) and tied for 10th in strikeouts (40).
- ✦ Has received 2R-or-fewer of run support in five of his six starts this season, including 0R of support in his first four starts (3/30-4/14), recording a 2.41 run support average this year.
- ✦ Made his Yankees debut on 3/30 at Seattle, allowing only 1R/ER over 4.1IP without recording a decision (4H, 2BB, 7K, 0HR).
- ✦ Made his second start of the season on 4/4 vs. Miami, allowing 3R/ER over 3.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 3BB, 4K, 0HR).
- ✦ Made his third start of the season on 4/9 vs. the Athletics, suffering his first loss of the year despite allowing 1R/ER in 8.0IP (7H, 1R/ER, 0BB, 7K, 0HR, 1WP)...set a career high with 101 pitches and tied his career high with 8.0IP (also 5/14/24 at Detroit with Miami)...became the first Yankee to toss at least 8.0 innings and not allow a walk in a regular season game since Clarke Schmidt on 5/16/24 at Minnesota (8.0IP).
- ✦ Made his fourth start of the season on 4/14 vs. Los Angeles-AL, taking the loss after allowing 5R/ER in 5.0IP (5H, 2BB, 10K, 4HR, 1WP)...recorded his third career double-digit strikeout game (also a career-high 11K on 6/1/24 vs. Texas with Miami and 10K on 4/16/24 vs. San Francisco with Miami)...marked the first double-digit strikeout game by a Yankee since Max Fried recorded 13K on 9/18/25 at Baltimore.
- ✦ Earned his first win as a Yankee after tossing 7.1 scoreless innings on 9/18 vs. Kansas City (5H, 1BB, 8K)...recorded his first scoreless start of the season and first scoreless start since 9/11/25 vs. Washington with Miami (5.0IP)...also marked the second-longest scoreless start of his career, trailing only his career-high-tying 8.0 scoreless innings on 5/14/24 at Detroit with Miami.

VS. BALTIMORE: Will make his first career start vs. the Orioles today.

2025: Went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Marlins...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts.

- ✦ Missed the first 41 games of the season on the injured list...was placed on the 15-day I.L. on 3/27 (retroactive to 3/24) with a left flexor muscle strain...combined to make three rehab starts with Single-A Jupiter and Triple-A Jacksonville, going 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2IP, 4H, 2R/ER, 4BB, 13K, 0HR)...was reinstated from the I.L. on 5/14.
- ✦ Made his season debut on 5/14 at Chicago-NL and earned the win (5.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 5K, 1HR).
- ✦ Went 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA (15IP, 2ER) and 15K over his first three starts (5/14-26).
- ✦ Was placed on the 60-day I.L. on 6/9 (left lat strain), missing 83 team games...made two rehab starts with Triple-A Jacksonville, posting a 2.45 ERA (7.1IP, 9H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 9K, 1HR)...was returned from rehab and reinstated on 9/11.

WEATHERS REPORT: Over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA (158.2IP, 148H, 71R/64ER, 44BB, 157K, 23HR) in 30 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 24 of those 30 starts.
