



Pittsburgh Pirates (13-13) vs. San Francisco Giants (12-14)

TODAY'S GAME: Fresh from a rare home off day in the middle of a homestand, the Giants have reached the final series of their longest homestand of the year as they welcome in the Pittsburgh Pirates for three games beginning tonight.

- ▶ SF is 4-3 through the first seven games of its 10-game homestand after going 2-2 vs. Arizona last weekend and taking two-of-three from the Mets Monday through Wednesday... the Giants had a chance to sweep the Mets on Wednesday afternoon but fell in the finale, 8-2.
- ▶ The Giants enter this series having gone 2-0-1 in their last three series (series wins at Miami and versus the Mets and a series split with the D-Backs).
- ▶ Only one Giant has faced today's Pirates starter RHP Quinn Priester, who made his debut last April... **DH Jorge Soler** went 2-for-2 with a double and was hit by a pitch last year vs. Priester while playing for Miami

PIRATES BOOTY: The Giants have won 10 of their last 13 games vs. the Pirates dating to July 25, 2021, their most wins in a 13-game span over the Buccos since a 10-3 stretch from 2009-11... the last time SF took 11-of-14 from the Pirates was 2000-2002 (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ However, the Giants have lost three of their last four series to the Pirates here in SF dating to the 2019... the lone series win was a three-game sweep of the Pirates here in 2022.
- ▶ Oddly enough, the Pirates are one of just two National League opponents the Giants do not have a winning record against in this ballpark since it opened in 2000... the other team is the Los Angeles Dodgers (104-107).

HARRY...I TOOK CARE OF IT?: LHP Kyle Harrison takes the hill for his sixth start of the season looking to improve from his shortest outing of the season (4.0ip) vs. Arizona on Saturday.

- ▶ He's facing the Pirates for the first time in his career... not one player on the Pirates has logged a plate appearance against Harrison in the regular season.
- ▶ The 22-year-old lefty has been very reliant on his four-seam fastball this year, throwing it 68% of the time... 17 of his 24 strikeouts this year have come on the pitch.
- ▶ Something to keep an eye on is how he fares the second time through the lineup... in his first five starts this year he's allowed a 1.074 OPS the second time through after limiting the opposition to a .661 OPS the first time through.
- ▶ Through his 12 career MLB appearances (five this year, seven last year), Harrison has struck out 59 batters... since 1901, that is tied for second-most by a Giants lefty through the first 12 games of their career with **LHP Shawn Estes**... only **LHP Andrew Suárez** (61) had more in his first 12 games.

WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. has reached base in 20 of 24 games where he's had an at-bat this season, and is slashing .368/.471/.491 with 11 runs, four doubles, a home run and seven RBI on the year overall.

- ▶ His .368 batting average and .471 OBP are both second in MLB (min. 65 PA) trailing LAD's Mookie Betts, who has a .374 average and a .477 OBP.
- ▶ He's reached base safely in 11 of his 13 career games vs. the Pirates since first facing them in 2021... he's slashing .357/.438/.857 against the Buccos in those 13 games with nine runs scored, four doubles, one triple, five homers and eight RBI.

CAN I GET YOUR CONTACT INFO?: OF Jung Hoo Lee enters today's game with a 91.1% contact rate that ranks fourth in the Majors.

- ▶ His 8.6% strikeout rate entering play today is the lowest among qualified Major Leaguers.
- ▶ Lee has rarely swung and missed through his first month of play in the Majors... he's seen a total of 385 pitches and swung and missed just 16 times (or 4.2% of the time)... only three Major Leaguers that have seen 300+ pitches this year have a lower percentage than Lee does.

FIELD DAY: Through 26 games the Giants defense has been worth +12 Outs Above Average according to *Statcast*, best in the Majors just ahead of Toronto and Texas (both with nine).

- ▶ The Giants finished last season at +14 OAA, ninth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ Looking at *Fangraphs* Defensive Runs Saved metric, the Giants enter today at +5, tied for 11th best... they finished the 2023 season at -15 DRS, tied for 22nd of 30 MLB clubs.

WOOSAH: The Giants bullpen has logged a 5.92 ERA through their first 26 games... the 5.92 bullpen ERA is the highest in the Majors entering play today (the Phillies are next closest at 5.85).

- ▶ Last season, the Giants 'pen had a 6.15 ERA through their first 26 games (28th of 30 MLB teams)... for context, however, SF's 25th and 26th games last year were played at elevation in México City that wasn't totally pitcher friendly... SF's pen had a 5.42 ERA through 24 games before going to CDMX and had a 6.15 ERA after two games there.
- ▶ The point being that from May 1 through the end of last season, the Giants 'pen had a 3.53 ERA that was fifth-best in the Majors (fourth-best in the NL).

KEEP IT UP FELLAS: Giants starters have logged a 0.90 ERA (2er, 20.0ip) over their last four games, SF's best four-game span for starters (min. 20.0ip) since June 13-17, 2022 when they logged a 0.75 ERA.

- ▶ The starters in this stretch have been **RHPs Jordan Hicks, Keaton Winn, Logan Webb** and **Ryan Walker**, who started the bullpen game on Wednesday.

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season today in the first game of this three-game series against the Pirates...Harrison is 2-1 with a 5.00 ERA (15er, 27.0ip) in his five starts this season.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

LAST TIME OUT: Lasted just 4.0 innings while allowing three runs on six hits and a walk last Saturday vs. Arizona in SF's 7-3 victory...marked his second-shortest start of his young career.

FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues...opposing hitters are 16-for-37 (.432) with three homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 15-for-70 (.214) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 68.0% of the time, highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches.

THE LONGBALL: Has served up at least one home run in four of his five starts this season, giving up five total in his 27.0 innings.

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited the walks through his first five starts, allowing just five free passes in 27.0 innings...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings...his 4.4% walk rate this season is 13th-lowest in MLB among qualifiers.

MORE FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, one career stat for Harrison that stands out is that his first time through the order, he has 34 strikeouts vs. 108 batters faced...other times through the order, he has just 25 strikeouts out of 153 batters faced.

LOTS OF PUNCHOUTS: Has struck out 59 batters in his first 12 big league games...according to *Stats, LLC*, since 1901, that is tied for the second-most strikeouts by any left-hander for the Giants through the first 12 games of a career (**Shawn Estes**) behind **Andrew Suarez** (61).

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the southpaw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since **Madison Bumgarner** in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/23 vs. NYM; S, 0.2ip, k (5 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made seven appearances and gone 1-0-4 with three hits allowed, one run allowed, three walks, and 12 strikeouts (7.0ip).
- ▶ Nine of his 12 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/24 vs. NYM; L, 2.2ip, 2h, 3r, 3er, bb, 2k, 2hr (37p)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...made season debut last Sunday, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made five rehab appearances between San Jose (A) and Sacramento (AAA)...threw 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits with seven strikeouts.
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/24 vs. NYM; 1.0ip, h (12 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on Monday...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Was placed on the IL the next day...made two rehab appearances for Single-A San Jose totalling 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Wednesday's outing against the Mets was his first appearance since being reinstated from the IL.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/24 vs. NYM; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last nine outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs over 9.1 innings (2.89 ERA) with 14 strikeouts, one walk, a 0.54 WHIP and a .129 opposing batting average (4x31).
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-16 off him early on...RHBs are 4-for-25.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 4/24 vs. NYM; 1.0ip, h (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in nine games for SF so far, allowing two runs over 7.1 innings of work with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Pitched only twice over the last nine days.
- ▶ Is 6-2 with a 2.80 ERA, 68 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP since April 18 of last season (62 games, 54.2 innings).
- ▶ Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- ▶ Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- ▶ His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/23 vs. NYM; 0.1ip, 3h, r, er (14 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in 12 of SF's first 26 games.
