GAME #34..... ROAD #18	TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Red Sox play the 2nd game of this 3-game weekend series here at Fenway Park this afternoon... RHP Spencer Arrighetti (3-0) will start for the Astros vs. BOS LHP Connelly Early (2-1)...the Astros will be facing Early for the 1st time in his young career.
ABOUT THE RECORD:	LOTS OF LEFTIES: The Astros are scheduled to face LH starters in all 3 games of this series...the last time they faced a LH starter in all games of a 3-game series was April 30-May 2, 2021 vs. TB (almost exactly 5 years ago)...the last time that HOU has faced 3 consecutive LH starters overall was Sept. 19-21, 2024 vs. LAA (4-game series).
Overall Record:..... 12-21	SPENCER'S GIFTS: After starting the season at Triple A Sugar Land, RHP Spencer Arrighetti has been strong in his 3 starts for the Astros this season...he is 3-0 with a 2.00 ERA (4ER/18IP) with 9 BB and 21 SO and a .169 opp. avg...in his last start on Sunday vs. NYY, he allowed just 3 hits and 1 run in 7.0 IP with 8 strikeouts (7-4 win).
Home Record:..... 8-8	SUCCESS VS. THE SOX: RHP Spencer Arrighetti has had success in his previous 2 starts vs. the Red Sox...in those 2 starts combined, Red Sox hitters are just 3x38 (.079) vs. him...in his Fenway Park debut on Aug. 10, 2024, Arrighetti tallied a career-high 13 strikeouts en route to a 5-4 win (7 IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 1 BB, 13 SO)...on Aug. 12 of last season, Arrighetti allowed just 1 hit in 5.0 IP vs. BOS, but took the loss in what ended in a 14-1 Red Sox win (5 IP, 1 H, 2 ER, 5 BB, 3 SO).
--with Roof Open:..... --	ROADIES: Today is the 5th game (1-3 thus far) of a 6-game road trip for the Astros...HOU was 1-2 in BAL on the first stop of the trip.
--with Roof Closed:..... 8-8	DAYTIMERS: As a result of Wednesday night's rainout in BAL, 4 of the 6 games on the Astros current road trip will be day games...HOU ended their last homestand with a day game, so they will have played 5 of 7 games in the daytime once they complete this road trip.
Road Record:..... 4-13	VS THE SAWX: The Astros swept the Red Sox in a 3-game series at Daikin Park earlier this season, Mar. 30-April 1...over the past 10 seasons (since 2017), HOU is 33-23 (.589) vs. BOS overall.

Lost 1	FUN AT FENWAY: Despite being swept in a 3-game series in their last visit here (Aug. 1-3), the Astros have had recent success at Fenway Park...HOU has won 6 of their last 10 games at the Fens... prior to last year's series in Aug., HOU had swept the Red Sox in 2 consecutive visits to Fenway, Aug. 28-30 of 2023 and Aug. 9-11 of 2024 (both 3-game series)...additionally, the Astros are 16-10 (.615) in the regular season at Fenway Park since 2017...Houston is also 4-3 at Fenway all-time in the postseason... YORDAN AT FENWAY: In 13 career reg. season games at Fenway, Yordan Alvarez is hitting .438 (21x48) with 7 HR and 16 RBI with a 1.529 OPS...his career OPS, SLG (.979) and OBP (.550) at Fenway are the best all-time (min. 50 PA).

HIT PARADE: The Astros, who lead the AL in batting (.267), have reached double-figures in hits in each of the last 3 games, going 38x118 (.322) in that span...last night marked the 14th game in which HOU reached double figures in hits in 2026.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH?: Yordan Alvarez is a strong candidate for the AL Player of the Month Award for March/April as he has had a torrid start to his season, hitting .341 with 12 HR and 27 RBI...Alvarez currently leads the AL in RBI (27), TB (87) and OBP (.446) while ranking 2nd in batting avg. (.341), SLG (.707) and OPS (1.153) and T-2nd in HR (12).

HISTORIC HOMERS: **Yordan Alvarez** is off to one of the most prolific starts in franchise history... his 12 HR through the club's first 33 games of the season are the T2nd-most in franchise history... below is a breakdown:

ROAD WARRIOR: In 12 road games (9 starts) this season, **Brice Matthews** is 11x35 (.314) with a HR, 7 RBI and 5 BB, slashing (.313/400/486) for an .886 OPS...in his young career, Matthews is hitting .288 in 19 road games (15 starts) with 5 HR and 16 RBI with a .373 OBP and a .593 SLG (.966 OPS).

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With 238 career HR as a second basemen, **Jose Altuve** needs one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for 7th place all-time among 2nd basemen...Altuve also needs 3 RBI to become the 5th player in franchise history to reach 900.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **Christian Walker** is hitting .375 (15x40) in his last 10 games (since 4/20) with 3 HR and 8 RBI...**Among The Leaders:** For the season, Walker enters today ranked T-7th in the AL in RBI (24), 7th in SLG (.546), 5th in TB (65), 9th in OPS (.917) and T-6th in doubles (9).

LAST START, APRIL 26 vs. NYY: made his 3rd Major League start of the 2026 season on Sunday vs. the Yankees...picked up the win after working 7.0 innings, while allowing 1 run on 3 hits, 1 walk and a HBP...fanned 8 in the outing...allowed his only run on a solo homer to Aaron Judge.

SPAGHETTI DAY: the 3rd-year starter has dominated in his Major League action this season, going 3-0 in 3 starts with a 2.00 ERA (4ER/18IP), while fanning 21 in 18.0 innings and allowing a miniscule .169 (11x65) opponent average...leads the Astros with 3 wins on the young season...his 3-game winning streak is the longest of his career...began the season at Triple A Sugar Land before being recalled on April 15.

DOWN IN SUGAR LAND: broke camp with Triple A Sugar Land and posted a 1.26 ERA (2ER/14.1IP), 0.77 WHIP and .111 opponent batting average, with 20 strikeouts, through 3 starts with the Space Cowboys...on the date of his recall from Triple A (April 15), he ranked 1st in the PCL in strikeouts and 2nd in ERA, WHIP and opponent batting average.

SAVANT SAYS: ranks in the 98th percentile in extension (7.4), 84th percentile in whiff percentage (31.1) and 76th percentile in strikeout percentage (26.9).

RACKING UP K'S: has 21 strikeouts in his 18.0 innings pitched this season, which included a 10-strikeout game in his season debut on April 15 vs. COL...his 10 strikeouts are the most strikeouts in a game by an Astros pitcher this season and marked his 5th career game with 10+ strikeouts (last: 11 strikeouts on Aug. 11, 2024 at PHI).

STRIKEOUT PACE: his 223 career strikeouts are 3rd-most through a player's first 39 career appearances in Astros history, trailing only **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (258) and **RHP Tom Griffin** (229).

VS. BOS: has started against the Red Sox twice in his career, going 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (4ER/12IP) in those games...picked up his win in a start at Fenway Park on Aug. 10, 2024 (2ER/7IP), a start in which he fanned a career high 13 hitters...last faced the Red Sox on Aug. 12, 2025 in Houston (2ER/5IP).

2025 SEASON: battled through a pair of IL stints in his 2nd season in the Majors, missing 105 team games due to a broken right thumb from April 7-Aug. 6, and then the final 26 games of the regular season due to right elbow inflammation...held opponents to a .229 average through his 7 starts, also recording a 5.35 ERA (21ER/35.1IP), 1.415 WHIP and 7.9 SO/9IP...was fantastic at Daikin Park, recording a 2.08 ERA (4ER/17.1IP) and .056 opponent average (3x54) in his 3 home starts.

ABOUT ARRIGHETTI: grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to the Houston suburb of Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School, located approximately 30 miles from Daikin Park...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette and was routinely ranked as one of the club's top pitching prospects in ascent through the minors...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

VS. BOS: In 10 career appearances against the Red Sox, he's recorded a 2.45 ERA (3ER/11IP) with 14 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 1.09 WHIP and a .220 opponent batting average.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...next on the all-time list is **RHP Xavier Hernandez** at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (464) and 7th in apps. (328).

CAREER: In 328 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.92 ERA (110ER/339IP) with 464 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.32 K/9 and a 0.77 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

MULTI-INNING MAN: A starter throughout his minor league career, has 7 multi-inning outings among his 13 appearances this season...among AL relievers, ranks T-2nd in innings pitched (18.1).

VS. BOS: Has made 1 career appearance against the Red Sox, struck out 1 in 1.0 scoreless inning on April 1, 2026 at Daikin Park.

CHANGING THINGS UP: Has tossed his changeup at a 26.9-percent rate, which would be a career-high usage for the pitch...used his changeup at a 19.3-percent rate as a rookie in 2025...has held opponents to a .167 average (4x24) with his changeup this season.
