**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue a 10-day, three-city road trip through Atlanta (0-1, 2 to play), Minnesota (3 to play) and Pittsburgh (3 to play) tonight at Truist Park...are 8-9 in their last 17 games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...are 8-15 since May 19 after going 11-4 in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...are 2-6 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26...the Rays have spent the entire season to this point within four games of .500.

★ The Rays yielded a season-high five runs in the opening frame last night, their most since June 27, 2023 at AZ (5)...they allowed seven runs in the first two innings for the first time since Sept. 11, 2022 at NYY (10)...after starter Zack Littell departed after 2.0 innings, Tampa Bay's bullpen followed with 6.0 shutout frames, their most in a game June 30, 2023 at SEA (6.0).

★ Over their last four games, 11 of the Rays 14 runs have come in the 7th inning or later...this, after going a season-high six consecutive games without plating a run from the 7th frame on from June 4-10.

★ Since May 1, the Rays are 17-5 when scoring 4+ runs and 2-15 with three or fewer...the have won seven of their last eight games when scoring 4+ times.

★ The Rays 12-6 (.667) mark in Interleague play is tied with the Yankees for second best in the majors behind the Phillies (11-4/.733)...they are 7-2 in their last nine games against NL opponents...since the beginning of 2021, their .635 (.66-38) Interleague winning pct. ranks second behind the Dodgers (.65-34/.657).

★ Tampa Bay's 33-37 record is its worst through 70 games since 2018 (32-38)...the Rays are looking to avoid falling five games below .500 for the first time since entering play on June 23, 2018 (35-40).

★ Tonight, the Rays will become the first major league club to wear their City Connect jerseys on the road...they will also don the threads on Aug. 7 at St. Louis...Tampa Bay has posted a 6-3 record in its City Connects since debuting them on May 3.

**PEP IN HIS STEP**—Rays starter Ryan Pepiot is 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER), 0.61 WHIP, 26 strikeouts and no walks through his first three road starts...all three runs allowed came in the opening frame on June 4 at Miami...he joins AZ Randy Johnson (2007) and NYY Mike Mussina (2001) as the only pitchers since 1901 to record 25+ SO and 0 BB in their first three road starts with a franchise...Pepiot is the first pitcher since at least 1901 to record 7+ SO and no walks in each of his first three road starts of a season.

★ Pepiot has tallied 8+ SO without issuing a walk in back-to-back starts, the first Ray to do so since Ryan Yarbrough (Aug. 11-17, 2019)...the club record is three straight starts, held by today's Braves starter, Charlie Morton (Aug. 5-16, 2019), and Chris Archer (May 27-June 7, 2015)...the last major league pitcher to accomplish the feat in three straight outings was TOR Kevin Gausman (4GS) from April 14-May 1, 2022.

**ROAD TRIPPIN'**—The Rays have won three of their last four road games and are 7-4 over their last 11 road contests following a 7-10 start...their .636 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) ranks third in MLB behind the Yankees (13-3/.813) and Orioles (10-5/.667)...the Rays have played the fewest road games in MLB (28), with the Mets (29) being the next closest club...however, last night commenced a stretch in which 15 of their 21 games will take place in visiting ballparks.

★ José Caballero is batting .321 (27-for-84) on the road, second in the AL behind HOU Yordan Alvarez (.328)...he owns a .200 (24-for-120) average at home.

★ Isaac Paredes is batting .317 (33-for-104) as a visitor, fifth best in the AL...he is slashing .367/.406/.533 (22-for-60) during a career-long 15-game road on-base streak, the fourth-longest active streak in the AL behind KC Salvador Perez (31G), TEX Corey Seager (19G) and HOU Yordan Alvarez (17G)...the last Ray with a longer single-season streak was Yandy Diaz (19G) from July 27-Sept. 13 (G1), 2022.

★ Paredes also has a career-long eight-game road hitting streak.

★ Amed Rosario is 16-for-35 (.457) with 5 XBH during a nine-game road hitting streak.

**CARDIAC KIDS**—The Rays 19 comeback wins are tied with three other clubs (BAL, MIL, PHI) for third most in the majors behind the Nationals and Yankees (both 20)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in eight of its last nine wins, including four multi-run comebacks in its last five victories...the Rays have recorded 10 wins after trailing by multiple runs, tied for second most in MLB behind the Twins (12), per Elias...they have faced a multi-run deficit at some point in six straight, 11 of 13, and 19 of their last 24 games...57.6 pct. of their victories have been comeback wins, the highest percentage in the AL.

★ The Rays have scored first in just three of their last 12 games, going 5-7 in that stretch...their 16 wins after conceding the opening tally are tied with the Mets and Nationals for second most in the majors behind the Yankees (18).

★ Tampa Bay has held a lead entering the 7th inning just three times in its last 24 games since May 18, but has managed a 9-15 record over that span.

★ The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (1st, 9), seven (1st, 7) and eight (T2nd, 4) frames.

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—The Rays own the best record in the majors in both one-run games (13-5/.722) and games decided by two runs or fewer (23-10/.692)...they are 14-4 in their last 18 games decided by two runs or fewer and have won seven of eight and nine of their last 11 one-run contests.

**THE CHAMP IS HERE**—Yandy Diaz is riding a season-high 17-game on-base streak, batting .279/.351/.338 (19-for-68) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 5 RBI, 8 BB and 10 SO...it marks the fourth-longest active streak in the AL and fifth longest in the majors...it signals his longest streak since a career-high-tying 22-game run from April 27-May 28, 2023...Isaac Paredes (18G, April 28-May 19) owns the longest on-base streak by a Ray this season.

★ Diaz's has six multi-hit efforts in his last 10 games since June 4, tied with three others for the most in the majors over that span.

**HOMER (UN)HAPPY**—The Rays have allowed 93 HR, tied with the White Sox for the most in the majors...they are 14-3 when holding the opposition homerless compared to 19-34 when yielding 1+ HR...Rays batters have recorded the fewest homers in the majors (53), marking their third-fewest long balls through 70 games in club history, ahead of only the 2014 and 2003 squads (both 50HR)...the club is 26-15 when out-homer the opponent or homers are even and 7-22 when being out-homered.

★ The Rays have collected 13 wins without the benefit of hitting a home run, tied with the Brewers and Giants for the most in MLB.

**IN THE ATL**—The Rays and Braves meet for their lone series of 2024 this weekend...Tampa Bay is 6-7 against Atlanta since 2020...this marks the Rays fourth series at Truist Park since the ballpark opened in 2017, earning a series win and two splits in the previous sets...the Rays have not played in Atlanta since July 16-18, 2021, when they won the series opener and rubber match...the Rays claimed the first game in extra innings and overcame a 3-0 deficit to win the finale.

★ The Rays are 16-27 (.372) all-time against the Braves...it marks their second-worst winning pct. against a single opponent, ahead of a 7-14 (.333) record against the Reds...the Rays went 0-7 from the start of their inaugural season through July 16, 2000, but have gone 16-20 in the last 36 games...the 43 all-time meetings are their second most against any NL opponent behind Miami (137).

★ Yandy Diaz is 13-for-34 (.382) in nine career games against Atlanta.

★ Braves RHP Charlie Morton pitched two seasons for the Rays, making one of his two All-Star appearances in 2019 before helping the club to a World Series appearance in 2020.

★ C Alex Jackson was traded to the Braves in 2016 and made his MLB debut with them in 2019 after progressing through their farm system...he appeared in 19 games with Atlanta over three seasons before being dealt to the Marlins for OF Adam Duvall at the 2021 trade deadline.

★ RHP Taj Bradley grew up in Stone Mountain, GA rooting for the Braves...he is friends with Braves OF Michael Harris II, who also hails from DeKalb County...OF Josh Lowe was also a Braves fan while growing up in Marietta, GA.

★ RHP Matt McWilliams, uncle of LHP Garrett Cleavinger, played for Short-A Eugene in the Braves system in 1995.

★ Rays LHP Colin Poche and Braves OF Brian Anderson were teammates at the University of Arkansas from 2013-14.

★ Rays INF Brandon Lowe hit his first career home against the Braves on Aug. 28, 2018 (Julio Teheran).

★ Braves RHP Hurston Waldrep pitched at the University of Florida in 2023.

★ Braves RHP Jimmy Herget, who is currently on the 15-day IL, hails from Tampa and is a University of South Florida product.

★ Atlanta C Travis d'Arnaud appeared in 92 games for the Rays in 2019.

★ Braves C Sean Murphy attended Wright State (OH) University, the same school as Bally Sports Sun announcer Brian Anderson...Wright State has produced eight major leaguers in its history, including former Ray Carlos Peña.

★ Tampa Bay and Atlanta faced off in the first game at Tropicana Field on March 27, 1998, an exhibition that saw the Devil Rays claim a 5-0 win...Hall of Famer Tom Glavine started for the Braves.

**TODAY'S START**—Pepiot will take the mound for his 12th start of the season today, including his fourth on the road...was on the 15-day IL from May 6-22 (lower left leg contusion) after being struck by a 107.5 mph comebacker off the bat of NYM **Starling Marte** on May 5...has a 4.98 ERA (21.2IP, 12ER) in four starts since being reinstated...is seeking his fourth straight quality start on the road.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Suffered the loss on June 10 vs. Baltimore...allowed four runs on a career-high nine hits with zero walks and nine strikeouts...allowed a leadoff homer to **Gunnar Henderson**...**James McCann** led off the 3rd inning with a solo shot...**Ryan O'Hearn** recorded a two-run double in the 5th frame...completed the outing with three strikeouts in the 6th inning, working around a **Colton Cowser** single...has recorded 7+ SO in a career-high three straight outings.

**NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?**—Pepiot is set to make his first career start against the Braves...has made two starts against the NL East this season (May 5 vs. NYM & June 4 at MIA), going 1-0 with a 6.75 ERA (8.0IP, 6ER) and 11 SO against 1 BB in those outings.

✦ He has made five career appearances (4GS) opposite the NL East, four of which came against the Marlins...is 3-0 with a 3.12 ERA (26.0IP, 9ER) and 26 SO across the five outings.

**ROAD WARRIOR**—He has earned a victory in each of his three road starts, posting a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) with 26 strikeouts against zero walks...he joins **AZ Randy Johnson** (2007) and **NY Y Mike Mussina** (2001) as the only pitchers since 1901 to record 25+ SO and 0 BB in their first three road starts with a franchise.

✦ He is the first pitcher in franchise history to throw 6.0+ innings and issue zero walks in each of his first three road starts of a season.

✦ Pepiot is the 10th pitcher in club history to record three straight quality starts on the road to begin a season, including the first since **Tyler Glasnow** (4QS, April 5-May 3, 2019).

✦ He has 7+ SO in each of his three road outings, marking the longest season-opening streak by a Ray since **Brendan McKay** (3GS, July 13-G1-Aug. 13, 2019).

✦ Prior to his start on June 4 at MIA, he had thrown 6.0+ scoreless innings with no walks in each of his first two road starts, becoming the fifth pitcher since 1901 to accomplish the feat, joining **DET Tarik Skubal** (2024), **MIL Corbin Burnes** (2021), **SF Johnny Cueto** (2018) and **PIT Deacon Phillippe** (1902).

✦ In eight starts at Tropicana Field this season, Pepiot is 1-3 with a 5.36 ERA (40.1IP, 24ER) and 42 strikeouts against 16 walks.

**IN CONTROL**—Pepiot has 8+ SO without issuing a walk in back-to-back starts, marking the first time a Tampa Bay starter has done so since **Ryan Yarbrough** (Aug. 11-17, 2019).

✦ He is one of four pitchers in the majors to accomplish the feat this season, joining **CWS Erick Fedde**, **BOS Nick Pivetta** and **ATL Chris Sale**...no starter this year has done so in three straight starts.

**HEAT CHECK**—Pepiot has held opponents to a 13-for-103 (.126) clip on his four-seamer, recording 42 of his 69 SO on the pitch...the .126 average is the lowest mark on any individual pitch in MLB (min. 100AB ending with pitch), ahead of **NY Y Luis Gil's** four-seam fastball (.134) and **CWS Garrett Crochet's** four-seamer (.142).

✦ He has produced a 36.3 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the second-highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball (min. 250 swings), trailing only **OAK Mason Miller's** four-seamer (41.0%).

**WHIFF YOU PLEASE**—Min. 750 swings, Pepiot's 31.2 pct. whiff rate ranks third in the AL behind **DET Jack Flaherty** (34.9%) and **CWS Garrett Crochet** (32.2%)...he had a 32.7 pct. whiff rate prior to his IL stint (7GS) compared to 28.7 pct. since his return (4GS).

**2ND FRAME FEATS**—Pepiot has not allowed a run in the 2nd inning, limiting opponents to 3-for-35 (.086) with 15 SO...among AL pitchers to have faced at 30 batters in the 2nd frame, his .086 opp. AVG is second lowest behind **HOU Ronel Blanco** (.075/3-for-40).

**LIMIT THE LEFTIES**—In his first six starts, Pepiot held left-handed hitters to a .193 (11-for-57) AVG...he has allowed them to hit .229 (11-for-48) with 2 2B, 2 3B and 2 HR in five starts since.
