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RAY REPORT-The Rays continue a 10-day, three-city road trip through Atlanta ( $0-1,2$ to play), Minnesota (3 to play) and Pittsburgh (3 to play) tonight at Truist Park....are $8-9$ in he 15 gee $11-4$ in their previous 15 cons 18 . $2-6$ so far during a stretch of 10 amin 20 days from 7 -26 the Rays have spent the entire season to this point within four games of .500

The Rays yielded a season-high five runs in the opening frame last night, their most since June 27,2023 at AZ (5)..they allowed seven runs in the first two departed after 2.0 innings, Tampa Bay's bullpen followed with 6.0 shutout frames, their most in a game June 30, 2023 at SEA (6.0)
Over their last four games, 11 of the Rays 14 runs have come in the 7th inning or later...this, after going a season-high six consecutive games without plating a run from the 7th frame on from June 4-10.
Since May 1, the Rays are 17-5 when scoring 4+ runs and 2-15 with three or fewer.. the have won seven of their last eight games when scoring $4+$ times.
The Rays 12-6 (.667) mark in Interleague play is tied with the Yankees for second best in the majors behind the Phillies (11-4/.733)...they are 7-2 in their last nine games against NL opponents...since the beginning of 2021, their . 635 (66-38) Interleague winning pct. ranks second behind the Dodgers (65-34/.657).
Tampa Bay's $33-37$ record is its worst through 70 games since 2018 ( 32 -38)...the Rays are looking to avoid falling five games below .500 for the first time since entering play on June 23, 2018 (35-40).
Tonight, the Rays will become the first major league club to wear their City Connect erseys on the road...they will also don the threads on Aug. 7 at St. Louis...Tampa

IN HIS STEP-Rays starter Ryan Pepiot is $3-0$ with a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP 3ER), 0.61 WHIP 26 strikeouts and no walks through his first three road starts all three runs allowed came in the opening frame on June 4 at Miami...he joins AZ Randy Johnson (2007) and NYY Mike Mussina (2001) as the only pitchers since 1901 to record $25+$ SO and 0 BB in their first three road starts with a franchise...Pepiot is the first pitcher since at least 1901 to record $7+$ SO and no walks in each of his first three road starts of a season. Pepiot has tallied 8+ SO without issuing a walk in back-to-back starts, the first Ray to do so since Ryan Yarbrough (Aug. 11-17, 2019)...the club record is three straight starts, held by today's Braves starter, Charlie Morton (Aug. 5-16, 2019), and Chris Archer (May 27-June 7, 2015)..the last major league pitcher to accomplish the feat
in three straight outings was TOR Kevin Gausman (4GS) from April 14-May 1, 2022.

ROAD TRIPPIN'-The Rays have won three of their last four road games and are 7-4 over their last 11 road contests following a $7-10$ start...their 636 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) ranks third in MLB behind the Yankees (13-3/.813) and Orioles (10-5/.667)...the Rays have played the fewest road games in MLB (28), with the Mets (29) being the next closest club...however, last night co
their 21 games will take place in visiting ballparks.

DOWN TO THE WIRE-The Rays own the best record in the maiors in both one-run games (13-5/.722) and games decided by two runs or fewer (23-10).697...they are 14-4 in of their last 11 one-run contests.

THE CHAMP IS HERE-Yandy Díaz is riding a season-high 17-game on-base streak, batting .279/.351/.338 (19-for-68) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 5 RBI, 8 BB and 10 SO...it marks the fourth-longest active streak in the AL and fifth longest in the majors...it signals his Paredes (18G, April 28 -May 19) owns the longest on-base streak by a Ray this season.

Diaz's has six multi-hit efforts in his last 10 games since June 4, tied with three others for the most in the majors over that span.
HOMER (UN)HAPPY-The Rays have allowed 93 HR, tied with the White Sox for the most in the majors...they are $14-3$ when holding the opposition homerless compared to 19-34 when yielding 1+ HR...Rays batters have recorded the fewest homers in the majors only the 2014 and 2003 squads (both 50 HR )...the club is $26-15$ when out-homering the opponent or homers are even and $7-22$ when being out-homered.

The Rays have collected 13 wins without the benefit of hitting a home run, tied
with the Brewers and Giants for the most in MLB.
IN THE ATL-The Rays and Braves meet for their lone series of 2024 this weekend.. Tampa Bay is 6-7 against Atlanta since 2020...this marks the Rays fourth series at Truist Park since the ballpark opened in 2017, earning a series win and two spits in they won the series opener and rubber match...the Rays claimed the first game in extra innings and overcame a 3-0 deficit to win the finale.

The Rays are 16-27 (.372) all-time against the Braves...it marks their second-worst winning pct. against a single opponent, ahead of a $7-14$ (.333) record against the Reds...the Rays went $0-7$ from the start of their inaugural season through July 16 , 2000, but have gone 16 -20 in the last 36 games...the 43 all-time meetings are their
second most against any NL opponent behind Miami (137).
Yandy Díaz is 13 -for-34 (.382) in nine career games against Atlanta.

LAST TIME OUT-Suffered the loss on June 10 vs. Baltimore...allowed four runs on a career-high nine hits with zero walks and nine strikeouts... allowed a leadoff homer to Gunnar Henderson...James McCann led off the 3rd inning with a solo shot...Ryan O'Hearn recorded a two-run double in the 5th frame...completed the outing with three strikeouts in the 6th inning, working around a Colton Cowser single...has recorded 7+ SO in a career-high three straight outings.

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?-Pepiot is set to make his first career start agains the Braves...has made two starts against the NL East this season (May 5 vs. NYM \& June 4 at MIA), going 1-0 with a 6.75 ERA (8.0IP, 6ER) and 11 SO against 1 BB in those outings

He has made five career appearances (4GS) opposite the NL East, four
of which came against the Marlins...is 3-0 with a 3.12 ERA ( 26.0 IP
9ER) and 26 SO across the five outings.
ROAD WARRIOR-He has earned a victory in each of his three road starts, posting a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) with 26 strikeouts against zero walks...he joins AZ Randy Johnson (2007) and NYY Mike Mussina (2001) as the only pitchers since 1901 to record 25+ SO and 0 BB in their first three road starts with a franchise

He is the first pitcher in franchise history to throw 6.0+ innings and issue zero walks in each of his first three road starts of a season.
Pepiot is the 10th pitcher in club history to record three straight quality starts on the road to begin a season, including the first since yler Glasno (4QS, April 5-May 3, 2019).
He has 7+SO in each of his three road outings, marking the longest season-opening streak by a Ray since Brendan McKay (3GS, July 3-G1-Aug. 13, 2019 ).
Prior to his start on June 4 at MIA, he had thrown 6.0+ scoreless innings with no walks in each of his first two road starts, becoming (2018) and PIT Deacon Phillippe (1902) nd PIT Deacon Phillippe (1902).
a Field this season, Pepiot is $1-3$ with a 5.36 ERA (40.1IP, 24ER) and 42 strikeouts against 16 walks.

IN CONTROL-Pepiot has 8+ SO without issuing a walk in back-to-back starts, marking the first time a Tampa Bay starter has done so since Ryan Starts, marking the first time

He is one of four pitchers in the majors to accomplish the feat this season, joining CWS Erick Fedde, BOS Nick Pivetta and ATL Chris Sale...no starter this year has done so in three straight starts.

HEAT CHECK-Pepiot has held opponents to a 13-for-103 (.126) clip on his four-seamer, recording 42 of his 69 SO on the pitch...the 126 average is the lowest mark on any individual pitch in ML B (min 100AB anding with pitch) ahead of NYY Luis Gil's four-seam fastball (134) and CWS Garret Crochet's four-seamer (.142).

He has produced a 36.3 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the second-highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball (min. 250 swings), trailing only OAK Mason Miller's four-seamer (41.0\%).

WHIFF YOU PLEASE-Min. 750 swings, Pepiot's 31.2 pct. whiff rate ranks third in the AL behind DET Jack Flaherty (34.9\%) and CWS Garrett Crochet (32.2\%)...he had a 32.7 pct. whiff rate prior to his IL stint (7GS) compared to 28.7 pct. since his return (4GS).
