MICHAEL WACHA is making his 26th start of the season and the 314th of his career (335th appearance) tonight in the 2nd game of the series vs. the Tigers at Kauffman Stadium...it's his 13th career start vs. Detroit and 3rd this season...Michael is in his 14th Major League season in 2026 and his third with Kansas City, after spending parts of 11 seasons with the Cardinals (2013-19), Mets (2020), Rays (2021), Red Sox (2022) and Padres (2023)...was selected 19th overall in the 2012 First-Year Player Draft by St. Louis.

+ Wacha joined Kansas City in December 2023 on a one-year contract...after a successful first season with the Royals—in which he went 13-8 with a 3.35 ERA in 29 starts—the two sides agreed to a new deal in November 2024, which keeps him in Kansas City through 2027, in addition to a club option for the 2028 season.

+ Michael has surrendered 3 earned runs or fewer in 65 of his 85 starts (76.5%) since joining the Royals in 2024, which are the most such starts in the AL over that span.

+ He was named an All-Star this season for the second time in his career and first since 2015 while with the Cardinals...according to *Elías*, he became the third player to have at least 10 seasons between All-Star selections, joining **Bert Blyleven** (11, 1973-85) and **Schoolboy Rowe** (10, 1936-47)...he worked a 1-2-3 3rd inning with 2 strikeouts in the 2026 All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia.

LAST START: Michael earned a 9-5 win on Monday night vs. the A's after surrendering 4 runs on 6 hits (career-high-tying 3 HR) and no walks with 3 strikeouts in 5.0 innings... he allowed a leadoff home run to **Jeff McNeil** on the 1st pitch of the game, but limited the damage to just 1 run after inducing an inning-ending, 4-6-3 double play by **Carlos Cortes** with runners at first and second...including the double play, he retired each of his next 10 batters faced through the 4th inning, but allowed 3 runs in the 5th on a solo shot by **Tommy White** and a 2-run blast from **Brian Severen**, respectively...he exited in favor of **Connor Thomas** prior to the beginning of the 6th with the Royals leading, 6-4.

+ Monday night marked Wacha's 1st win since June 22 at Tampa Bay, while it was his 1st victory at home since May 9 vs. these Tigers...he was credited with the win despite not recording a quality start for the first time since last Sept. 5 vs. Minnesota.

+ Was the first time in his Major League career that he earned the win despite yielding 3 home runs, and he became the first Royals starting pitcher to turn the trick since **Jakob Junis** on June 11, 2017 at San Diego (3 HR) & the first to do so at home since tonight's Royals.TV analyst **Jeremy Guthrie** on April 9, 2013 vs. Minnesota (3 HR).

CENTRAL COMMAND: In 8 starts vs. AL Central opponents this season, Wacha is 4-1 with a 1.80 ERA (11 ER in 55.0 IP), which is the 4th-lowest ERA by any pitcher vs. their own division this year, trailing **Joey Cantillo** (1.32), **Chris Sale** (1.45) and **Cam Schlichtler** (1.75), while his 4 intradivisional wins are T-2nd in the AL, behind **Drew Rasmussen** (5).

+ He has worked at least 7.0 innings in 6 of his 8 outings vs. the AL Central this year, while he's limited divisional opponents to a .184 average (36-for-196) against him.

CAN'T WALK HERE: Wacha has not issued a walk in consecutive starts for the eighth time in his Major League career and first since Aug. 1-6, 2025...he has not surrendered a walk in 3 straight starts only once in his career: Sept. 5-16, 2022 while with Boston.

+ He's yielded 1 walk or fewer in 9 of his last 13 starts since June 5, tied for the 4th-most such outings in the Majors during that stretch, trailing only Colorado's **Kyle Freeland**, and Tampa Bay's **Nick Martinez** and **Drew Rasmussen** (10 each)...prior to this 13-start run, Wacha issued 1 walk or fewer in 4 of his 1st 12 starts this year.

QUALITY TIME: He's tied with **Sonny Gray** and **Cam Schlichtler** for the AL lead with 16 quality starts this season, trailing only **Sandy Alcantara** (20), **Cristopher Sánchez** (18) and **Yoshinobu Yamamoto** (18)...Michael is on pace to record 19 quality starts this year, which would match a career high that he set in 2015 while with the St. Louis Cardinals.

+ Michael's 64.0% quality start rate (16-for-25) this season is the 2nd-best clip by any pitcher in the American League, trailing only Gray, who has a 66.7% rate (16-for-24).

+ Wacha is trying to become the first Royals starting pitcher to lead the American League in quality starts outright in a single season since **James Shields** had 27 in 2013...his teammate, **Seth Lugo**, finished 2024 tied for the American League lead with 22 quality starts alongside **Corbin Burnes**, **Logan Gilbert** and **Tarik Skubal**.

LIKE CLOCKWORK: Michael has averaged an American League-leading 6.1 innings per start this year, which is tied with **Cristopher Sánchez** for the 3rd-best clip in the Majors, trailing only **Yoshinobu Yamamoto** and **Sandy Alcantara**, who are each averaging 6.2 innings per start this year...Wacha's 155.2 innings this season are the 2nd most by any pitcher in the American League, behind only **Cam Schlichtler** (158.0).

+ Michael has spun at least 5.0 innings in 24 of his 25 starts this year, which is tied with **Logan Gilbert**, **Parker Messick** and **Gavin Williams** for the most in the AL.

+ He has worked at least 6.0 innings in 18 of his 25 starts this season, tied with **Sonny Gray** for the most such outings in the American League and tied for the 3rd most in Major League Baseball, behind Alcantara, who has 23 and Yamamoto, who has 20.

+ Wacha has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 9 of his 25 starts this year, which is tied with **Nathan Eovaldi** for the most in the American League and tied for the 3rd most by any pitcher in Major League Baseball, behind Alcantara (12) & Webb (10).

DOUBLE OR NOTHING: Wacha has induced 14 groundball double plays in 25 starts this season, tied for the 5th most in the AL, behind only teammate **Seth Lugo** (17), **Kyle Bradish** (16), **George Kirby** (16) and **Framber Valdez** (15)...he's on pace to induce 17 GDP this year after recording 17 in 2024 and 18 last season...the last Royal to induce at least 17 groundball double plays in 3 straight years was **Tim Lincecum** from 1996-98.

THE ROUND-TRIP REPORT: He allowed a career-high-tying 3 home runs on Monday night vs. the A's, and he's surrendered a HR in 7 of his last 8 starts since July 4...Wacha's 11 home runs allowed during that stretch are the most in the AL and T-3rd most in MLB.

HOME: Michael is making his 12th start of the season at Kauffman Stadium tonight, where he's 4-3 with a 3.21 ERA (25 ER in 70.0 IP)...Wacha has fired at least 6.0 innings in 8 of his 11 home outings this year, while he has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 7 of those.

TOMORROW’S STARTER: LHP DANIEL LYNCH IV (4-4, 2.83)

- + **Daniel Lynch IV** will make his 4th start of the season and the 60th of his career (174th appearance) in tomorrow's series finale vs. the Tigers.

+ In his most recent start on Tuesday night vs. the Athletics, Lynch IV pitched a season-high 4.0 innings, allowing just 1 run on 2 hits and 2 walks with 1 strikeout in a 4-3 Royals win...after retiring the 1st batter of the game, he allowed 4 consecutive baserunners to reach, with the last being a **Tommy White** RBI single, but the damage was limited after **Nick Loftin** threw out **Jeff McNeil** at the plate on the play...he retired each of the next 10 batters he faced, with his night ending on a strikeout of **Lawrence Butler** to end the 4th inning before being relieved in favor of **Mason Black** for the 5th.

+ Per *Elías*, Lynch is one of three active players to have at least 50 starts and 100 relief appearances with one team, joining **Andre Pallante** with the Cardinals (193 G, 85 GS) and **Reynaldo Lopez** with the White Sox (205 G, 91 GS).

+ Has limited left-handed hitters to a .156 average (14-for-90) this season, the 6th-best mark in the AL (min. 90 BF), trailing Tampa Bay's **Shane McClellan** (.131).
- + In 17 games (8 starts) vs. the Tigers in his career, Lynch IV is 4-3 with a 4.35 ERA (25 ER in 51.2 IP) with 37 strikeouts...he has allowed just 3 runs in 10.1 innings (2.61 ERA) with 9 strikeouts across 9 relief appearances vs. Detroit since 2024.

+ Across 68 games (28 starts) vs. the AL Central in his career, he is 12-14 with a 4.74 ERA (95 ER in 180.1 IP) and 132 strikeouts...his 1.69 ERA (3 ER in 16.0 IP) vs. the AL Central this season ranks 3rd in MLB (min. 15 games), trailing **Brent Headrick** (0.56).

+ In 26 games (2 starts) at The K this season, Daniel is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (7 ER in 30.1 IP) and 21 strikeouts...three of his 7 earned runs allowed at home this year came in his 1st start of the year vs. the Cubs...that start snapped a 10-game scoreless streak at home that dated back to June 10 vs. the Rangers.

MANAGER MATT QUATRARO (kwuh-TRAIR-roe)

- + **Matt Quatraro** is in his fourth season as Royals Manager...in January, he agreed to an extension that runs through 2029 and includes a club option for 2030...the option would represent his eighth season, which would mark the 2nd-longest tenure in franchise history, trailing only **Ned Yost's** 10 seasons as Manager.

+ His 280 wins are 7th most in franchise history, 6 shy of **Hal McRae** (286) for 6th...he's only 20 wins shy of becoming the fifth Manager in Royals history to reach 300 wins (Yost 746, **Whitey Herzog** 410, **Dick Howser** 404, **Tony Muser** 317).

+ Quatraro led the Royals to back-to-back winning seasons in 2024-25 for the first time since 2013-15...the Royals under Q are the eighth team in the Wild Card Era, according to *Elías*, to have back-to-back winning seasons after a 100-loss campaign.
- + Quatraro led the 2024 Royals to an 86-76 record in his second season as Manager.

+ Q finished runner-up in the 2024 American League Manager of the Year voting.

+ The 2024 Royals were the sixth team in the 162-game Era (since 1961), according to *Elias*, to have a 30-win improvement from one season to the next (excluding shortened seasons)...they were the third team to make the postseason following a 100-loss season, following the 2017 Minnesota Twins and 2020 Miami Marlins.

+ Before joining the Royals, he spent five years on **Kevin Cash's** staff in Tampa Bay and four seasons on **Terry Francona's** staff in Cleveland...during his 12 full seasons on a big league staff, his teams have reached the postseason seven times.

REPLAY SPECIALIST BILL DUPLISSEA

- + **Bill Duplissea** is in his 21st season with the Royals and has served as the Replay Coordinator since Instant Replay was instituted in 2014...during that time, the Royals 65.4% success rate is 1st in the Majors, ahead of the 2nd-place Yankees (64.0%).

+ Duplissea has overturned 22 of 30 challenges this season (73.3%), which is the best rate in the Majors according to the latest update sent from MLB a week ago.

+ In 12 full seasons of Instant Replay, the Royals have finished in the top 5 in success rate eight times and have finished in the top 10 in all 12 seasons.
- + Duper started with the Royals as a Bullpen Catcher in 2006, then added advanced scouting duties in 2012...in his current role, he works closely with the coaching staff in scouting upcoming opponents, in addition to his in-game replay role.

+ Prior to joining the Royals, he spent 2004-05 as an Assistant Coach at the College of San Mateo, helping lead the Bulldogs to conference titles in both seasons.

+ Duplissea was a catcher for five seasons in the Los Angeles Dodgers organization, reaching Triple-A Albuquerque in 2000.
