METSELLANEOUS: The Mets fell to the Reds, 4-3, last night...The Mets finish a six-game road trip (2-3) today going 1-2 vs. the Pirates and the 1-1 vs. the Reds...The Mets are 4-3 in rubber games this year...The Mets are looking for their 15th series win of the season and their sixth series win on the road...The Mets are off on Thursday and then return to New York for a 10-day, 11-game homestand against the Blue Jays (three games), Braves (five games) and Reds (three games).

THE STRO SHOW: Marcus Stroman is set to take the bump for the 20th time today and the 11th time on the road...He is 6-8 with a 2.79 ERA (32 earned runs/103.1 innings) with 25 walks and 86 punchouts this season...On the road, he is 3-4 with a 2.91 ERA (19 earned runs/58.2 innings) with 12 walks and 47 strikeouts...He has tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his 10 starts on the road this season...This will mark his third career start against the Reds and his first since 2019...He is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (four earned runs/10.2 innings) against the team with three walks and seven strikeouts...This will mark his second start at GABP...He last pitched at the park on September 22, 2019 in a 6-3 win for the Mets.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: Pete Alonso is batting .364 (8-22) with four runs, a double, two home runs, four RBI, three walks, a .440 OBP and a .682 SLG in five games after the All-Star break...He is batting .272/.335/.525 with 20 runs, five doubles, 12 home runs, 30 RBI, 13 walks and an .860 OPS in 45 games since the start of June.

MOVING ON UP: Michael Conforto has hit 124 home runs and is now tied with Todd Hundley for eighth on the team's all-time home run list...Lucas Duda is seventh with 125...Pete Alonso is now 21st on the Mets all-time home run list with 88 blasts...Gary Carter is 20th with 89 home runs.

WE LIKE MIKE: Michael Conforto is 6-21 (.286) with four runs, two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, two walks and a 1.157 OPS in five games since after the All-Star Break.

HANG 10: Jeff McNeil is on a 10-game hitting streak, batting .324 (11-34) with six runs, a double, a home run, five RBI, four walks and an .851 OPS in that span...His 10 game hitting streak is the second longest streak of his career...His career-high is 11 straight games with a hit, doing so from August 16-26, 2018...He has safely reached base in each of his last 11 games, putting up a .419 OBP in that span...He is batting .321 (17-53) with nine runs, a double, a home run, seven RBI and six walks with a .796 OPS in 16 games this month.

BREAK OUT THE BATS: The Mets collected nine more hits last night...The team is batting .280/.368/.543 on their current road trip, scoring 33 runs with 13 extra-base hits...Overall this season, the Mets are slashing .238/.310/.402 on the road.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Mets have been in first place since Saturday, May 8, a streak of 74 days...This is their longest run atop the East in the last 14 seasons...The 2007 Mets (135 days in a row) were the last iteration of the club to be in first longer than 74 days in a row, per Elias...The team has been in first place for 90 days overall this season, the most of any team in 2021.

PROUD TO BE GREAT AMERICAN: The Mets own a 35-21 record with a 4.20 ERA (230 earned runs/492.2 innings) at Great American Ball Park...The team has hit .268/.334/.462 with 86 home runs at the yard...The Mets have outscored the Reds, 301-250 since the ballpark was opened in 2003...The team's .268 batting average is the fourth-highest opposing batting average in the ballpark...It's the second-highest in the NL...Only the Dodgers (.272) have a higher batting average at GABP.

JULY! JULY! JULY! As a team, New York is batting .264/.349/.460 with an .810 OPS in 16 games this month...This is their highest batting average, OBP and SLG in any month this season...The Mets hit .222/.297/.379 in 30 games in June...The team has hit 27 home runs this month...Their second-highest total of any month this year...The team hit a season-high 33 blasts in June.

I'M WALKING HERE: Brandon Nimmo has drawn nine walks in his last five games...He is 15-55 (.273) with 12 runs, four doubles, one home run, 12 walks and six RBI in 15 games since returning from the 10-Day IL...He is batting .298 (36-121) with 19 runs, nine doubles, two home runs, 14 RBI, 24 walks and an .839 OPS in 37 games this year.

C IS FOR COOKIE: Carlos Carrasco is currently on a rehab assignment with the Syracuse Mets...He made the start last night and allowed five earned runs on three hits (all home runs) with three walks and a strikeout...He threw 41 pitches, 23 for strikes...He tossed 2.0 scoreless innings and allowed only a hit, while striking out two in his first start last Thursday...Carrasco is on the 60-Day IL with a right hamstring injury.

METS-REDS NOTES: The Mets return to the Queen City for the first time since September 20-22, 2019...The team took two of three from the Reds.

IN A PINCH: The Mets pinch-hitters are batting .262/.340/.469 with nine doubles, six home runs, 30 RBI and 13 walks...Their .262 batting average is the fourth-best in the majors and is the best in the NL...Their .809 pinch-hit OPS is also the best in the NL...The team's six pinch-hit home runs is the third most in the majors.

ROAD SHOW: Pete Alonso is batting .286/.347/.600 with 32 runs, seven doubles, 16 home runs, 40 RBI and 14 walks on the road this year...His 16 road home runs on the road lead the major leagues...This compares to a .218/.321/.336 slash line with three home runs at home...Dominic Smith is slashing .277/.346/.464 with 21 runs, 10 doubles, seven homers, 18 RBI and 16 walks away from Citi Field...This compares to a .223/.295/.315 slash line with six extra-base hits at home.

TOTAL DOMINATION: Dominic Smith is batting .291/.355/.582 with 13 runs, four doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, five walks and a .937 OPS in 16 games this month...He is batting .342/.405/.507 with eight extra-base hits against left-handed pitchers this year.

OUCH! The Mets have been plunked 51 times this season...That places them sixth in the majors and fifth in the NL...Since the start of 2019, the team has been plunked 191 times, which is the third-most in the majors in that span...Only the Reds (194) and Cubs (193) have been hit more in that span.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Mets are 21-29 with a 4.49 ERA (207 earned runs/415.1 innings) with 145 walks and 443 strikeouts on the road this year...This compares to a 28-14 record with a 2.43 ERA (97 earned runs/359.0 innings) with 128 walks and 399 strikeouts at home...The team's 2.43 ERA at home is the best in the majors and their .667 winning percentage is the fourth-best.

CONNECT FORTY: The Mets are 40-8 when scoring four or more runs this season...The team is 9-34 when scoring three or fewer runs...The Mets are 37-13 when scoring first this season...The team's .740 winning percentage is tied for the fifth-best record in the major leagues when scoring first this season.

REPLACE-METS: Entering today, the Mets have used 53 players through 92 games this season...The franchise record for most players used in a season is 56 by the 2018 Mets...The Mets have had 15 different pitchers start a game this season...That is the most in the majors...The Mets used 10 starters in 2020...The last time the Mets used 15 or more starters in a season was in 1979 when they also used 15...The franchise record is 20 starters used in 1967.

QUALITY EATS: The Mets have made 34 quality starts this season...The Mets rotation owns a 3.08 ERA (152 earned runs/444.1 innings) this season, the second-best mark in the major leagues...deGrom leads the major leagues with a 1.08 ERA, while Marcus Stroman is 13th in the majors with a 2.78 mark.

THIS DAY IN METS HISTORY: On this day in 2004, David Wright made his major league debut as the Mets defeated the Expos, 5-4, in front of 30,227 at Shea Stadium...Wright started at third and went 0-4 in his first career game...Jae Weong Seo made the start, but did not factor in the decision...The Mets took an early lead, but Montreal tied it at 4-4 in the seventh...New York took the lead in the eighth when Todd Zeile reached on an error by the first baseman...Braden Looper converted his 20th save of the season...Wright would go on to play 1,585 games with the Mets and hit .296/.376/.491 with 242 home runs and 970 RBI...He was a seven-time All-Star, a two time Silver Slugger Award Winner and a two-time Gold Glove recipient...For cool photos and interactive history information on the Mets, please visit the Mets Virtual Vault at metsheritage.com.

STROMAN NEWS & NOTES

LAST START: Today Stroman will make his 20th start of the season and 11th on the road...In his last start, Stroman pitched 5.0 innings, allowing a season-high-tying eight hits and two runs, earned...Did not walk a batter and struck out three in the Mets' 4-1 loss to the Pirates at PNC Park on July 16...Suffered his eighth loss of the season...Was the fifth consecutive game he did not pitch 6.0 innings or more after doing so for a streak of eight straight starts (May 11-June 17)...Finished the first half with a 2.75 ERA (30 ER/98.2 innings), the best mark of his career.

SEEING RED: Making his third career start against the Reds and second as a member of the Mets...Has gone 1-0 against Cincinnati in those two games with a 3.38 ERA (four earned runs/10.2 innings)...In his last start against the Reds on September 22, 2019, Stroman did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.2 innings and allowing two runs, earned, on three hits...Struck out two batters and walked three in the Mets' 6-3 victory at Great American Ball Park.

A GOOD RUN: Stroman's 2.75 ERA (30 earned runs/98.1 innings) through 18 starts in the first half of the season is his best 18-start stretch by that measure in his career...He has allowed two earned runs or fewer and pitched 5.0 innings or more in 11 of his 18 starts this year.

FEELING SIX-Y: Stroman completed at least 6.0 innings in eight straight starts (May 11-June 17) before leaving in the second inning due to injury on June 22...He has not gone 6.0 innings since then...Those eight starts were good for the longest streak of his career...Stroman had a 2.50 ERA (14 earned runs/50.1 innings) over that stretch...The Mets are 8-3 when Stroman goes at least 6.0 innings this year and 1-7 when he does not complete 6.0 IP.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Stroman has allowed only 18 extra-base hits in 103.1 innings, the third-fewest among the 91 pitchers in the majors who have thrown at least 80.0 innings this season...Only Charlie Morton (17) and Corbin Burnes (17) allowed fewer...Ranks 16th in the majors and 12th in the NL in opponent slugging (.340).

KEEP IT ON THE GROUND: Stroman currently ranks seventh in the majors and fifth the NL with a 51.0 percent ground ball rate...He is 13th in the NL with a 0.87 HR/9 ratio.

SUCCESS VS. LEFT: Lefties are slashing just .225/.271/.305 against Stroman, a .576 OPS against that ranks ninth in the NL among pitchers who've faced at least 150 LHB.

STAY HOT: Stroman is 3-4 with a 2.84 ERA (18 earned runs/57.0 innings) in his last 11 starts...He has allowed only four home runs in the stretch (0.63 HR/9) while walking 17 and striking out 51...The Mets are 5-6 in those games.

LET'S GO STREAKING: Stroman did not allow a run in his 14.1 innings until giving up a run in the seventh inning at Colorado on April 18...This scoreless streak extended from the last 2.0 innings of his first start on April 6, his 0.1 innings on April 11, his 6.0 scoreless innings on April 13 and his 6.0 scoreless innings on April 18...He fell 1.2 innings shy of tying his career-best streak (16.0 IP).

WITH THE METS: Stroman has gone 10-8 with a 3.06 ERA (52 earned runs/153.0 innings) in his 28 starts with New York...The Mets have gone 17-11 in his 28 starts after he joined the team on July 28, 2019...In 2019, he struck out 60 in 59.2 innings with the Mets (Stroman never averaged more than 9.0 K/9 in a season with Toronto).

FRIDAY'S STARTER: RHP TYLOR MEGILL (0-0, 2.63 ERA)

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 6.0 shutout innings on July 17 at Pittsburgh, his first scoreless start of his career...Allowed just six hits and did not walk a batter, also a career-first...Struck out two...Left with the Mets ahead, 6-0...New York fell on a walk-off grand slam, 9-7.

GREAT START: Megill holds a 2.63 ERA through his first five starts...That is the best ERA through a pitcher's first five career starts while pitching for the Mets since 2016, when Seth Lugo posted a 2.27 ERA through his first five starts.
