Freddy Peralta took a no-hit bid through 7.1 innings yesterday, the eighth time in franchise history a pitcher has completed at least 7.1 no-hit innings and the first time since Dave Bush (7.1 innings) on 4/23/09 at Philadelphia.....it was the second time it happened in a home game and the first time it occurred in Milwaukee (Marty Pattin, 7.2 innings, 4/29/69 for the Seattle Pilots vs. California).

Brandon Woodruff recorded his 10th consecutive quality start Sunday at Washington, becoming the eighth pitcher in franchise history with 10+ straight quality starts and the first since CC Sabathia (13 from 7/8-9/10, 2008)....Woodruff is 4-2 with a 0.94 ERA (67ip, 7er) with 78 strikeouts in those 10 starts, dating back to 4/7.

The Brewers have hit multiple home runs in three straight home games for the first time since 6/6-6/9, 2019 when they did so in four straight home games against Miami and Pittsburgh.

Charming The Snakes
Milwaukee has won 12 of its last 15 games against Arizona dating back to the start of the 2018 season, the best winning percentage (.800) of any team over Arizona in that time.....the Brewers are 10-3 against the NL West in 2021, the best winning percentage (.769) against the division in MLB.

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 5 (3-1) of a 7-day, 6-game homestand against Detroit (1-1) and Arizona (2-0).....following this weekend and an off day Monday, the team heads to Cincinnati for 3 games against the Reds.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 15-15 at home, going 2-5-2 in series play.....have won 6 of their last 9 at home.....the team went 15-14 at home in 2020, going 3-4-2 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 16-11 on the road, going 7-2-0 in series play.....currently on a 5-game road winning streak, matching a season high (also, 4/10-4/21).....had a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.....the team went 14-17 on the road in 2020, going 3-6-1 in series play.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (465-438) and sixth full season.....Counsell is second in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

TODAY’S STARTER: #53 - RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF (11gs, 4-2, 1.27)

WOODRUFF AT A GLANCE: Reigning National League Player of the Week, Brandon Woodruff, 28, will be making his 12th start of the season.....Woodruff last started last Sunday at Washington and earned a 3-0 victory (7ip, 2h, 2bb, 10k, 106 pitches).....he notched his ninth career 10+ strikeout game and third this season.....the team is 8-3 in his starts.....he has 10 quality starts (in a row).....opponents are batting .138 (33-for-239, 3hr).....he has 83 strikeouts in just 71.0 innings.....he has a 0.94 ERA over his last 10 starts (67ip, 7er).....he is the eighth pitcher in franchise history with 10 consecutive quality starts and the first to do it since **CC Sabathia** (13 from 7/8-9/10, 2008).....Woodruff was selected in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.

ENCORE!: Woodruff is the first Brewers pitcher to start on Opening Day in consecutive seasons since **Yovani Gallardo** started a franchise-record five in a row from 2010-14.

LAST SEASON: Woodruff went 3-5 with a 3.05 ERA in 13 starts last season.....he tied three others for the Major League lead in starts.....he ranked among the NL leaders in innings pitched (4th, 73.2), opponent batting average (4th, .204), H/9IP (4th, 6.72), WHIP (5th, 0.99), K/BB (5th, 5.06), strikeouts (7th, 91), K/9IP (7th, 11.12) and ERA (9th, 3.05).....the team went 6-7 in his starts.....he made a team-leading 6 quality starts.

CAREER: Is 23-13 with a 3.17 ERA in 73 games / 58 starts (351.2ip, 124er).....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2017-21).....was a 2019 All-Star.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 12-5 with a 3.52 ERA in 38 games / 31 starts (184.1ip, 72er).....is 1-0 with a 2.05 ERA in 5 starts this season (30.2ip, 7er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 11-8 with a 2.80 ERA in 35 games / 27 starts (167.1ip, 52er).....is 3-2 with a 0.67 ERA in 6 starts this season (40.1ip, 3er).

CAREER vs. DIAMONDBACKS: Is 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA in 3 games / 2 starts (10ip, 6er).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .193 (16-for-83) hitter with 1 HR and 5 RBI.....has 4 walks and 37 strikeouts.....homered on 7/13/18 at Pittsburgh (solo off Nick Kingham).....has 6 sac bunts.....also homered in Game 1 of the 2018 NLCS vs. Los Angeles (solo off Clayton Kershaw).....it marked the first postseason home run by a pitcher in franchise history.

RHP Corbin Burnes will make his 10th start of the season.....Burnes last started on Memorial Day vs. Detroit and received a no decision in the Brewers' 3-2, 10-inning win (6ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 7k, 93 pitches).....he left the game with a 2-1 lead.....the team is 3-6 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .167 (31-for-186, 2hr).....he has 81 strikeouts in just 52.1 innings.....he was on the injured list (non-injury related) from 4/29-5/12.....
