THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award... He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 341 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver $(1,480)$.
