**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles walked off the Diamondbacks, 5-4 in 11 innings, to earn their ninth series win of the year...**Jordan Westburg** delivered the game-winning RBI single in the 11th inning, his second career walk-off hit, joining a two-run home run on April 1 vs. Kansas City...**Gunnar Henderson** and **Anthony Santander** each homered in the win...**Ryan Mountcastle** went 3-for-5 with two doubles, a triple, and a run scored; marked his fourth career game with three extra-base hits and first since May 2, 2023 at Kansas City...The bullpen worked 6.1 scoreless innings and has not allowed a run in 9.2 innings this series.

**SWEEP DREAMS:** The Orioles are looking to complete the sweep in today's three-game finale against the Diamondbacks...It would be their fourth sweep of the season, joining three-game sets from April 9-11 at Boston, April 15-17 vs. Minnesota, and May 3-5 at Cincinnati...The O's have only swept the D-backs once: a three-game set in Baltimore from September 23-25, 2016.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The Birds have won seven of their last eight games, nine of 11, 10 of 13, 14 of 19, and 18 of 24...At 26-12 (.684), the Orioles have the best record in the AL and second-best in MLB behind the Phillies (.700, 28-12).

- 🔴 The 26-12 record is tied for the best start through 38 games in O's history (1969 and 1970); the best start through 39 games is 27-12 (1969 and 1970), while the best through 40 is 28-12 (1970).
- 🔴 Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 210-152 (.580), the best record in the AL and third-best in MLB behind the Braves (.636, 229-131) and Dodgers (.652, 238-127).
- 🔴 The O's, Cubs, and Phillies are the only teams in MLB this year without a losing streak of at least three games; Baltimore has only lost back-to-back games twice this season, from April 6-7 and April 12-13.
- 🔴 The O's have gone 127-73 in their last 200 games; the last time they won 127+ games in a 200-game span was August 22, 1982 to September 29, 1983 (127-73).

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 59 home runs, the third-most homers through the first 38 games of a season in O's history, trailing 1987 and 2012 (60)...The most long balls through Baltimore's first 39 games of a season is 63 by the 1987 team.

- 🔴 The Orioles have an MLB-best eight players with at least five homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (12), **Anthony Santander** (7), **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, **Cedric Mullins**, and **Jordan Westburg** (6), and **Ryan O'Hearn** and **Adley Rutschman** (5); the Yankees rank second with six players with at least five long balls.
- 🔴 Henderson's 12 home runs are tied with Atlanta's Marcell Ozuna and Houston's Kyle Tucker for the most in MLB.

**BIG TIME RUTSCH:** **Adley Rutschman** enters today sixth in the AL in hits (48) and seventh in batting average (.306)...He ranks fourth in the AL and tied for fifth in MLB in multi-hit games (15).

- 🔴 Rutschman has hit safely in 18 of 20 games since April 19 and 23 of his last 26 since April 11; for the season, he has reached safely in 31 of his 37 games and has a hit in 30 of those.
- 🔴 Since April 19, he's slashing .330/.344/.511 (29-for-88) with four doubles, four homers, eight runs, 15 RBI, two walks, and a stolen base.
- 🔴 He had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an O's batter this season.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles continue their season-long nine-game homestand today with the finale of the three-game set against the D-backs...The O's will then host the Blue Jays (3 G) from May 13-15, followed by a scheduled off day on Thursday, May 16, before hosting the Mariners (3 G) from May 17-19.

- 🔴 The O's are off to a 14-7 (.667) start at home, tied for the second-best home winning percentage in the AL and fifth-best in MLB.

**AGAINST THE D-BACKS:** The O's and D-backs conclude their only series of the season today with the finale of the three-game set at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...The O's took two out of three against the Snakes last year from September 1-3 at Chase Field...Marks the first time the Birds have hosted the D-backs since sweeping a three-game set from September 23-25, 2016...Baltimore and Arizona have only squared off in the regular season 26 times in team history, with the O's owning an 11-15 record in those games.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** **Gunnar Henderson** and **Colton Cowser** were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the O's have claimed both awards in the same month...The last MLB team to do so was the Dodgers in August 2023: Mookie Betts (Player) and James Outman (Rookie)...The last occurrence among AL teammates was the Guardians in April 2022: José Ramirez (Player) and Steven Kwan (Rookie).

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** The Orioles have gone 104 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

**ON THIS DATE:** On this date in 2023, **Cedric Mullins** becomes the seventh and most recent Oriole to hit for the cycle in a 6-3 win over the Pirates at Camden Yards; Mullins singles in the third inning, triples in the fifth, doubles in the seventh and then blasts a three-run homer in the eighth to complete the cycle...On this date in 1984, Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Jim Palmer** makes the 558th and final appearance of his stellar career in relief against Oakland at Memorial Stadium.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 341 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his eighth start of the season and the first of his career against the Diamondbacks...Made his fourth Opening Day roster...Went 13-5 with a 4.12 ERA (79 ER/172.2 IP), allowing 171 hits (27 HR) with 55 walks and 157 strikeouts across 32 starts in his 2023 campaign...The O's went 24-8 in his starts and his career-high 13 wins were tied for sixth in the American League...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Breyvic Valera, OF Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Rylan Bannon in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14<sup>th</sup> round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Won his third straight start on May 5 in Cincinnati after allowing one hit and one walk with six strikeouts across 6.0 shutout innings; the one hit surrendered is the fewest he has allowed since his Major League debut on September 6, 2020 vs. New York-AL (also: 1)...The three-game winning streak ties a career high (4x, last: 7/5-8/10/23)...Marks his third quality start of the year and his second in as many outings...Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in four of his seven starts this season and three-or-fewer in six of the seven...Threw 93 pitches, 53 strikes.

**AGAINST THE DIAMONDBACKS AND THE NL WEST:** Today will mark Kremer's first career start against the D-backs and his first against the NL West since August 16, 2023 at San Diego...Has posted a 1-1 record with a 5.40 ERA (10 ER/16.2 IP) across three career starts against the division; all three of his lifetime starts took place during the 2023 season.

**HOME AND ROAD:** Has gone 1-1 with a 6.06 ERA (11 ER/16.1 IP) in three home starts this year, compared to 2-1 with a 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) in four starts away from Oriole Park.

**DAY MAN:** Is 2-1 with a 3.22 ERA (8 ER/22.1 IP) in four day starts this year and 7-7 with a 4.48 ERA (67 ER/134.2 IP) in 26 career day starts.

**APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS:** Owns a 3.55 ERA (23 ER/58.1 IP) in 11 lifetime starts in the month of May, compared to a 5.92 ERA (52 ER/79 IP) in 16 career April starts, his highest mark in any month.

**RIGHTY TIGHTY:** In his last four starts, Kremer has held right-handed hitters to a .070/.167/.140 (3-for-43) slash line with one home run, five walks, and 15 strikeouts...Has held right-handers to a .607 OPS on the season.

**GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS:** Kremer pitched to a 5-1 record with a 3.09 ERA (28 ER/81.2 IP) and seven quality starts in his final 15 outings last season...He went 8-4 with a 5.04 ERA (51 ER/91.0 IP) and seven quality starts in his first 17 starts to open the year, allowing 105 hits (19 HR) and 24 walks with 82 strikeouts.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Earned the win on September 28 vs. Boston, clinching the AL East...Collected his 300<sup>th</sup> career strikeout on September 17 vs. Tampa Bay, matching Chuck Estrada and Daniel Cabrera as the fifth-fastest Orioles by appearances (69) to reach the mark...Logged four straight quality starts from August 10-29, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic; made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaragua in Pool Play on March 12, 2023 at loanDepot park in Miami (4.0 IP, 3 H, BB, K).

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Kremer made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 3 of the ALDS against the Texas Rangers on October 10...Allowed six runs on seven hits and one walk in 1.2 innings...The six earned runs marked the most amount that Kremer had given up in a game since June 30 vs. Minnesota (7 ER)...It was his shortest outing since June 24, 2021 at Toronto (0.1 IP).
