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THE TWINS: Began their seven-game roadtrip by going 1-2 in Chicago against the Cubs over the weekend, their only win coming on Friday night...tonight, they will continue the trip with a four-game series against the Guardians at Progressive Field through Thursday.
✪ Twins have won seven of their last 11 and 10 of their last 16 games.
✪ Twins are 4-2 in their last six series openers on the road.
✪ Twins are looking to avoid dropping three-straight games for the first time since June 22-24, when they were swept in three games by the Dodgers at Target Field.

TWINS BLOWN OUT OF THE WINDY CITY: The Twins lost to the Cubs yesterday afternoon at Wrigley Field, dropping their first series since June 22-24 vs. Los Angeles-NL, snapping a series winning streak of five...Zebby Matthews (4-7) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing 10 runs (8 earned) on nine hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits but struck out just four times...Minnesota's only run scored came on a Royce Lewis sacrifice fly in the eighth inning.

RETURN OF THE MACK: The Twins have reinstated outfielder Byron Buxton from the 10-day Injured List...Buxton, who was placed on the IL on July 7 with a right hip strain, has hit .271 (83-for-306) with 16 doubles, one triple, 25 home runs, 45 RBI, 57 runs scored, seven stolen bases, a .328 on-base percentage, a .575 slugging percentage and a .904 OPS in 75 games this season...prior to landing on the IL, the 32-year-old was named one of the starting outfielders for the American League in the 2026 All-Star Game.
✪ To make room for Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Tristan Gray to Triple-A St. Paul.

ON GUARD: The Twins and Guardians are playing the seventh of 13 meetings today...Twins are 4-2 vs. the Guards this season, going 2-1 at Cleveland from May 8-10 and 2-1 at Target Field from July 7-9.

✪ Since the start of 2024, 20 of the 32 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 7-13 in those)...and 14 have been decided by one run (Twins 5-9)...at Progressive Field alone, each of the last 10 here have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-7).

✪ Twins offense has recorded 52 hits over six games vs. the Guards this season, averaging 8.7 hits-per-game...however, they have just three homers against Cleveland pitching this season: Buxton off Festa (5/8 at CLE), Buxton off Bibee (5/9 at CLE) and Lewis off Williams (7/9 at MIN).

✪ Over his last seven games vs. the Guards, Brooks Lee is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with five RBI.
✪ In his last 14 games vs. Cleveland, Kody Clemens is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with six doubles, two triples, a .551 slugging percentage and a .924 OPS...in his last four games, he has eight hits in 16 at-bats (4 extra-base hits).

✪ In his last six games against Cleveland, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI, three walks, a .708 slugging percentage and a 1.116 OPS.

CLEVELAND CLINIC: Twins enter this series looking for consecutive series wins in this ballpark, which would mark the first time since September of 2021 and June of 2022.

✪ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 76 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most at any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (98)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 60).

✪ In his last 14 games at Progressive Field, Josh Bell is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .978 OPS.

✪ In 13 career games at Progressive Field, Royce Lewis is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with nine RBI and an .807 OPS...he has reached safely in eight-straight in Cleveland.

✪ Byron Buxton has reached base safely in seven-straight games at Progressive Field, hitting .355 (11-for-31) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI and a 1.007 OPS in that span.

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: The Twins have gone 10-5 in their last 15 road games...in those 15, they have hit .280 (150-for-535) and averaged 6.3 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 94-67.

✪ Twins have lost back-to-back road games...last time they lost three-plus straight away from Target Field was May 27-June 9, when they dropped six-straight (2 at CWS, 3 at PIT, 1 at DET).

✪ The 1-2 weekend series loss at Wrigley Field was Minnesota's first road series loss since June 9-11 at Detroit.

✪ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in seven-straight road games...over his last 14 road games, since June 16, Keaschall is hitting .409 (18-for-44) with eight walks, a .527 on-base percentage and a 1.118 OPS...his road OPS since that date ranks third in baseball, trailing Trevor Larnach (1.131) and Kyle Stowers (1.124).

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: Kody Clemens has 18 home runs, one shy of his single-season career high of 19, set last year...seven of his home runs have come in his last 18 games...Saturday afternoon's first homer marked the 50th of his career.

✪ Since June 1, he's homered 12 times, tied with Ben Rice for second-most in baseball, trailing Junior Caminero (16).

✪ Among AL players with at least 330 plate appearances on the season, he ranks ninth in slugging percentage (.492).

THE RUNNING MEN: Twins enter today leading the AL in runs scored at 479, 10 ahead of New York-AL (469).

✪ Twins have six different players with 40-plus runs scored: Byron Buxton (57), Luke Keaschall (49), Josh Bell (48), Kody Clemens (47), Trevor Larnach (45) and Brooks Lee (44)...five other teams have as many individual players with 40-plus runs scored (Washington, Atlanta, Chicago-AL, Chicago-NL and Milwaukee).

CHECKING IN WITH THE BIG CHEESE: Connor Prielipp (left middle finger blister) made his first start on rehab assignment yesterday for St. Paul, pitching 3.0 shutout innings, with no hits, one walk and three strikeouts, while throwing 32 pitches.

GOAT BIRTHDAY: National Baseball Hall of Famer and Twins legend Tony Oliva is celebrating his 88th birthday today.
