CAREER

Tall, powerful right-hander was Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Made his Major League debut in 2022 and returned to the mound in 2025.

- 1,076 days passed between his debut on Aug. 26, 2022 vs. Cincinnati and his second career appearance on Aug. 6, 2025 vs. Athletics.
- Was ranked as high as the No. 53 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.com and the No. 61 prospect per *Baseball America* entering the 2023 season.
- Had the “Best Curveball” in Washington’s system, per *Baseball America*, for two consecutive seasons (2024-25)...Had the “Best Slider” in the system in 2021 and 2022.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts in 2021.

LAST START

Cavalli tossed 6.0 innings of no-run ball with eight strikeouts and allowed four hits and two walks against the Rockies...He earned his seventh win of the season in the 8-0 win over Colorado at Coors Field.

- He became just the second Nationals pitcher (2005-pres.) to pitch 6.0 scoreless innings at Coors Field, joining **Tony Armas** on August 13, 2005.

vs. TORONTO

Cavalli is set to make his first career start against the Toronto Blue Jays.

REGENCY BIAS

Cavalli is 3-0 with a 2.43 ERA (9 ER/33.1 IP) and a .197 opponents' average over his last six starts...Right-handed batters are 8-for-44 (.182) with 20 strikeouts, three walks and zero extra-base hits over this stretch.

CADE'S KS

Cavalli ranks seventh in the National League in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (10.33) and eighth with 127 strikeouts...He's just outside of the top 10 in strikeout-to-walk ratio (11th, 3.74).

- Cavalli has struck out 45 and walked just six across six games since June 25...He ranks among NL pitchers in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 7.50), strikeouts (3rd, 45) and strikeouts per 9.0 innings (3rd, 12.15) since that date.

STINGY WITH THE LONGBALL

Cavall has allowed just nine home runs this season, tied for the fifth-fewest among National League pitchers...He ranks fifth in the National League with 0.73 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings.

- He did not allow a homer through the first six starts (24.2 IP) of the season and allowed just one through his first nine starts (40.1 IP).

THE RIGHT STUFF

Opposing right-handed batters are 39-for-171 (.228) with six extra-base hits off Cavalli so far this season.

- Right-handed batters hit .381/.442/.548 against Cavalli in 2025.

2026 OPENING DAY

Cavalli made his first career Opening Day start March 26 against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field...He allowed two earned runs on three runs with five strikeouts.

- Became the 10th different pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to start on Opening Day.
