**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-2 through five games on their seven-game homestand, winning a series 2-1 over the White Sox earlier in the week, followed by a 1-1 split of the first two games with the Royals...today, the Twins will play the third of four against Kansas City and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's series finale, the Twins will have an off-day Monday, then travel to Detroit for a three-game series at Comerica Park from Tuesday-Thursday. ☞ Twins are on day 16 of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day-off is Monday...it will be their first off-day since May 21, just before their trip to Boston. ☞ Twins are playing their 31st day game today...30 day games, entering today, are tied for second-most in baseball...Minnesota is 13-17 during the day.

**BIG SIXTH INNING BOOSTS TWINS:** The Twins beat the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 5-3 as Minnesota scored four of their five runs in the sixth inning...Zebby Matthews (2-3) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with a career-high-tying four walks and two strikeouts...Anthony Banda earned his eighth hold and Travis Adams earned his second save...the offense recorded 10 hits, five going for extra-bases...Brooks Lee drove in two runs and hit his ninth home run of the season. ☞ Austin Martin threw out two runners at home plate from rightfield, become the first Twin since Oswaldo Arcia on May 30, 2014, to record two outfield assists at home plate in a game.

**ROYALTIES:** The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the sixth of 13 games in 2026...Twins have gone 2-3 vs. KC this season. ☞ Since the start of 2024, the Twins have gone 10-5 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 5-11 at Kauffman Stadium. ☞ Twins are 36-25 in their last 61 overall against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022...that includes a home record of 24-8. ☞ Josh Bell is hitting .323 (32-for-99) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.013 OPS in 28 career games vs. Kansas City...two of his five home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Bailey Falter and April 2 off Steven Cruz). ☞ Kody Clemens has multiple hits in each of his last three games against the Royals...he has four home runs in his last four games against Kansas City, dating back to September 7...he has 11 career hits against the Royals, seven are home runs...he has a .250 career average vs. KC, compared to a .750 slugging percentage...1.103 OPS in 16 games...he also has seven walks and a .353 on-base percentage.

**ROYCE BACK:** The Twins have recalled infielder Royce Lewis from Triple-A St. Paul...Lewis, who was optioned to St. Paul on May 19, played in 13 games for the Saints (May 21-June 5), hitting .340 (18-for-53) with four doubles, eight home runs, 19 RBI, 12 runs scored, five walks, a .417 on-base percentage, an .868 slugging percentage and a 1.285 OPS...over the 13 games, he recorded six multi-hit games, two multi-homer games and hit a grand slam vs. Indianapolis on Wednesday at CHS Field. ☞ To make room for Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated outfielder James Outman for release or assignment...Outman played in 49 games for the Twins this season, hitting .156 (10-for-64) with five walks and three RBI.

**STEADI-LEE ON THE RISE:** Brooks Lee has 54 hits on the season, second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (58)...below are Lee's first 22 games (March 26-April 22) compared to his numbers over his last 39 games (since April 23):

**ADDITIONALLY:** Lee leads the club with 37 RBI...37 RBI tie him for 14th-most in the AL...most among AL switch hitters, ahead of Adley Rutschman (36), Josh Bell (33) and José Ramírez (32).

**WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS:** Over his last 23 games, Kody Clemens has posted a .920 OPS (.326 OBP/.593 SLG), while hitting .297 (27-for-91) with eight doubles, two triples, five home runs and 11 RBI...over that 23-game span, he has started at five different positions defensively: first base 13 times, centerfield five times, rightfield three times, leftfield once and second base once. ☞ Clemens has reached base safely in 18 of his last 19 home games, posting a .372 on-base percentage in that span. ☞ He is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with a .683 slugging percentage and 1.069 OPS over his last 11 home games.

**RISP ASSESSMENTS:** Through five games this homestand, Twins have gone 12-for-34 (.353) with runners in scoring position...on the season, they have hit .279 (152-for-544) with RISP, the best in the AL and third-highest in baseball, trailing Atlanta (.291) and Milwaukee (.288). ☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 50 RISP plate appearances: Brooks Lee (.389) ranks third and Luke Keaschall (.339) ranks fourth.

**FEELING MINNESOTA:** Twins have won six of their last nine games at home...they have won three of their last four series' (May 12-14 vs. Miami, May 18-20 vs. Houston and June 1-3 vs. Chicago) in Minnesota. ☞ They are 18-16 at home this season, compared to 12-19 on the road. ☞ They have a +14 run differential at home (162-148), compared to -38 on the road (139-177). ☞ Twins have scored 162 runs at home this season, second-most in the AL, trailing Baltimore (171). ☞ Twins are 7-2 vs. the AL Central at home in 2026.

**GIMME A BELL YEAH:** Josh Bell has now hit safely in a eighth of his last nine games...in those nine, he has hit .323 (10-for-31) with four doubles, four RBI and an .815 OPS. ☞ Since May 18, he is hitting .364 (16-for-45) as a left-handed batter, including four doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, four walks, a .417 on-base percentage, a .591 slugging percentage and a 1.008 OPS.

**TOUCH OF GRAY:** Over his last nine games, since May 28, Tristan Gray is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with three doubles, one home run, 11 RBI, two stolen bases, a .615 slugging percentage and a .986 OPS...since May 28, his 11 RBI is tied for fourth-most in baseball.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2019, Max Kepler became the second player in club history to record multiple three-homer games (also 2016), joining Eddie Rosario (2017 and 2018), as Kepler hit all three homers off Trevor Bauer at Progressive Field.

- Is 8-2 with a 2.58 ERA (66.1 IP, 19 ER), 15 walks, 69 strikeouts and a 0.95 WHIP in 12 career starts against the Royals; is 4-0 with a 1.78 ERA (30.1 IP, 6 ER), five walks, 38 strikeouts in five starts at Target Field.
- In his last start on June 1 vs. Chicago-AL, Ryan earned the win, allowing four runs on eight hits (2 HR), with no walks and nine strikeouts in a 9-6 Twins victory at Target Field.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ryan made his 13th start of the season on June 1 vs. Chicago-AL opposite right-hander David Sandlin...earned his fourth win of the season, allowing four runs on eight hits - including home runs from Andrew Benintendi and Miguel Vargas - in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and matched a season high with nine strikeouts, as the Twins took the series-opening win against the White Sox by a score of 9-6 at Target Field.

Joe has now had nine strikeouts and zero walks in three straight starts, becoming the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-) to go three consecutive starts with that line...also was the 10th time in his career he has done that, which moves him within three of Johan Santana (13) for the most such starts in Twins history (1961-).

The two home runs surrendered matched a season-high, previously done on April 23 at New York-NL.  
He has made five consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more innings pitched since May 9 at Cleveland, matching the second longest such streak of his career (also five from April 27-May 27, 2025)...his career long streak is 10 consecutive games of 6.0-or-more innings pitched from September 30, 2022-May 19, 2023.

**THE BIG 5-0:** Joe Ryan recorded his 50th career major league victory in his last start on June 1 vs. the White Sox...he reached the milestone in his 128th career game, making him just the 12th pitcher in Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-) to record 50-or-more wins in his first 128 career outings, joining the likes of Twins greats such as Twins Hall of Famer Radke (53) and Twins and National Baseball Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (55).

He is the first to join that list since José Berríos finished with 54 wins through his first 128 games as a Twin from April 27, 2016-June 5, 2021.  
Joe Ryan's 798 career strikeouts are the most of any Twins pitcher with 50-or-more wins in that span.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan made his 12th start of the season on May 26 at Chicago-AL opposite right-hander Sean Burke...recorded his team-high seventh quality start of the season but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR) through 7.2 innings pitched, with no walks and matched a season-high nine strikeouts, set in his previous start on May 20 vs. Houston...threw 78.6% of his pitches for strikes, his best strike percentage since throwing 91/72 (79.1%) of his pitches for strikes on April 25, 2023 vs. New York-AL.

The start matched the second longest outing of his career (also 7.2 IP on September 18, 2022 at Cleveland) and longest since recording his longest career outing - a complete-game shutout of the Boston Red Sox - on June 22, 2023 at Target Field.

**ROYAL TREATMENT:** This will mark Ryan's 13th career start against Kansas City and second this season...he is 8-2 with a 2.58 ERA (66.1 IP, 19 ER), 15 walks, 69 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .201 (48-for-239) BAA...his eight wins against Kansas City are his most against any opponent, with his second most coming against Detroit (5).

In his first bout with the Royals this season on April 1 at Kansas City, Joe took the loss, allowing five runs on nine hits (both season highs), in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts, as the Twins lost by a score of 13-9.

Joe began his career 8-0 in his first 10 career starts against the Royals, boasting a 1.34 ERA (60.1 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks and 64 strikeouts, but has gone 0-2 in his last two against Kansas City, owning a 15.00 ERA (6.0 IP, 10 ER) with four walks and five strikeouts...he has allowed more runs across his last two starts against the Royals (10) than in his previous 10 combined (9).

**COMMANDING THE CENTRAL:** Today marks Joe's 43rd career start (44th game) against an opponent from the American League Central division...he is 20-9 with a 3.04 ERA (248.1 IP, 84 ER), 50 walks, 265 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .203 (185-for-912) BAA.

In five starts against division opponents this season, Ryan is 2-1 with a 4.40 ERA (28.2 IP, 14 ER), six walks, 33 strikeouts, a 1.15 WHIP and a .241 (27-for-112) BAA...the Twins' offense provided Joe with nine runs of support in his last start on June 1 vs. Chicago-AL after providing nine combined runs of support in his first four starts against division opponents this season.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In 62 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.89 ERA (344.1 IP, 149 ER), 77 walks and 363 strikeouts, compared to 29-19 with a 3.58 ERA (367.1 IP, 146 ER), 85 walks and 435 strikeouts in 66 home appearances (65 starts).

In seven starts at Target Field this season, Ryan is 3-2 with a 2.80 ERA (35.1 IP, 11 ER), six walks, 45 strikeouts, a 0.96 WHIP and a .209 (28-for-134) BAA.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, lefties are slashing .208/.261/.357 (32-for-154) with eight doubles, five home runs, six walks and 43 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .206/.256/.308 (22-for-107) with eight doubles, one home run, eight walks and 36 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .215/.274/.383 (285-for-1,325) with 89 walks and 336 strikeouts (3.78 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .226/.272/.413 (303-for-1,343) with 73 walks and 462 strikeouts (6.33 K/BB).

Ryan's 6.33 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

Ryan ranks sixth among major league pitchers with a .119 (5-for-42) BAA on his curveball and is also sixth with a 42.2% strikeout percentage (min. 40 plate appearances).

Has a 27.5% whiff percentage on his four-seamer, which is the seventh highest among American League pitchers (min. 300 pitches).

Joe has an overall pitching run value of 12, which falls within the league's 94th percentile, and is tied for the seventh highest in the American League.
