AHOY MATEY: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates play the second game of a four-game series tonight at PNC Park ... The Redbirds are playing their first four-game April series in the Steel City since April 10-13, 1987, a wraparound weekend series highlighted by **Brian Bartow's** first roadie as a PR pro and newly-acquired All-Star catcher **Tony Peña** breaking his left thumb against his former team ... St. Louis enjoyed a wild smash-and-grab, come-from-behind 4-2 victory in last night series opener, after ending a perfect game bid with two outs in the 6th inning and erasing a two-run deficit with one out the 9th.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the NL Central, 3.0 games back of first place Cincinnati ... Tonight's game is their 5th of a season-high 17 straight without an off day (April 24-May 10) ... The Cardinals (-13), Athletics (-8), and Diamondbacks (-5) are the only three MLB teams with winning records but negative run differentials.

WHEEEEEEEEEEEEEEEEE: According to *Baseball Savant*, St. Louis had a 3.7% win probability last night before **Pedro Pagés** and **JJ Wetherholt** hit back-to-back one-out jacks in the 9th ... The last time St. Louis came back to win a game in which the opposing team's pitcher(s) were perfect through 6.2 innings was **Sept. 20, 1999 at Wrigley Field** ... Chicago's **Jon Lieber** was perfect through 6.2 innings before **Mark McGwire** hit a solo homer, his 59th of the season, that kicked off a seven-run frame for the Cardinals, all with two outs, en route to a 7-2 victory. - *Elias*

CARDIAC CARDS: The Cardinals share the Major League lead in both last at-bat wins (6) and walk-off victories (3) this season, while tying for the 3rd-most come-from-behind wins (10) ... St. Louis is an MLB-best 5-0 in extra inning affairs, its best start since the 2004 Cardinals started their season 6-0 in extras. **CLOSE CALLS:** St. Louis and Cleveland co-lead MLB with 17 games decided by two runs or fewer this season, with the Cardinals sporting an MLB-leading 12 wins in those games.

TUESDAY NO LOSE DAY: St. Louis is the only undefeated MLB team on Tuesdays this season, sporting a 4-0 record.

BURIED TREASURE: The Cardinals (117-90) and Cubs (117-91) tie for the most wins all-time among visiting teams at PNC Park (2001-present), while their .565 win pct. trails the Padres (.625) and Dodgers (.578) for 3rd-best among annual Steel City visitors.

CARDS CLAIM PERALTA: The Cardinals claimed LHP **Luis Peralta** off waivers from Colorado yesterday and optioned him to Memphis (AAA) ... The 25-year-old southpaw, who is the younger brother of Mets All-Star pitcher **Freddy Peralta**, appeared in 37 games for the Rockies between 2024-25 and struck out 14 in his 7.1 IP for Albuquerque (AAA) to begin the 2026 season ... Peralta originally signed with Pittsburgh as an International Free Agent in 2017 and pitched parts of his first six professional seasons in the Pirates minor league system (2018-19, 2021-24).

Other notables born on this date include **Matt Chapman** (33), Hall of Famer **Barry Larkin** (62), actresses **Jessica Alba** (45), **Penélope Cruz** (52), & **Bridget Moynahan** (55), professional golfer & Cardinals fan **John Daly** (60), and former U.S. President **James Monroe** (1758-1831).

Nathan Church (2018) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonsia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens.

Justin Bruihl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Alec Burluson tallied his first career hit on Sept. 11, 2022 at Pittsburgh.

Lars Nootbaar smacked his first career home run on Aug. 12, 2021 at Pittsburgh.

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Assistant to the President of Baseball Operations **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Marcell Ozuna played in 278 games for St. Louis from 2018-19 after the Cardinals acquired him in a trade with the Marlins on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Zac Gallen**, **Magneuris Sierra** and **Daniel Castano**.

Hunter Dobbins and **Mason Montgomery** were teammates at Texas Tech from 2019-20.

Evan Sisk was selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and pitched in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-21 before St. Louis traded him along with **John Gant** to Minnesota in exchange for **J.A. Happ** and cash considerations on July 30, 2021.

Nick Yorke made his MLB debut at St. Louis on Sept. 16, 2024.

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Yohel Pozo made his Cardinals debut on April 7, 2025 at Pittsburgh in front of approximately 15 family members based in Harrisburg, Pa.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Tonight marks his 6th start of the season (7th career) and 104th career appearance.
- It will be his 8th career appearance vs. the Pirates and his 4th at PNC Park; Owns a career mark of 1-0 with 0.00 ERA in his 8.2 IP vs. PIT with 15 strikeouts.
- Both of wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit and April 17 at Houston.
- Limiting right-handed batters to .217/.308/.391 (10-46) slash with a .699 OPS this season.
- His first 97 career appearances were as a relief pitcher beginning with his Major League debut on July 7, 2023; First career start came at Chicago's Wrigley Field on Sept. 28, 2025.
- Previously started 72-of-89 games over his first four professional seasons (2018-19, 2021-22).
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT (Wed., April 22 at Miami's loanDepot Park): L, 4-1: 5.0 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 1 SO, 0 HR; 89 pitches.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

PARK PLACE: Of his five starts to begin the season, all three on the road have been at Parks (Comerica Park, Daikin Park & loanDepot Park) with tonight at PNC Park adding to that collection.

DEEP DRIVE DIVE: Three of his four HR's allowed have been solo shots, three of the 4 HR's have come in the 3rd inning and 3 of the 4 came in his 4/17 win at Houston.

DECISIVE STARTS: Has earned the decision in each of his 5 starts; losing a team-high 3 games, but could match **May & O'Brien** for team lead in wins (3) with a victory tonight.

BROOM RIDE: Gained the win in the middle game of the Cardinals three-game series sweep at HOU in a 9-4 win on 4/17; Struck out a season high 6, but allowed 3 solo HR's.

ALL EYES ON US: Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX.

EASTER DELIGHT: Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER: The Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42 degrees on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45 degrees and below, two shy of matching Cardinals announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

IF AT FIRST YOU DON'T SUCCEED...: Took the loss in his first career home start vs. NYM (3/30) allowing four runs over a then career-high 5.0 innings and 79 pitches.

CAREER:

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County Player of the Year and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction, Colo., going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 strikeouts and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- Pitched two summers for the Waterloo Bucks of the collegiate summer Northwoods League (2016-17).
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

LEAHY VS. PITTSBURGH:

- Makes his first career start and 8th career appearance against the Pirates tonight.
- Previously faced PIT in seven relief outings (all in 2025), hurling 8.2 innings while allowing just one unearned run for a 0.00 ERA.
- His 15 career strikeouts against the Buccos are his most against any team.
- Has allowed just 2 HR's in his 43.2 career IP vs. NL Central clubs over 32 appearances.
