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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore closes out the pre-All-Star schedule with a six-game homestand that began last night with game one of three against the Cubs...The Royals are in town beginning Friday...The Orioles concluded a brief three-game road trip in Cincinnati on Sunday, taking the first two games of the series before dropping the series finale...The O's enter play 12.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 4.5 games back in the Wild Card.

🦅 The Orioles were held to six hits in last night's loss, the fifth time in the last 12 games with six hits or less...Overall this season, the team is 7-23 (.233) when recording six or fewer hits, including defeats in nine of the last 10 such games since May 24 (G2).

🦅 **Shane Baz** suffered the loss last night despite turning in a quality start (6.0 IP, 3 ER)...His seven quality starts are one shy of **Kyle Bradish** for the team lead.

🦅 **Adley Rutschman** went 2-for-4 with two RBI...He's hit safely in all five of his games this month (7 total H) while driving in a run in three of those (5 total RBI).

OPENING STATEMENTS: The Orioles rotation has posted a 3.63 ERA since May 20, the third-best starter ERA in the AL and fifth best in the majors during that time behind the Tigers (2.99), Mariners (3.12), Brewers (3.23), and Dodgers (3.40).

🦅 Prior to this stretch, the club posted a 5.20 ERA from its starters, third worst in the majors ahead of the Rockies (5.69) and Nationals (5.25) through May 19.

NO CUBS NO: The Orioles and Cubs meet this week for the only series between the teams this season...Chicago took two of three against Baltimore at Wrigley Field last year, which was the first series for both teams following the trade deadline.

🦅 The O's are 8-18 (.308) against the Cubs since the teams first met in 2003, their lowest winning percentage against one opponent all-time...The Birds have lost five home games in a row and are 2-10 (.167) against Chicago at Oriole Park, the lowest winning percentage against one team at the ballpark (since 1992).

ALL-STAR ADLEY: **Adley Rutschman** was named to the 2026 All-Star Game, earning his third career selection (2023 & 2024).

🦅 Rutschman is the fourth catcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to earn multiple All-Star Game selections, joining Matt Wieters (4), Gus Triandos (3), and Andy Etchebarren (2).

🦅 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Rutschman is one of six catchers in MLB to earn at least three All-Star Game selections in their first five full seasons since 1990, joining Brian McCann (4), Mike Piazza (4), Ivan Rodriguez (4), Jason Kendall (3), and Salvador Perez (3).

🦅 Baseball Savant credits Rutschman with a Fielding Run Value of nine, tied with DET's Dillon Dingler and TOR's Brandon Valenzuela for the highest figure among all catchers and tied for the seventh-highest clip among all position players behind STL's JJ Wetherholt (17), CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (16), KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (13), BOS' Ceddanne Rafaela (11), and WSH's Jacob Young (10).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 83 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Athletics (79 G)...The Orioles have drawn at least three walks in 11 straight games, the longest such streak by the club since April 25-May 6, 2000 (also 11).

🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 353 walks this year.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** ranks tied for fourth in the AL with 60 RBI...He is batting .278/.388/.522 (32-for-115) with four doubles, eight homers, 20 runs, 24 RBI, 20 walks, and two hit-by-pitches in 32 games since June 1.

🦅 Alonso is the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 93 RBI in 2013.

🦅 He is one home run shy of becoming the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and Anthony Santander (24) in 2024...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 37 home runs in 2013.

🦅 Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and has played 506 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (871 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .366/.411/.524 (53-for-145) with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 18 runs, 27 RBI, 10 walks (1 IBB), six stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 53 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

🦅 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 125 PA) in batting average (1st) and on-base percentage (3rd) behind CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (.419) and MIL's Andrew Vaughn (.418)...He has eight three-hit games since the beginning of May, tied for second most in the majors during that time with HOU's Yordan Alvarez, behind MIA's Otto Lopez (9).

🦅 Alexander is batting .380 (19-for-50) with five doubles, two triples, one home run, and 25 RBI with runners in scoring position...His RISP average ranks seventh in the majors (min. 45 AB).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 69) and times on base (6th, 158)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

🦅 Ward's slugging percentage difference at home (.259) compared to the road (.446) is the seventh largest in the majors...He has yet to homer at Camden Yards as a member of the Orioles while 15 of his 19 doubles have been on the road.

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: Infielder Jaiden Lo Re and right-handed pitcher JT Quinn have been named the Orioles Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for June, respectively...Both players were selected in the 2025 First-Year Player Draft.

🦅 Lo Re slashed .361/.495/.486 (26-for-72) with four doubles, one triple, one homer, 12 runs, 14 RBI, 19 walks, and 11 stolen bases in 21 games between Single-A Delmarva and Rookie-level FCL Orioles last month, ranking among organizational leaders in on-base percentage (1st), batting average (2nd), hits (T-2nd), and OPS (5th, .981)...He was taken in the fifth round last year out of Corona del Sol (AZ) High School and is currently ranked as the No. 26 Orioles prospect according to *Baseball America*.

🦅 Quinn went 1-0 with a 2.73 ERA (8 ER/26.1 IP) with 17 hits (4 HR), six walks, one hit batter, and 21 strikeouts in five starts with High-A Frederick in June, ranking among organizational leaders in innings pitched (2nd), WHIP (2nd, 0.87), and opponent batting average (3rd, .185)...He was taken last year in the Competitive Balance Round B (No. 69 overall) out of the University of Georgia.

QUICK HITS: Kramer is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season and 127th of his career tonight vs. Chicago-NL...Was activated from the 60-day Injured List (right quad strain) prior to his last start on July 1...Made his season debut on April 13 vs. Arizona after being recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to the game...Went 11-10 in 2025 with a 4.19 ERA (80 ER/171.2 IP) and 1.21 WHIP on 163 hits (22 HR), 45 walks, two hit batters, nine wild pitches, and one balk with 142 strikeouts in 31 appearances (29 GS)...Led the Orioles in innings pitched...Was acquired by Baltimore on July 18, 2018, from Los Angeles-NL along with INF Rylan Bannon, OF Yusniel Díaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Breyvic Valera in exchange for INF Manny Machado.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first victory of the season on July 1 vs. Chicago-AL after allowing one run on four hits (1 HR) and one walk with four strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Has completed at least 5.0 innings and allowed three earned runs or fewer in all three of his MLB starts this season...Threw 79 pitches, 50 strikes.
👉 Has recorded a quality start in back-to-back games for the first time since August 12-17, 2025...He last did so in three straight outings from August 14-25, 2024.

WINDY CITY: Kramer is 1-1 with a 6.00 ERA (6 ER/9.0 IP) over two career starts opposite Chicago-NL...Suffered the loss in his last outing vs. the Cubs on July 9, 2024, at Camden Yards after allowing seven runs (5 ER) on seven hits (2 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts over 4.0 innings pitched.
👉 Over 35 career Interleague starts, he is 11-13 with a 5.05 ERA (104 ER/185.1 IP)...The 5.05 ERA is the third-highest mark against Interleague opponents in MLB since 2022 (min. 30 GS) ahead of COL's Michael Lorenzen (5.21) and CHC's Jameson Taillon (5.07).

LICKETY-SPLIT: Opponents are batting .074 (2-for-27) with zero extra-base hits and 14 strikeouts on Kramer's splitter this season through three starts...The .074 opponent average is the lowest mark among MLB starters (min. 100 splitters thrown) with the next closest pitcher being SEA's Bryce Miller (.109)...His 45.1 percent whiff rate on the pitch is the highest mark among MLB starters (min. 100 splitters thrown) ahead of LAA's José Soriano and CHC's Shota Imanaga (both 41.9%).
👉 Kramer's 39.4 percent whiff rate on his splitter in 2025 ranked third in MLB (min. 500 splitters thrown), trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (42.1%) and NYM's Kodai Senga (41.8%)...Held batters to a .206 average (32-for-155) on his split finger and recorded 51 strikeouts with it, the most with any of his pitches.

SMALL SAMPLE: His 4.6 percent walk rate over three starts this season is the lowest mark of his career ahead of 2025 (6.4%) and would be the third-lowest mark in MLB if he was qualified, trailing TB's Nick Martínez (4.4%) and Drew Rasmussen (4.5%).
👉 His 30.8 percent strikeout rate is also the highest mark of his career ahead of 2020 (26.5%)...It would rank second in MLB this season if he was qualified behind MIL's Jacob Misorowski (39.6%).

RIGHT HAND MAN: Kramer is holding right-handed hitters to a .091 (3-for-33) average with one home run, two walks, and eight strikeouts over seven games (6 GS) since September 5, 2025...Over his first 27 outings (26 GS) of 2025, righties hit .260 (73-for-281) with 13 doubles, eight home runs, 20 walks, and 64 strikeouts.

IN THE ZONE: During the 2025 season, Kramer's 65.7 first-pitch strike percentage was the second-highest mark by a qualified Oriole since tracking began in 1988, trailing Wei-Yin Chen (68.3%, 2015)...That mark also ranked 10th in MLB and fifth in the AL behind DET's Tarik Skubal (71.5%), TOR's Kevin Gausman (68.8%), SEA's Bryan Woo (66.5%), and MIN's Joe Ryan (66.0%).
👉 Kramer has registered a 61.5 first-pitch strike percentage (40/65) over three starts this season, including a 50.0 percent mark (11/22) in his previous start on July 1 vs. Chicago-AL.

THE DISTANCE: Kramer's 171.2 innings led the Orioles in 2025 and were 1.0 inning shy of his career high set in 2023...Became the seventh pitcher in as many seasons to lead the Orioles in innings, marking the first seven-season span with seven different pitchers leading the club in innings since the first eight seasons in franchise history (1954-61), per *Stats Perform*.
👉 Made six starts in 2025 in which he threw 7.0+ innings while allowing three hits or fewer, tied for the second-most such outings in franchise history (since 1954) behind Wally Bunker (7 GS, 1964)...Tied with BOS' Garrett Crochet and SD's Nick Pivetta for the second-most such starts in MLB behind DET's Tarik Skubal (8 GS).
