**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**APRIL 18**  
**1998** - The Astros beat the Expos in the 'Dome, 4-3, on a walkoff homer by **3B Sean Berry** in the bottom of the 9th...**2B Craig Biggio** goes 2x5 with a pair of runs scored and takes sole possession of the franchise record for runs scored, surpassing **César Cedeño** (890) on the all-time list...Biggio would finish his Hall of Fame career with 1,844 runs scored, by far the most in club history, ahead of second-place **1B Jeff Bagwell** (1,517).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The homestanding Astros will try to even up this three-game series with their former division rivals, the St. Louis Cardinals, tonight at Daikin Park...Astros veteran **RHP Lance McCullers** will make his fourth start of the season and the first of his career against the Cardinals, opposite **RHP Andre Pallante** and the Redbirds.

**ABOUT MCCULLERS:** **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** is set to make his fourth start of the season and his second at Daikin Park (also, March 30 vs. BOS, 1ER/7IP, 9SO)...McCullers made his return to the mound in 2025 after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...he worked around four IL stints in 2025 to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP in 16 games (13 starts).

**ON THE RADIO:** Due to a scheduling overlap with the Houston Rockets, tonight's Astros radio broadcast can be heard on **KTRH 740 AM**...the popular combination of **Robert Ford** and **Steve Sparks** will be on the radio call tonight.

**GIVEAWAY SEASON:** Tonight, 10,000 fans will receive an **Astros Ice Cream Bucket Hat**, presented by Texas Bay Credit Union...at last night's game, 10,000 fans received a **Carlos Correa City Connect Jersey**, presented by Houston Methodist.

**HOME-COOKIN':** Tonight is the fifth game of a six-game homestand for the Astros, in which they'll host a pair of NL opponents in the Rockies (2-1) and Cardinals (0-1)...the Astros have been great at home in 2026, going 7-4, including a seven-game winning streak, which was snapped on Thursday.

**VS. THE CARDS:** This series is a matchup of former division rivals, who spent 19 seasons together in the NL Central from 1994-2012...overall, the two teams have played each other 723 times, with the Astros going 336-385...these teams also have postseason history, with the Astros going 7-6 vs. the Cards in the playoffs...the two clubs faced off in back-to-back NLCS in 2004-05 with St. Louis taking the '04 NLCS in seven games and Houston winning the '05 NLCS in six games.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Astros and Cardinals played a close ballgame last night until St. Louis broke it up open late in a 9-4 Astros loss...**DH Yordan Alvarez** continued his great start, going 2x5 with his eighth homer of the season, which ranks tied for first in the Majors...**RHP Peter Lambert** (4ER/5IP) made his first start as an Astro, making him the 10th different starter used by the Astros in their 21 games this season.

**MEDICAL UPDATE:** **LF Joey Loperfido** left last night's game with right quad tightness...later in the game, **3B Isaac Paredes** was removed from the contest due to leg discomfort.

**MINOR LEAGUE SIGNINGS:** The Astros officially signed **RHP Brandon Bielak** and **RHP Miguel Yajure** to minor league contracts yesterday, assigning them both to Triple A Sugar Land.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** The Astros have claimed **OF Dustin Harris** off waivers from Chicago (AL)...to make room for Harris on the 40-man roster, the Astros have designated **RHP J.P. France** for assignment.

**THE ORDER:** The Astros have used 21 different batting orders in their 21 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

**HOT START:** **LF Yordan Alvarez** ranks first in the AL in extra-base hits (14), total bases (54), RBI (19), OPS (1.229), SLG (.750) and OBP (.479), ranks third in walks (18), fourth in runs scored (17) and in batting average (.333), and tied for fourth in doubles (6).

**MR. 2000:** **2B Jose Altuve** has appeared in 1,996 career games and is looking to become the third player in franchise history to reach 2,000 career games, which would join him with **Craig Biggio** (2,850) and **Jeff Bagwell** (2,150)...only four active players have reached 2,000 career games: **Andrew McCutchen** (2,276), **Carlos Santana** (2,212), **Fredie Freeman** (2,198) and **Paul Goldschmidt** (2,081).

**EXTRA! EXTRA!:** **2B Jose Altuve** recorded his 750th career extra-base hit on Thursday night with his 461st career double...he also has 32 triples and 258 home runs, all coming as an Astro...only **Craig Biggio** (1,014) and **Jeff Bagwell** (969) have more extra-base hits than Altuve in franchise history.

**AGENT SMITH:** According to Baseball Savant, **RF Cam Smith** has played like one of the best all-around Major League players in 2026, ranking in the 99th percentile in fielding range (OAA), 98th percentile in bat speed, 96th percentile in sprint speed and 93rd percentile in barrel percentage...on the season, Smith is hitting .264 (19x72) with three homers, 10 RBI and an .807 OPS in 21 games.

**BEHIND THE DISH:** **C Christian Vázquez** is hitting .400 (312x30) with four doubles, two homers and 10 RBI in nine games...he's made just seven start at catcher, yet still ranks tied for fourth among AL catchers in RBI, trailing only **Dillon Dingler** (14), **Shea Langeliers** (12) and **Cal Raleigh** (11).

**HARD TO HIT:** **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**, just the second Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history, has held opponents to 6x41 on the season for a .146 opponent average...overall, Teng has gone 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3ER/11.2IP), a 0.86 WHIP and 11 strikeouts in 11.2 innings in relief.

**LAST START, 4/11 at SEA:** In his 3rd start of the year, allowed 6 runs on 5 hits with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts (79 pitches-46 strikes)...had recorded a 3.27 ERA (4ER/11IP) with a .237 opponent average, a 1.18 WHIP and 13 strikeouts through his first 2 starts of the year.

**VS. THE CARDS:** will be making his 1st career appearance vs. the Cardinals with tonight's start...along with the Astros, the only other teams he's yet to face in his career are the Rockies, Brewers, Mets and Nationals...the only player on the Cardinals active roster he's faced in his career is **IF Ramón Urías**, who's gone 1x2 with a single in their career matchups.

**CUT ABOVE:** Has thrown his cutter at a 31.5-percent rate, the highest of any of his pitches this season...per Baseball Savant, he only began to throw a cutter last season and threw it at a 4.5-percent rate...batters have gone just 3x16 (.188) vs. his cutter this year, while also inducing 4 strikeouts with a 24.3 whiff percentage with the pitch.

**APPROACHING 800:** enters tonight start with 789.1 innings pitched...he's looking to become the 25th player in Astros history to reach 800 career innings with the club, and the 1st to do so since **LHP Framer Valdez**.

**SEASON DEBUT:** had a spectacular debut to his 2026 season, striking out 9 over 7.0 innings while allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk (96 pitches-63 strikes) on March 30 vs. LAA...was his longest start since also tossing 7.0 innings on Sept. 21, 2022 at TB...was his longest start while allowing 1-or-fewer runs since allowing 1 run through 7.0 innings on July 16, 2021 at CWS...was his longest start in a season debut in his 9-year MLB career and were his most strikeouts in a season debut since striking out 10 batters on March 31, 2018 at TEX...is also the longest start by an Astro and tied for the 7th-longest start by an AL pitcher this season.

**2025 RECAP:** made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.

**GROUNDING:** is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.3 ground-ball percentage ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP Framer Valdez** (62.3%) and **RHP Logan Webb** (57.9%).

**ABOUT MCCULLERS JR.:** the 2017 All-Star has made 149 apps. (143 starts) in 9 MLB seasons with Houston (2015-18, 2020-22, 2025-26), posting a 52-37 record with a 3.74 ERA (328ER/789.1IP) and 878 strikeouts (10.0 SO/9IP)...missed the 2019 and 2023-24 seasons due to injury.
