Dubón's AB

Last night against Devin Williams, Mauricio Dubón strung together a 14-pitch plate appearance in the ninth inning – the longest PA of his career.

He singled on the last pitch, one of just three 14-pitch PAs in MLB this season to end in a base hit.

It stands as the longest Braves plate appearance to culminate in a hit since at least 1998...Multiple Braves have logged hits in 13-pitch PAs in that time, including Sean Murphy and Jurickson Profar, who each homered in 13-pitch PAs last season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and New York Mets today continue a three-game weekend series with the second of 13 scheduled games between the clubs this season...This is the first of four series between the teams this season...They will next meet for a four-game wraparound series from July 3-6.

A Atlanta fell to the Mets last night, 7-5...The club dropped to 6-6 in series openers on the road and to 35-4 (.897) when scoring at least five runs...The Braves started the season 35-2 when scoring five, but have lost each of their last two games when doing so...The club won 20 straight games when scoring five runs from April 26-June 6.

A The Braves and Mets are slated to play all of their regular season games during the summer months for the second consecutive season...Each of the contests between these two clubs will be completed by August 12...In that span, 25% of Atlanta's games will be against New York.

A Atlanta played to an 8-5 record against New York last season, including a 4-3 mark here at Citi Field...Overall, the 2025 Braves went 30-22 against the NL East, but 46-64 against all other opponents.

A The Braves have taken the season series from the Mets for nine consecutive seasons, dating to 2018...The team is 83-62 (.572) against New York in that span.

A LH Sean Manaea will climb the hill to make his third career start (fourth appearance) against Atlanta...He has faced the Braves while with each of his former teams: the Athletics (2017), Padres (2022) and Giants (2023)...The 6-foot-5, 245-pound left-hander is 0-1 in those games with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER/18.0 IP)...Today's outing will mark Manaea's first start of the season after making his previous 14 appearances from the bullpen...This year, he is 1-1 with a 5.02 ERA (24 ER/43.0 IP).

MARTÍN PÉREZ: Will make his 10th start of the season (14th appearance) with a 4-3 record and a 3.02 ERA (19 ER/56.2 IP)...The southpaw from Guanare, VZ, has started against the Mets six times previously (10 total games), posting a perfect 4-0 record and a 3.09 ERA (15 ER/43.2 IP).

A This year, Pérez has completed at least 5.0 innings in all nine of his starting assignments...The native of Guanare, VZ, has limited opponents to two earned runs-or-fewer in six of those turns.

A Among the 16 active starting pitchers that are at least 35 years old (min. 9 starts), Pérez' ERA (3.02) is fourth-best in MLB behind Zack Wheeler (PHI, 2.22), Chris Sale (ATL, 2.30) and Nick Martinez (TB, 2.43).

A There are 49 pitchers that have made at least 10 appearances this season at age 35 or older...Among that group, five of the top 13 ERAs belong to Braves: Robert Suarez (2nd, 0.61), Raisel Iglesias (3rd, 1.21), Chris Sale (9th, 2.30), Pérez (11th, 3.02) and Tyler Kinley (T13th, 3.18).

ON LOSING: The Braves have lost three consecutive games for just the second time this season, and for the first time since doing so on the road against Arizona (2) and Los Angeles-AL (1) from April 4-6.

A Atlanta is one of two clubs that has yet to endure a four-game losing streak...Last series' opponent, the Chicago White Sox, also hasn't...The last Braves team to go deeper into a season without a four-game losing streak was the 2022 club, which didn't have a four-game spell all season.

A The Braves are attempting to avoid just their fourth series loss of the season, which would still be the fewest in Major League Baseball...The Los Angeles Dodgers have the next-fewest, with five.

RILEY AGAINST THE METS: Austin Riley reached base safely three times last night, drawing a pair of walks and lashing a double into the left-center gap...The hit carried an exit velocity of 110.5 mph, his fourth-hardest-hit ball of the season.

A Among active players with at least 50 games played against the Mets, Riley's .877 OPS is eighth-best... Ronald Acuña Jr. (3rd, .917) and Matt Olson (4th, .897) both rank ahead of him.

A Riley has hit 12 home runs in this ballpark, his most of any road venue ahead of Citizens Bank Park (11).

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Sean Manaea this afternoon...The team enters play 20-9 (.690) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins in such games in the majors this year.

A Dating even further to 2019, no team in Major League Baseball has been better against lefties... The Braves have gone 186-108 (.633) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .621 (205-125).

A Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 19 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 13-6 record in those games.

A The Braves have alternated wins and losses in their last 10 games against left-handed starters, going 5-5 against southpaws since May 22.

A Both the Braves and their opponent will field a left-handed starting pitcher for the ninth time this season...The team enters play 5-3 when both starters are left-handed.

JR RITCHIE: Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings of relief last night, giving up just two hits, two walks and striking out five...The 22-year-old is 1-1 with a 3.82 ERA (13 ER/30.2 IP) this season.

A He became the first Brave to complete at least 5.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen since July 26, 2011...Cristhian Martínez pitched innings 11-16 of a 19-inning game versus Pittsburgh.

A The last Brave to do so without extra innings was Charlie Puleo on May 6, 1988 versus Philadelphia.

Today's Game

Makes his 10th start of the season and the 289th of his career in the middle game of a three-game series at New York (NL)...In his most recent turn June 5 against Pittsburgh, the 35-year-old Venezuelan earned the win, allowing three runs over 5.0 innings in Atlanta's 6-3 victory at Truist Park.

Owens a 4-0 record and a 3.09 ERA (15 ER/43.2 IP) in 10 career appearances (six starts) against the Mets...Has never lost a decision to New York...Last defeated them on August 28, 2023 with Texas, working 2.0 scoreless innings in relief in a 4-3 win.

Has allowed five hits or fewer in 19 consecutive starts dating to March 31, 2025, the longest active streak of its kind by a left-handed starting pitcher...The run is the second-longest by a left-handed starter since 1901, trailing only Tony Cingrani's 22-game streak from 2013-14.

The 6-foot, 210-pound left-hander enters with a 4-3 record and a 3.02 ERA (19 ER/56.2 IP) over 13 total appearances - nine starts and four relief outings - with 47 strikeouts against 20 walks.

Owens a 3.02 ERA (19 ER/56.2 IP) through his first 13 games of the season, the second-lowest mark he has posted over a season-opening 13-game span in his career, trailing only the 2.10 ERA (19 ER/81.1 IP) he recorded to begin 2022 with Texas...His next-lowest such span was a 3.22 ERA over his first 13 games of 2016, also with the Rangers.

Right-handed batters are hitting .207 (29-for-140) with four homers off Pérez this season, while left-handers are batting .186 (11-for-59) with two homers.

2026

Earned the win in his most recent start June 5 against Pittsburgh, allowing three runs on three hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and five strikeouts on 85 pitches in Atlanta's 6-3 victory at Truist Park...All three runs scored in the third inning.

Earned the win May 30 at Cincinnati, allowing two runs on four hits over 5.0 innings with three walks and two strikeouts on 81 pitches in Atlanta's 5-2 victory at Great American Ball Park...Bleday's two-run homer in the second was the only home run he surrendered.

Took the loss in his most recent start May 24 against Washington, allowing one run on five hits over 5.2 innings with two walks and two strikeouts on 86 pitches in Atlanta's 2-1 defeat at Truist Park...Lile's double was the only extra-base hit he surrendered.

Logged his first career 10-strikeout game in his 285th start on May 19 at Miami, the second-most starts before a first career 10-or-more strikeout game among pitchers to debut since 1893, trailing only Doyle Alexander (321st start, July 23, 1985)...At 35 years, 45 days, Pérez is the 17th-oldest pitcher to record a first career 10-strikeout game dating to 1893, and the first to do so at age 35-or-older since Colin Rea (35 years, 79 days) on September 18, 2025 (per Elias).

Received a no-decision May 19 at Miami, working 5.0 innings with two walks, a career-high 10 strikeouts and a home run on 78 pitches in Atlanta's 8-4 win at loanDepot park...Set a career high in strikeouts and recorded his first career 10-strikeout game.

Tossed a perfect inning of relief on May 16 vs. Boston, striking out a pair on 14 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in the Braves' 3-2 loss at Truist Park.

Worked a perfect inning of relief on May 13 vs. the Cubs, striking out two on 12 pitches in Atlanta's 4-1 win at Truist Park.

Took the loss in his start on May 6 at Seattle, allowing two runs on five hits over 5.2 innings with one walk, five strikeouts and a home run on 84 pitches in a 3-1 defeat at T-Mobile Park...The home run was a solo shot by Julio Rodríguez in the sixth.

Earned his second win as a Brave on April 28 vs. Detroit, working 5.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with four walks and five strikeouts on 91 pitches in the 5-2 victory at Truist Park.

Tossed 3.0 innings of relief on April 22 at Washington, allowing a pair of solo home runs in a span of three batters in the sixth inning, but did not factor in the decision in the 8-6 win.

Earned his first win as a Brave on April 17 at Philadelphia, holding the Phillies to four hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 94 pitches in the 9-0 victory at Citizens Bank Park.

Took the loss in his second start with Atlanta on April 11 vs. Cleveland, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with three walks, two strikeouts and a home run on 86 pitches in a 6-0 defeat...The lone run came on a solo home run by José Ramírez in the fourth inning.

Allowed four earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in his first career start as a member of the Braves on April 5 at Arizona, walking one with one strikeout on 75 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings.

Made his first appearance with the Braves on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the 5-2 loss.

Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on April 17...Originally had his contract selected on March 30 before being designated for assignment on April 12, outrighted to Gwinnett on April 14, and re-signed to a minor league deal on April 15.
