O'S ON THE INJURED LIST

Austin Hays 10-day (right hamstring strain) 60-day (lower back strain) Chris Davis Hunter Harvey 60-day (left oblique strain) TWICE AS NICE: Due to last night's postponement, the O's and Mariners will play a doubleheader today with two, 7.0-inning games beginning at 4:05 p.m...Game 2 will start approximately 45 minutes following Game 1, but not before the originally scheduled 7:05 p.m start time...It is the first doubleheader of the season for the O's, who went a combined 1-7 in four doubleheaders last season, including being swept in each of their last two (9/17 against TB and 9/4 against NYY).

 θ_{s} Three of the four O's doubleheaders last season came at Oriole Park: in two of the three (8/5 against MIA and 9/17 against TB) the O's acted as the road team and batted first in one of the games.

JUST KEEP HITTING: OF Cedric Mullins has begun his season with 17 hits in 37 at-bats (.459)...His 17 hits are tied for the most in the majors...He's hit safely in each of the O's first nine games; he also hit safely in four-straight games to close out the 2020 season and combined has hit safely in 13-straight games, which is the longest active streak in the majors...His nine-game hitting streak just this season is a career-high for a single-season (previous-high six-straight).

- $oldsymbol{ heta}_{\!\scriptscriptstyle S}$ Mullins nine-game hitting streak to begin the season is the longest by an Oriole since Manny Machado in 2016 (16-straight); club record is 17-straight by Davey Johnson in 1971...There has been 15 double-digit hitting streaks to begin a season in O's history.
- Mullins has led off each game this season, and has gone 5-for-9 in his first at-bats of the game; has gone 10-for-17 when leading off any inning, with his 10 hits leading all of baseball in this category.
- his 17 hits are tied with Ronald Acuña, Jr. for the most amongst hitters in baseball batting in the lead off slot.
- Mullins has gone 6-for-11 (.545) against left-handed pitching to start the season; in Spring Training, he became a full-time left-handed hitter after switch hitting his entire professional career.

ON A ROLL: LHP John Means makes the start in Game 1, looking to extend his streak of consecutive starts allowing one-or-fewer total runs to seven-straight...His current streak of sixstraight such starts is tied with Hall of Famer, and current O's broadcaster, RHP Jim Palmer (5/20-6/10/1978) for the O's club record.

- Means during this stretch has gone 3-1 with a 1.27 ERA (5 ER/35.1 IP) and 39 strikeouts... Palmer during his stretch went 5-0 with a 0.18 ERA (1 ER/50.1 IP) and 20 strikeouts; Palmer pitched four shutouts during this span.
- Ox The O's record for consecutive starts of allowing one-or-fewer earned runs is eightstraight, done by Palmer (5/20-6/18/1978); Means' six-straight such starts currently sits tied for second in team history in this category (also: RHP Tom Phoebus, 6/28-7/21/1968 and RHP Hoyt Wilhelm, 9/20/1958-5/2/1959).

AN UNFAMILIAR OPPONENT: The Orioles and Seattle Mariners square off for the first time since 2019...Today's games mark the first time the Orioles have played an opponent outside the AL East or NL East divisions since they faced the Mariners on September 22, 2019.

- Orioles batters are tied for the third-youngest group in baseball (27.1 years old) and Mariners pitchers are the fourth-youngest group in baseball (28.1 years old), according to Baseball Reference.
- $oldsymbol{artheta}_{\!\scriptscriptstyleeta}$ The four Orioles starters scheduled for this series have made a combined two career appearances against the Mariners (Means and Harvey one game apiece).
- Only two current O's batters have appeared in at least 10 games against the Mariners in their careers (Galvis - 11 and Mancini - 17).

BACK-TO-BACK FOR BOOM BOOM: INF/OF Trey Mancini has homered in each of the last two games; first time homering in back-to-back games this season and the 11^{th} time for his career...His career-long streak is three-straight games, done once (7/24-26/2019).

Ox Both of his home runs came on the first pitch...For his career, Mancini has slashed .360/.360/.704 (73-for-203) and recorded 17 home runs with a 0-0 count; his 17 home runs are the most in his career for any count.

PAST WEEK STRUGGLES: The O's have dropped each of their first three home games, after being swept by Boston over the weekend...It is the second time in the past three seasons (2019) in which they've dropped each of their first three homes; also started 4-2 on the opening road trip in 2019 before dropping three-straight at home.

- Φ After hitting .325 (13-for-40) with runners in scoring position in the opening series at BOS, the O's have batted .122 (5-for-41) with RISP since 4/5; the lowest average with RISP in the AL during this span.
- The O's have struck out double digit times in eight-straight games (8-of-9 overall).

ON THE BOARD: OF Ryan McKenna collected his first career hit in the game on 4/11 against Boston, a triple in the sixth inning off of RHP Nick Pivetta; finished the game 2-for-3 with two runs scored.

McKenna became the first Oriole to record a triple for his first career hit since Manny Machado (8/9/2012 vs. KC)

WELCOME, MAIKEL: INF Maikel Franco connected on his first home run as an Oriole on 4/11 against Boston...He drove in a season-high four runs in the game as well, the 16th time in his career with four-or-more RBI in a game...His nine RBI lead the Orioles.

- Pranco has started each game this season for the O's (seven at third base and two as the DH)...He's started in 74-straight games, dating back to 9/24/19 G2 at WSH.
- 🔗 Franco has drawn as many walks (5) as times he's struck out this season (5); he's one of two O's to have done so (Stewart 3 walks and 1 strikeout); his .325 OBP ranks second on the team (min. 10 at-bats).

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on 4/7 at NYY...Allowed just one run on seven hits and two walks with four strikeouts through 4.2 innings...Has not earned a decision against the Yankees since suffering a loss on 8/13/19 in New York.

GONE STREAKING: With his Opening Day scoreless victory and the no-decision in his last start, Means has allowed just one or fewer total runs in six-consecutive starts dating back to 9/8/20...This is tied with Hall of Famer and current Orioles broadcaster, Jim Palmer (5/20-6/10/78), for the longest such streak in Orioles history.

CAREER VS. SEATTLE: On 9/22/19, Means faced the Mariners for the first and only time in his career...He earned the win in a quality start at Oriole Park, tossing 7.0 innings of one-run ball with one walk and four strikeouts.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: In just five career appearances against the American League West in 2019, Means went 2-2 and pitched to a 1.88 ERA (6 ER/28.2 IP) with six walks, 18 strikeouts and just three home runs allowed...Only one of his starts against the AL West have been away from Oriole Park at Camden Yards (6/5/19 at TEX).

MEANS BUSINESS: On 4/2 at BOS, Means became the 17th pitcher in Major League history, and first Oriole, to toss at least 7.0 innings, while allowing one or fewer hits in a start on Opening Day; he is the third pitcher in Major League history to do so without issuing a walk, joining Irv Young (1906) and Jordan Zimmermann (2019)...It was the second time in his career he did not allow a run in a start (last: 6/28/19 vs. CLE, 5.0 IP, H, BB, 5 SO)...Means is the first pitcher in Orioles history to work at least 7.0 innings, while allowing one or fewer hits, and no runs in a start at Fenway Park...He joined Mike Mussina (5/30/97) and Jim Palmer (5/12/67) as one of three Orioles to throw at least 7.0 innings, allowing one or fewer hits, no runs, and no walks in a start

WELCOME HOME: Making his first start at Oriole Park at Camden Yards since 9/20/20 where he earned the win against Tampa Bay... In 24 career games (22 starts) at OPACY, is 9-8 with a 3.56 ERA (45 ER/113.2 IP), 22 walks, and 96 strikeouts...Has held the opponent to a .219 (94-for-429) batting average with 18 home runs.

<u>2020 HIGHLIGHTS:</u> Means went 2-4 with a 4.53 ERA (22 ER/43.2 IP), seven walks, 42 strikeouts, and a .220 opponents' batting average in 10 starts in last year's shortened season...Had a solid final four outings, going 2-1 with a 1.52 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) with three walks and 30 strikeouts...Was the only Orioles pitcher to record double-digit strikeouts in a game in 2020 when he struck out a career-high 12 batters on 9/20 vs. TB...Struck out seven-straight Rays batters in the same game to match the Orioles' club record for consecutive strikeouts set by Sammy Stewart in 1978...Led the team in strikeouts (42), tied RHP Alex Cobb for most starts (10), and finished second in innings pitched (43.2)

GAME 2 STARTER - RHP DEAN KREMER (0-1, 9.00 ERA)

Kremer will be starting at Oriole Park for the first time this season... Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11 IP), six walks, and 13 strikeouts in two starts at Camden Yards in 2020... Gave up his first-career home run in his last outing on 4/6 at NYY...Will be facing an opponent outside of the American League East for the first time in his career...Made his MLB debut on 9/6/20 vs. NYY, where he earned the win after allowing just one run on one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts through 6.0 innings of work...Kremer started all five 2021 Spring Training games he appeared in, going 0-1 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER/15.2 IP) with eight walks and 16 strikeouts.

QUICK HITS: Made the Opening Day roster for the first time in his career... Kremer made four starts in his rookie campaign...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Rylan Bannon, OF Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Breyvic Valera from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for INF Manny Machado on 7/18/18...Ranked as the Orioles' No. 9 prospect by Baseball America and No. 8 by MLB.com...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV....Became the first Israeli citizen to be selected in the MLB Draft...Pitched for Israel's National Team in the 2017 World Baseball Classic and was named Most Valuable Pitcher for Israel in 2014 and 2015 after he helped the team qualify for the European Baseball Championship...Has dual Israeli-American citizenship.

<u>LAST START:</u> Suffered the loss on 4/6 at NYY in his first start of the year... Tossed 3.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits and four walks with five strikeouts...The four free passes were a career high...Gave up the first home run of his career, a solo shot from Jay Bruce to right field in the second inning.

OUT WITH THE OLD, IN WITH THE NEW: Tonight's contest against Seattle marks Kremer's first-career appearance against an American League West opponent...All five of his previous career starts have come against the American League East, where he is 1-2, and has pitched to a 5.40 ERA (13 ER/21.2 IP) with 16 walks, and 27 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Tonight is Kremer's first appearance at home this season...Made two starts at Oriole Park in 2020, pitching to a record of 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP), six walks, and 13 strikeouts...Kremer owned a 0.91 WHIP at Oriole Park last year, and held opponents to a .108 (4-for-37) average..This compared to a career 9.28 ERA (11 ER/10.2 IP) in three road games.

LEFT AND RIGHT: Kremer did not give up a hit to a left-handed batter (0-for-13) in his first two outings last season...Through his first three starts of 2020, lefties hit just .111 (3-for-27) against him with eight strikeouts, while right-handers hit .179 (5-for-28) with 12 strikeouts against him through his first three starts last year...In his career, lefties are hitting .171 (6-for-35) with just one home run, compared to a .286 (14-for-49) mark against righties with no homers.

MLB DEBUT: Earned the win in his Major League debut on 9/6/20 vs. NYY, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing just one run on one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts...Struck out DJ LeMahieu (looking) for his first career strikeout...Became the fourth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to work at least 6.0 IP while allowing one-or-fewer hits in his big league debut, and the sixth pitcher in O's history to strike out at least seven batters in his Major League debut.

SPRING TRAINING: Went 0-1 in five starts during Spring Training 2021, and pitched to a 6.32 ERA (11 ER/15.2 IP)...Threw 4.2 innings, his longest outing, in his final start vs. BOS on 3/24, in which he allowed two runs on five hits and one walk with five strikeouts.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Recalled from the Alternate Training Site at Double-A Bowie on 9/6/20 and made his Major League debut on that same day vs. New York-AL...Became the fourth of five Orioles to make his Major League debut in 2020...Over his first three big league starts, he went 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP), tossed 5.0 innings-or-more, allowed one run-or-fewer, and recorded at least six strikeouts...Did not allow a home run in his 18.2 innings worked...Faced just the Yankees, Red Sox, and Rays, going 1-1 overall with a 4.82 ERA (10 ER/18.2 IP), 12 walks, and 22 strikeouts.
