Atlanta was swept yesterday in Minnesota, and never once held a lead in the three-game set. Per Elias, it marked the first series of at least three games in which the Braves never led since April 1-4, 2021, at Philadelphia, when the Phillies swept three games in the opening series of the season.

The Twins scored in the first inning on Monday and Tuesday, and the Braves were trailing entering 21 of their 27 half-innings at-bat in the series.

ONE-STOP SHOP: The Braves and White Sox today play the make-up game of their originally-scheduled matchup on June 11 which was postponed by inclement weather...Atlanta was in Minnesota wrapping up a three-game series yesterday afternoon, and will open another three-game set in Milwaukee tomorrow.

 The White Sox won both games of the original series between these two clubs in June, taking a pair of one-run victories...With the losses Atlanta fell below .500 against Chicago all-time (14-15, .483).

 Atlanta has just one series win against Chicago-AL in the last seven seasons, dating to 2020...All-time, the Braves are 4-6-1 in series play against the White Sox.

 The Braves have lost four consecutive games here at Rate Field, and are just 5-12 (.294) here all-time...Since this park opened in 1991, Atlanta's .294 winning percentage in this building is by far the lowest in baseball...Texas, at 56-83 (.403), ranks 29th.

 RH Grant Holmes made the first start of his career against the White Sox during the original series between the two teams this season, June 9 here at Rate Field...The 6-foot-0, 226-pound South Carolina native allowed four hits and three runs over 3.2 innings in that turn, taking a no-decision... The right-hander took the loss in his last turn last Saturday versus Arizona, stopping a streak of seven consecutive Braves wins in his turns.

 LH Anthony Kay was also the scheduled starter in this original matchup on June 11, and will make his first start and second overall appearance against Atlanta this afternoon...The White Sox have won each of his three starts in the month of August, during which he is 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP)...The 6-foot-0, 225-pound native of Stony Brook, NY, has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of his last 10 starts dating to June 22, and the left-hander is 3-3 with a 3.18 ERA overall in that span.

MATT OLSON IS FAST: Matt Olson went 1-for-3 with a walk and a run scored yesterday afternoon at Minnesota, and swiped his fourth base of the season in the seventh inning...He has two of his four stolen bases on the season over his last four games.

 The four stolen bases this year also match his career high, originally set in 2021 while with Oakland.

 Olson has not been caught stealing on the basepaths since April 21, 2021, and has successfully swiped each of his last 10 attempts...Out of 477 runners with at least 10 stolen base attempts since that date, he is one of only six who has yet to be caught.

 Yesterday's run scored was also Olson's 89th on the season, third most in all of baseball...Only James Wood (100) and Pete Crow-Armstrong (90) have scored more runs this season...Since joining Atlanta prior to the 2022 season, Olson's 478 total runs scored trail just Kyle Schwarber (502) in the NL.

FIRST-PLACE TEAMS: Atlanta today begins a stretch of seven consecutive games against teams currently in first place in their division...Follow today's tilt with the White Sox (AL Central, +4.0), the Braves play three against the Brewers (NL Central, +4.5) and Dodgers (NL West, +9.0).

 Atlanta (NL East, +4.5) has played just eight games against the five other teams currently leading their divisions, and has gone 4-4 (.500) in these affairs... The Braves dropped the two games earlier this season versus the White Sox, and went 2-1 in three-game sets against the Brewers and Dodgers...Atlanta has yet to see either Tampa Bay or Houston in the American League.

 Over a larger sample size against good opponents, Atlanta's 32-24 (.571) record against teams at or above .500 ranks third best in all of baseball...Only Milwaukee (41-21, .661) and Houston (19-14, .576) have been better.

 Atlanta owns the second-hardest remaining strength of schedule in baseball over the remainder of the season, with its opponents combining for a .530 winning percentage...Only Cincinnati, with a .557 opponents mark, has a harder schedule the rest of the way.

RONALD NEARING HISTORY: Ronald Acuña Jr. slugged his 13th home run of the season and the 199th home run of his career on Saturday night vs. Arizona... In the four games since, while this note has been on the front page of the game notes, he has gone 3-for-17 with two singles and a double.

 Acuña Jr.'s next home run will stand as the 200th of his career, and he is looking to become the fastest player in major league history, by games played, to reach at least 200 home runs and 200 stolen bases.

 Alfonso Soriano holds the current record, swiping a pair of bases in his 929th career game to reach 203 home runs and 201 stolen bases...Acuña Jr. currently has 220 stolen bases to go with his 199 home runs... Today's game will be the 893rd of his career.

 Acuña Jr. is batting leadoff for Atlanta again this afternoon, and enters play with 840 career hits from the top spot in the batting order...He needs just two hits to tie, and three to pass, Rafael Furcal for the most hits as a leadoff batter in franchise history... Furcal amassed 842 knocks over 723 games batting leadoff from 2000 to 2005.

SKIDDING: Atlanta has lost three straight games and five of its last six dating to last Friday...The skid comes on the heels of the Braves going 11-3 over 14 games from July 29 to August 12.

 The Braves have just one longer losing streak this season, dropping four straight games from June 21 to June 24.

 Atlanta has scored just 15 total runs over its last six games, including just 10 in the five losses...The Braves are batting .191 as a club in that span.
