YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the White Sox, 7-6 in 10 innings, yesterday at Guaranteed Rate Field...Marked the second walk-off loss for the O's this season, joining April 1 at Boston...**Cedric Mullins** reached base five times after going 2-for-3 with a double, an RBI, and three walks while **Jorge Mateo** recorded a season-high three hits by going 3-for-4 with a homer, a run scored, and two RBI.

⚾ Mateo's go-ahead RBI single in the sixth inning yesterday had an exit velocity of a career-high 112.4 mph, the hardest-hit ball by an Oriole this season.
 ⚾ The Orioles walked a season-high 10 times yesterday and have walked 19 times in this series; marks only the eighth time in franchise history (since 1954) that the team has drawn nine-or-more walks in back-to-back games, last done from September 14-15, 1996; the 19 total walks the last two days are the most in a two-game stretch by the O's since May 17-18, 1997.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: The O's and White Sox wrap up their first series this season with today's game at Guaranteed Rate Field...Baltimore and Chicago-AL will play six times in 2023 with the Orioles hosting the Sox from August 28-30...The O's went 5-2 against the White Sox in 2022, taking three of four games in Chicago from June 23-26 and two of three at Oriole Park from August 23-25.

LOOKING AHEAD: The Orioles have a scheduled off day tomorrow before traveling to Washington, D.C. for two games against the Nationals from April 18-19...Following another off day on Thursday, the O's open a six-game homestand with the Tigers from April 21-23 and Red Sox from April 24-26.

ON THE ATTACK: Baltimore is batting .257/.353/.455 (128-for-499) with 31 doubles, one triple, 22 home runs, 86 runs scored, 84 RBI, and 71 walks in 15 games to start the season...The O's rank second in the AL and MLB in runs scored after finishing 10th in the AL and 20th in MLB with 674 runs scored in 2022...The team leads the AL and is third in MLB in on-base percentage while also ranking second in the AL and fourth in MLB in slugging percentage, second in the AL and fourth in MLB in total bases (227), and second in the AL and fourth in MLB in walks this season.

⚾ The Orioles lead MLB with 4.13 pitches-per-plate appearance this season; the O's have four players in the top 12 in the AL in pitches-per-plate appearance - **Anthony Santander** (6th, 4.42), **Adley Rutschman** (10th, 4.35), **Gunnar Henderson** (T-12th, 4.31), and **Adam Frazier** (T-12th, 4.31).

NEED FOR SPEED: The O's 22 stolen bases are second-most in MLB behind the Guardians (24)...The 22 stolen bases through their first 15 games of the year are the most in O's history (since 1954) to open a campaign...Baltimore and Cleveland are the third teams since 2000 with at least 22 steals through the first 15 games, joining Tampa Bay in 2009...The O's have only been caught stealing twice for a 91.7 percent success rate...**Cedric Mullins** is tied for the MLB lead with Chicago-NL's Nico Hoerner with eight stolen bases while **Jorge Mateo** is tied for third with seven steals...The duo's 15 combined stolen bases are more than 23 MLB teams to start 2023.

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** has tied a career high by reaching base safely in 12 straight games since April 3, joining August 15-28, 2022...He's reached at a .491 clip with 14 hits and 13 walks during that stretch...Rutschman's career-high eight-game hitting streak was snapped yesterday...He slashed .462/.611/.885 (12-for-26) with two doubles, three home runs, seven runs scored, eight RBI, and 10 walks from April 3-14.

⚾ Rutschman ranks among AL leaders in walks (1st, 14), on-base percentage (2nd, .479), OPS (4th, 1.075), hits (6th, 20), batting average (7th, .351), and total bases (T-8th, 34).

⚾ His 34 times reaching base safely this season lead MLB; did not reach safely 34 times last year until his 30th game on June 27; he is the only MLB player this season to reach safely at least four times in four different games.

⚾ Since the start of 2022, he ranks third in MLB with a .308 batting average (12-for-39) on 0-2 pitches (min. 40 PA).

⚾ He has hit four home runs this season, tied with Los Angeles-AL's Logan O'Hoppe for the most among primary catchers; last year, Rutschman didn't hit his fourth homer until his 38th game on July 7.

⚾ Homered in back-to-back games (4/9-10) for the first time in his career.

MOUNT UP: **Ryan Mountcastle** finished 0-for-6 yesterday but hit four balls with an exit velocity of 100.4+ mph...He has 27 batted balls at 95 mph+ this season, tied for fifth-most in MLB, while his 12 barrels are tied for second-most in MLB...Among MLB leaders, Mountcastle is second in RBI (19), tied for third in home runs (6) and extra-base hits (10), and tied for seventh in total bases (37).

⚾ On Tuesday vs. Oakland, he became the third player in Orioles history with nine RBI in a game, tying Jim Gentile (5/9/61 at MIN) and Eddie Murray (8/26/85 at CAL) for the team record; his 12 RBI in the Oakland series were the most in one series by an Oriole since Rafael Palmerio from August 15-18, 1996 at Oakland (5G) and the most in a four-game series since Dan Graham had 13 RBI from July 21-23, 1980 at Minnesota.

⚾ His grand slam in the seventh inning on April 11 was the second of his career (5/22/21 at WSH) and the first by an O's batter in 2023; it traveled 456 feet, the farthest home run by an Oriole this season and the farthest of his career.

HAYS OF OUR LIVES: **Austin Hays** is slashing .480/.519/.920 (12-for-25) with three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 11 runs scored, three RBI, and two walks in six games since April 10...He has scored four more runs than any big leaguer over that time...Hays is the first Oriole with 11 runs in a six-game span since Jonathan Villar from July 25-30, 2019...He is tied for second in MLB with 15 runs scored (see chart at right)...Among AL leaders, he is tied for third in extra-base hits (10), fifth in OPS (1.045), tied for fifth in doubles (6), sixth in slugging percentage (.655), seventh in total bases (36), and 10th in batting average (.333)...Hays, **Jorge Mateo**, and **Adley Rutschman** all rank in the top eight in the AL in OPS this season.

⚾ Hays' double off Jimmy Lambert in the eighth inning Friday night was 110.5 mph, the hardest-hit ball of his career, per *Statcast*; five of his six hardest-hit balls and 10 of his hardest-hit 15 balls in 2023 have come since April 10.

⚾ He scored a career-high four runs on April 11 vs. Oakland.

⚾ April 11 vs. Oakland marked his second game this year with four hits, joining a five-hit effort on April 1 at Boston; he and **Adley Rutschman** are two of the four MLB players with two games of at least four hits this season; since the start of 2022, Hays and Los Angeles-NL's Freddie Freeman both have six games with 4+ hits, most in the majors.

⚾ He homered in back-to-back games from April 10-11 for the third time in his career.

QUICK HITS: Slated to make his third career start this afternoon against the White Sox...Made his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas, becoming the first Oriole to make his debut this season...Thirteen players (7 pitchers) made their debut for the O's in 2022... Also became the first O's pitcher to start his Major League debut since **DL Hall** on August 13, 2022, and the youngest O's pitcher (23-140) to start his debut since Kevin Gausman (22-137) on May 23, 2013 at Toronto...Had his contract selected to the 40-man roster on November 15, 2022...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

WELCOME TO THE CHARM CITY: Made his Oriole Park debut on April 11 vs. Oakland...Did not factor into the decision after allowing five runs on six hits with four walks and a career-high six strikeouts in 4.1+ innings...Departed with one out and the bases loaded after walking three batters in the fifth inning...All three runners scored...Struck out Jesús Aguilar on a foul tip in the first inning on a 98.6 mph fastball for his first strikeout at Oriole Park...Threw 99 pitches, 65 strikes.

PROSPECTING: Currently ranked as the No. 5 overall prospect by *MLB Pipeline* and No. 7 by *Baseball America*...He is ranked as the top Orioles prospect and the No. 2 pitching prospect by both outlets...At 23 years, 151 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the second-youngest player overall behind **Gunnar Henderson** at 21 years, 291 days.

SPRING TRAINING: Attended his second Major League Spring Training and made five starts with the O's, going 0-1 with a 7.04 ERA (12 ER/15.1 IP) and 19 strikeouts.

HIGH TIDE: Started Norfolk's 2023 season opener on March 31 at Durham; did not factor in the decision after allowing three runs (2 ER) on four hits (1 HR) with four walks, two strikeouts, and a wild pitch in 4.0 innings...Threw 75 pitches, 48 strikes...Went 6-1 with a 2.20 ERA (17 ER/69.2 IP) and 97 strikeouts in 14 starts for the Tides in 2022...Named International League Pitcher of the Month for May 2022, going 3-1 with a 2.25 ERA (8 ER/32.0 IP) and 48 strikeouts in six starts...Left his start on June 1 vs. Jacksonville with a strained right lat muscle...At the time of his injury, he led the International League in starts (11), ERA (2.09), innings pitched (56.0), batting average against (.168), WHIP (0.84), and strikeouts (80).

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Owned a 6-2 record with a 2.62 ERA (22 ER/75.2 IP) with 109 strikeouts in 17 starts between High-A Aberdeen, Double-A Bowie, and Norfolk...Started the season with Norfolk and made his Triple-A debut on April 8 vs. Charlotte, allowing just one hit with seven strikeouts to one walk in 4.0 shutout innings...Pitched to a 1.19 ERA (2 ER/15.1 IP) in his first three Triple-A starts...Tossed a career-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings on May 27 vs. Gwinnett...Spent time on the Injured List with a strained right lat muscle...Made three rehab starts, one with Aberdeen and two with Bowie, pitching to a 7.50 ERA (5 ER/6.0 IP) with 11 strikeouts and five walks...Reassigned to Norfolk on September 11 and made his next start on September 16 vs. Charlotte, allowing two hits with four strikeouts to one walk in 5.0 scoreless innings...Allowed just two home runs across three levels in 2022.

COLLECTING HARDWARE: Rodriguez was named the Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year in consecutive seasons (2019, 2021)...Orioles player development and scouting awards were not administered in 2020 due to the cancellation of the Minor League Season because of the COVID-19 pandemic...Named Eastern League Pitcher of the Year in 2021.

TUESDAY'S STARTER: RHP DEAN KREMER (0-0, 9.49)

Kremer is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season, second on the road, and second career start against the Nationals...Has not factored in the decision in any of his first three starts...Allowed four runs on five hits (2 HR), two walks, and a hit batter with one strikeout in 4.1 innings on April 12 vs. Oakland...Threw 90 pitches, 52 strikes...In his only other start against Washington on September 13, 2022 at Nats Park, earned the victory in Baltimore's 4-3 win after allowing three runs on eight hits with one walk and one strikeout in 5.0 innings...Threw 82 pitches, 57 strikes...Marked his only career appearance against an NL East opponent...Is 5-8 with a 5.34 ERA (57 ER/96.0 IP) and 71 strikeouts and 40 walks in 20 career starts on the road, but had a 3.63 ERA (25 ER/62.0 IP) in 11 road starts last season.
