RAY MATTER—The Rays lost in walk-off fashion last night to snap a season-high-tying 5-game winning streak...it marked their third walk-off loss of the season, following April 21 at KC (single) and April 6 at BOS (double)...it was the first time the Rays allowed a walk-off homer since July 27, 2019 at TOR, when **Teoscar Hernández** hit one in the 12th inning off **Emilio Pagan**...the Rays are 5-1 in their last 6 games and have outscored opponents, 32-16, over that stretch...this 5-1 stretch has brought them from last place in the AL East into second place, 2.5 GB of Boston (20-13).

- + Last night was the third time this season the Rays lost when allowing 2 runs (or fewer), tied for the most such losses in the majors...the Rays are 8-3 when doing so, in comparison to 19-2 last season.
- + The Rays are 11-6 on the road this season, tied for 3rd in the majors, and 31-12 (.721) on the road since Aug 10, 2020, best in the majors...the Rays have won nine of their last 11 road games after going 2-4 on the season-opening road trip...over this 9-2 span, the Rays have made 4 errors while their opponents have combined for 17 errors.
- + The Rays have used 38 players (3rd in the majors), 22 pitchers (tied for 2nd in majors) and 11 starting pitchers (tied for 1st) this season.
- + The Rays are 8-7 in this stretch of 17 consecutive days without an off day, and 16-12 in this stretch of 30 games in 31 days.

18 UP, 18 DOWN—Last night the Rays were held to a season-low 3 hits for the second time (April 12 vs. TEX)...LH **Sean Manaea** saw his perfect game bid end with a **Randy Arozarena** walk to lead off the 7th inning, and his no-hit bid ended when former high school teammate **Mike Brosseau** doubled to lead off the 8th...according to Stats LLC, last night was the ninth time the Rays had a perfect game against them through 6 innings, first since **Michael Pineda** (6.2 IP) on April 10, 2017 at NYY...last night was the 16th time the Rays had a no-hitter against them through 7 innings, and first since KC **Danny Duffy** (7 IP) on Aug 1, 2016 at Tropicana Field.

- + There have been four no-hitters this season and two this week, including CIN **Wade Miley** last night at CLE...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, the only other season in major league history with 4+ no-hitters through May 7 was 1917 (5)...had Manaea completed a no-hitter, it would have been the third time that two no-hitters were thrown on the same date, according to MLB.com...it would have joined June 29, 1990 (**Dave Stewart** and **Fernando Valenzuela**) and April 22, 1898 (**Theodore Breitenstein** and **Jay Hughes**).
- + There have been 23 perfect games in major league history (22 in the regular season) and none since SEA **Félix Hernández** on Aug 15, 2012 vs. TB...the Rays have been on the wrong end of a perfect game three times—more than any other team in the majors—and have had two additional no-hitters thrown against them.

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays have allowed a total of 6 runs in their last 3 games and 3 runs (or fewer) in five straight games...the Rays have pitched to a 2.86 ERA (125.2-IP, 40-ER) in their last 14 games, allowing 3 runs (or fewer) 12 times over that stretch...this has lowered the staff's season ERA from 4.62 to 3.81, its lowest since the end of play on April 2 (2.00)...the Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) in 18 of their last 27 games (66.7 pct.) since April 10, after doing it once in the first 7 games this year.

- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.32 ERA (244.1-IP, 90-ER) in 27 games, which ranks 6th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.78 ERA (68-IP, 21-ER) in the last 15 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 4.03...since April 10, the bullpen is 12th in the majors with a 3.32 ERA (124.2-IP, 46-ER) in 27 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 55 runs in the 7th inning or later, 5th in the majors and 2nd in the AL...the Rays have yielded 3 HR in the 7th, 4 HR in the 8th, 3 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras...however, in the last 15 games the Rays have allowed 10 runs in the 7th inning or later, compared to 45 runs through the first 19 games of this season.
- + The Rays are 9-9 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 4-6 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

START ME UP—Rays starters rank 9th in the majors and 3rd in the AL with a 3.60 ERA (157.1-IP, 63-ER)...since April 10, the starters rank 2nd in the AL with a 3.31 ERA (119.2-IP, 44-ER) behind the White Sox (2.63)...over that stretch, Rays starters have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 16 of 27 starts (59.3 pct.), including 12 scoreless starts...traditional starters (excluding openers) have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 11 of 21 starts since April 10, including nine scoreless starts...this comes on the heels of a 4.54 ERA through the first 7 games this season, which ranked 22nd in the majors.

- + Rays pitchers have made 11 starts this season of 5 IP (or more) and 1 run (or fewer), tied with the White Sox for the most in the AL—despite using an opener six times...in comparison, Rays starters accomplished that only 11 times in 60 games (18.3 pct.) last season.
- + Rays starters have gone 6 IP (or more) 13 times this season after doing so nine times in 2020, which tied for fewest in the majors.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—The Rays have totaled 27 runs on 38 hits, 6 HR, 24 BB and 6 errors over the first 5 games of this 7-game road trip (LAA/OAK)...the 27 runs pass their total from the preceding 10-game homestand (25) and the 6 HR are one shy of matching their homestand total.

- + In the 5-1 stretch in the last 6 games, opposing starters have a 2.48 ERA (32.2-IP, 9-ER) and bullpens have a 8.41 ERA (20.1-IP, 19-ER).
- + In the last 15 games since April 23, the Rays have scored 52 runs (3.47 R/G) on 101 hits and 51 BB, have struck out 163 times and are batting .205 (101-for-493) overall and .159 (18-for-113) with RISP.
- + The Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 21 of 34 games (61.8 pct.), tied for the 3rd-fewest in the AL after the Tigers (23) and A's (22).
- + The Rays offense has a majors-most 352 SO this season, ahead of the Tigers (351) and Rangers (341)...they rank 11th in the AL in batting avg. (.223), 10th in on-base pct. (.307) and 11th in homers (34).
- + The Rays have used 34 different batting orders in 34 games.

CHICKEN ON THE BONE—The Rays have scored 27 runs this road trip, batting .262 (11-for-42) with RISP over that stretch including .417 (5-for-12) in the last 2 games...the 11 hits this trip pass the team total from the preceding 10-game homestand, when they hit .099 (7-for-71) with RISP.

- + This season the Rays are batting .201 (59-for-293) with RISP, last in the majors—in 29th place is the D-backs (.202)...with RISP/2 out, their .151 avg. (21-for-139) is last in the majors (29th: Nationals, .167).
- + The Rays are batting .248 (40-for-161) with RISP on the road, compared to a .144 avg. (19-for-132) with RISP at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have struck out 101 times with RISP, most in the majors ahead of the Dodgers (100)...**Willy Adames** leads the majors with 15 SO with RISP, while **Randy Arozarena** ranks 2nd with 14 SO.
- + The Rays have had 67 PA this season with a runner on third and less than 2 outs, and that runner has scored 32 times (47.8 pct.), 15th in the majors...the major league avg. in those situations is 48.9 pct.

RAYS vs. ATHLETICS—Today is the sixth of seven meetings this season, all over a 14-day stretch, after the two clubs split a 4-game series at Tropicana Field last week...the Rays trail the season series, 3-2, and all 5 games have been decided by 2 runs (or fewer) including four 1-run games...the Rays are 78-112 (.411) all-time against the Athletics and 32-61 (.344) at the Oakland Coliseum—their lowest winning pct. at a current AL ballpark.

- + Since July 22, 2016, 21 of the 28 games have been decided by 2 runs (or fewer) and 17 of the 28 have been decided by 1-run margins.
- + LH **Rich Hill** made 14 starts for Oakland in 2016 before they sent him to the Dodgers at the trade deadline...INF **Joey Wendle** is the only other Ray who once played for the Athletics (2016-17).

LEFTY LOOSEY—Last night **Jeffrey Springs** allowed a walk-off, solo homer to **Seth Brown**, the third time in his career he was on the mound for a walk-off loss...the previous two were both walk-off homers: Sep 25, 2020 at ATL (**Freddie Freeman**) and Sep 16, 2019 at SD (**Francisco Mejía**)...last night was the fourth time in franchise history the Rays lost on a "left-on-left" walk-off homer, according to Stats LLC...the others: June 23, 2012 at PHI (**Jim Thome** off **Jake McGee**), Aug 7, 2009 at SEA (**Ryan Langerhans** off **J.P. Howell**) and May 2, 2002 at MIN (**Corey Koskie** off **Steve Kent**).

KING OF THE HILL—Last night **Rich Hill** pitched six scoreless innings and extended his scoreless streak to 11 IP...he has a 1.20 ERA (15-IP, 2-ER) in his last 3 starts to reduce his season ERA from 8.82 to 5.17...with **Albert Pujols** designated for assignment by the Angels, Hill is the oldest active player in the majors, according to Stats LLC...at 41 years, 58 days as of today, he tops the list ahead of MIN **Nelson Cruz** (40.311), STL **Adam Wainwright** (39.251), MIN **J.A. Happ** (38.201) and KC **Ervin Santana** (38.147).

THIS DAY IN RAYS HISTORY—On May 8, 2014 vs. BAL, RH **Brad Boxberger** replaced LH **David Price** with the bases loaded and no outs in the 6th inning—and proceeded to strike out the next three batters on 9 pitches...though their pitch count records are incomplete, the Elias Sports Bureau had no record of any other pitcher doing that on nine pitches...despite his efforts, the Rays lost at Tropicana Field to the Orioles, 3-1.

LAST START—On Mon at LAA, recorded his ninth straight winning road decision after allowing 3 runs in 6 IP, his fifth quality start of the season... worked around runners in scoring position in each of his first 3 IP, including a leadoff double in the 3rd, but avoided any damage before he retired his next 9 BF...all 3 runs came on home runs in the 6th inning: a 2-run homer by **Shohei Ohtani** and a solo homer by **Anthony Rendon**...walked his next batter faced, then induced a groundball double play to end his outing...his line: W, 6 IP, 4 H, 3 R/ER, 4 BB, 8 SO, 2 HR, 99 pitches, 62 str.

- + Has recorded groundball double plays in consecutive starts after going 20 straight starts without one since May 10, 2019 vs. NYY.
- + Is one of four AL pitchers to make at least 6 starts of 6 IP (or more).

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Has allowed 5 runs in the 1st inning this season, yielding a .290 opp avg. (9-for-31) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 3 BB and 13 SO...in comparison, has allowed 5 runs in innings 2-thru-8 (1.23 ERA) and has held opponents to a .116 avg. (14-for-121) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 12 BB and 51 SO.

vs. ATHLETICS—Will be making his second career start against the Athletics, following his start on April 28 at Tropicana Field, when he pitched seven scoreless innings with 10 SO...stranded a leadoff single in the 1st inning, then got out of a 2-on, 2-out jam in the 2nd with a strikeout...following a 2-out single in the 3rd, retired his next 9 BF including 5 SO, and struck out the side in the 5th...allowed consecutive 2-out hits in the 6th to snap that stretch, but avoided damage with an inning-ending groundout.

- + Has never lost to an AL West opponent, going 5-0 with a 1.19 ERA (37.2-IP, 5-ER) in 7 starts and the Rays are 7-0 in these games...since 2018, his 1.19 ERA against the division in the best in the majors (min. 5 starts), ahead of TB/MIA/HOU **Ryne Stanek** (1.56).

KING OF THE ROAD—Since the start of the 2019 season, is 9-0 with a 1.96 ERA (87.1-IP, 19-ER) and 121 SO in 16 starts on the road, including seven scoreless starts...his 9-game road winning streak is the longest road winning streak all-time by a Rays starter, passing **David Price** (7) from May 15-Aug 16, 2012...min. 75 IP, leads the AL and ranks 2nd in the majors in road ERA behind ATL **Mike Soroka** (1.46) since the start of 2019...opponents are batting .159 (49-for-308) against him over that stretch.

- + A win today would be the longest road winning streak in the majors since STL **Miles Mikolas** (10) from April 2-Sep 29, 2018.

ON A ROLL—Over his last 14 starts since Aug 19, 2020 at NYY, is 9-1 with a 2.52 ERA (85.2-IP, 24-ER), 128 SO and .161 opp avg. (49-for-304), including a career-high 7-game winning streak that was snapped on April 23 vs.

TOR...min. 50 IP over that span, ranks 2nd in the majors in opp. avg. and 2nd in the AL in strikeouts, behind CLE **Shane Bieber** (145)...ranks among AL leaders since then in WHIP (0.89, 4th), innings pitched (85.2), FIP (2.93, 6th) and ERA (6th)...the Rays are 12-2 in his starts over that stretch.

- + Has recorded 122 swings-and-misses this season, 2nd-most in the majors behind CLE **Shane Bieber** (152)...has forced a swing-and-miss on 17.0 pct. of his pitches, the 3rd-highest rate in the majors.
- + Ranks among AL leaders this season in ERA (2.06, 5th), innings pitched (43.2, 4th), strikeouts (64, 3rd), opp avg. (.151, 3rd), WHIP (0.87, 4th), strikeout rate (38.3, 3rd) and fWAR (1.5, tied for 2nd).

GLIASHIMUP—His avg. 4-seam fastball velocity this season is 97.3 mph, according to StatCast, tied for 4th in the majors (min. 300 total pitches)... opponents are batting .151 (11-for-73) against the pitch, 9th-lowest in the majors (min. 40 PA)...the pitch value of 9.0, according to the FanGraphs, on his fastball ranks 2nd of any fastball in the majors behind CWS **Carlos Rodon** (9.6)...his 28 SO with the pitch are tied for 4th in the majors.

- + Has thrown eight fastballs that have registered velocities of 100 mph (or more) this season, 3rd among major league starting pitchers behind LAA **Shohei Ohtani** (9) and NYM **Jacob deGrom** (46).

CRAZY CURVE—Has recorded 29 SO with the curveball this season, most in the majors ahead of MIN **José Berríos** (22)...has achieved this despite throwing it on just 14.2 pct. of his pitches...has limited batters to a .068 avg (3-for-44) on at-bats ending with the curveball, the 3rd-lowest mark in the majors (min. 10 AB)...has recorded a 54.9 pct. whiff rate on the pitch this season, the 4th-best mark in the majors (min. 10 PA).

ROLLIN' AS A RAY—Since making his Rays debut on Aug 1, 2018, he is 16-8 with a 3.06 ERA (217.1-IP, 74-ER) and 295 SO in 40 starts...min. 200 IP, since being acquired by the Rays he ranks 2nd in the AL in opp avg. (.189), 3rd in WHIP (1.00), and 4th in SO/9 IP ratio (12.22) and ERA...is allowing 2.90 BB/9 IP since the trade, compared to a 5.79 BB/9 IP ratio with PIT.

KING OF THE K—His 64 SO in 7 starts are the most in franchise history for a pitcher making the season-opening rotation...has 58 SO over his last 6 starts, the most for a Rays pitcher over a 6-game stretch at any point during a season since **Chris Archer** (58) from May 10-June 6, 2017...the club record in a 7-game span is held by Archer (69) from May 5-June 6, 2017.

- + His 56 SO in April were the most in club history, passing **Chris Archer** (43) in April 2016...they were the 2nd-most for any calendar month in Rays history behind **Chris Archer** (58) in May 2017.

- + Has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games, batting .268 (15-for-56).
- + On Thurs at LAA, hit a RBI double off Mike Mayers and scored the game-tying run on a Manuel Margot single as part of the 7-run 8th inning.
