BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN: The Orioles defeated the Guardians yesterday, 8-5, in the second game of the three-game set at Oriole Park...Have gone 11-4 against the AL Central this season, their best winning percentage and tied for their most wins against a single division in 2023 (11-7 vs. AL East)...Tallied five runs in the bottom of the second, their ninth time this season scoring at least five runs in an inning and first since plating a season-high eight runs in the top of the seventh on May 24 at New York-AL.

BURNING RUBBER: The O's and Guardians square off in a rubber game in today's series finale...The Birds have gone 5-3 in rubber matches this season and have won their last two, on May 10 vs. Tampa Bay and May 25 at New York-AL; went 11-11 in such games in 2022.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: Of Baltimore's 55 games this season, 49 have been decided by four or fewer runs, tied with Los Angeles-AL for the most in MLB...The O's have gone 32-17 in those games, the most wins and best winning percentage (.653) in MLB...The O's are 23-13 in games decided by three or fewer runs, the most wins and best winning percentage (.639) in MLB.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY POWER: **Anthony Santander** is slashing .344/.432/.625 (33-for-96) with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 17 runs scored, 20 RBI, and 13 walks in 26 games in May after slashing .213/.280/.362 (20-for-94) with eight doubles, two home runs, eight runs scored, 11 RBI, and 10 walks in 25 games in March/April; has reached base safely in 23 of 26 games this month and has a hit in 19 of those games, including 11 multi-hit efforts...His 1.057 OPS in May is second in the AL and fifth in MLB (see box at right)...For the month, he also ranks fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB in on-base percentage, tied for fourth in the AL in RBI and extra-base hits (14), fifth in the AL and 10th in MLB in slugging percentage and total bases (60), tied for fifth in the AL in hits, sixth in the AL in batting average, and tied for sixth in the AL in home runs...On the season, he leads switch hitters with an .853 OPS.

⚾ Went 3-for-4 with two doubles, a triple, two runs scored, and three RBI last night; has recorded at least three hits in back-to-back games for the second time in his career (also: 8/24-25/21).

⚾ His three extra-base hits last night tied his career high for the fifth time (last: 9/27/22 at BOS).

⚾ Knocked a three-RBI triple in the second inning last night, the fourth triple of his career (last: 8/6/20 vs. MIA); became the first O's batter to hit a bases-loaded triple since Jace Peterson on May 2, 2018 at Los Angeles-AL in the top of the ninth inning.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The O's wrap up a six-game homestand today...The homestand began this past weekend with three games against the Rangers (1-2) before a three-game set against the Guardians (1-1)...The Birds are 17-11 (.607) in Baltimore and own the fourth-best home winning percentage in the AL and fifth-best in MLB...Their 17 home wins are third in the AL and tied for fourth in MLB.

AGAINST THE GUARDIANS: The O's are facing the Guardians for the third of seven games this season...The Birds will travel to Cleveland for four games at Progressive Field from September 21-24...Baltimore went 3-3 against Cleveland in 2022, 1-2 at Oriole Park and 2-1 at Progressive Field...The O's have not won a season series against the Guardians since 2016 (5-1).

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's have won 26 of their last 39 games, 29 of 43, and 31 of 46...The 35-20 overall record ranks third in MLB to start the season (see box at right)...Entering today, the Rays (39-18) and Rangers (35-19) are the only other teams with 35 wins this season, as well as the only other teams with 20 or fewer losses.

⚾ Last season, the Birds did not collect their 35th win until their 75th game on June 27 (35-40); they did not reach 36 wins until their 80th game on July 3 (36-44), which was the start of their 10-game winning streak.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** managed his 600th career game with the Orioles on Monday, becoming the sixth skipper to manage 600 games for the Orioles, along with Earl Weaver (2,541), Buck Showalter (1,353), Paul Richards (1,063), Hank Bauer (726), and Mike Hargrove (649)...Managed his 600th overall game on Sunday; served one game as Miami's interim manager on June 19, 2011 against Tampa Bay, following the resignation of manager Edwin Rodriguez...Hyde is currently in his fifth season as manager of the Orioles after being named the 20th manager in club history on December 14, 2018...In 2022, he led the O's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the *Baseball America* MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers...He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award.

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** leads the AL and ranks second in MLB with 43 walks...He ranks fourth in the AL and ninth in MLB with a .402 on-base percentage...He leads all primary catchers and all switch hitters in on-base percentage...He leads the AL and ranks tied for fourth in MLB with 97 times reaching base safely this season (54 H, 43 BB)...He has reached base safely at least three times in 15 games this year, the most in the AL and fifth-most in MLB.

MOUNT UP: **Ryan Mountcastle** ranks fifth in MLB with 28 Barrels, per *Statcast*, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (33), Toronto's Matt Chapman (31), Atlanta's Matt Olson (30), and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (29)...He ranks tied for seventh in the AL and 13th in MLB with 80 Hard-Hit Balls...His 38 RBI rank tied for ninth in the AL and tied for 15th in MLB; they rank fourth among primary first basemen, trailing only New York-NL's Pete Alonso (46), Atlanta's Matt Olson (42), and Los Angeles-NL's Max Muncy (39).

SOLID CONTACT: The Orioles rank tied with the Rangers and Yankees for fourth in MLB with an 89.9 mph average exit velocity, per *Statcast*, trailing the Braves (91.2 mph), Rays (90.3 mph), and Angels (90.1 mph)...Baltimore's 15.0 degree average launch angle on batted balls is the second-highest in the majors, trailing only the Dodgers (15.4)...Baltimore's 588 Hard-Hit Balls rank sixth in the AL and ninth in MLB.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Baltimore bullpen owns a 3.15 ERA (72 ER/206.0 IP), the fourth-best in MLB behind the Yankees (2.90), Guardians (3.03), and Astros (3.07)...O's relievers have 16 wins this season, tied with the Yankees for the most in the majors...The O's are second in MLB with 237 strikeouts from the 'pen, trailing the Royals (252).

QUICK HITS: Slated to make his 19th appearance of the season, 12th at home, and second career appearance against the Guardians this afternoon behind opener **Keegan Akin**...Claimed off waivers by the O's from Washington on June 7, 2022; designated for assignment by the Nationals on May 31, 2022... Originally selected in the fifth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Washington.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last outing on May 26 vs. Texas...Allowed one run on two hits with two walks, a hit batter, and one strikeout in a career-high 3.2 innings of relief...Has pitched to a 1.96 ERA (4 ER/18.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts in 13 appearances since April 16; had a 9.00 ERA (8 ER/8.0 IP) in his first five games of the year...Threw a season-high 62 pitches, 42 strikes.

CAREER AGAINST THE GUARDIANS: Making his second career appearance against the Guardians today...Earned the win in his only outing against Cleveland with Washington on September 27, 2019 at Nationals Park...Made the start and allowed two runs on two hits with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...Threw 73 pitches, 43 strikes.

CAREER AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Making his 11th career appearance against the AL Central...Owns a 3-1 record with a 4.05 ERA (15 ER/33.1 IP) and two holds through his first 10 appearances (six starts) against the division.

HOME COOKING: Making his 12th home appearance of the 2023 campaign this afternoon...Has pitched to a 4.32 ERA (8 ER/16.2 IP) and one hold through his first 11 appearances at Oriole Park this season...Owns a 4-1 record with a 3.78 ERA (28 ER/66.2 IP) through his first 23 appearances (11 starts) at Oriole Park with the O's and the Nationals.

DAY 'N' NITE: Sports a 1-1 record with a 3.55 ERA (5 ER/12.2 IP) in 10 day appearances compared to an 0-0 record with a 4.61 ERA (7 ER/13.2 IP) in eight night outings this season...Allowed an unearned run on two hits with a season-high-tying three strikeouts (also: 4/5 at TEX) in his last day appearance on May 21 at Toronto..Threw 38 pitches, 24 strikes...Made 10 day appearances (eight starts) with the O's in 2022, pitching to a 1-3 record with a 1.99 ERA (9 ER/40.2 IP) and two quality starts in those games...Posted a 2.28 ERA (12 ER/47.1 IP) in 17 day appearances (eight starts) between the O's and the Nationals in 2022; ranked 12th-best in MLB (min. 47.0 IP).

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Started the season with Washington; was designated for assignment on May 31 and claimed by the O's on June 7...Went 5-4 with a 4.34 ERA (49 ER/101.2 IP) in 41 games (17 starts) between the Nationals and Orioles...Made all 17 starts for the Orioles, going 4-4 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER/76.1 IP) and two quality starts...Allowed two earned runs-or-fewer in 18 of his 22 appearances with the Orioles...Won a career-high four straight decisions from July 10 to August 23...Pitched to a 1.99 ERA (9 ER/40.2 IP) in 10 day games (8 starts) with the Orioles...Tossed a season-high 6.0 scoreless innings on two hits with one walk and three strikeouts on August 17 at Toronto.

FRIDAY'S STARTER: RHP DEAN KREMER (5-2, 4.58 ERA)

Kremer is scheduled to make his 12th start of the season, sixth on the road, and first career start against the Giants on Friday...Will also be his first career start against the NL West... Appeared in his 50th career game in his last outing on May 27 vs. Texas...Dealt the loss after allowing three runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts in 6.1 innings of work...Left the game with a runner on base, who later scored...Snapped his three-game winning streak at Oriole Park...Threw 97 pitches, 63 strikes...Has pitched to a 2-1 record with a 4.15 ERA (12 ER/26.0 IP) in five road starts this season...Making his sixth career Interleague start; has gone 4-1 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) and three quality starts through his first five outings against National League opponents.

BIRDS IN THE BULLPEN
