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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a seven-game homestand today with the first of three games against the Guardians after being swept in a four-game series by the Red Sox...The O's are in the midst of 16 games in as many days since August 25, which will end with an off day on Thursday...After moving to .500 (69-69) for the first time since April 30 (15-15) following last Monday's win at Colorado, the Birds have lost a season-high six straight games to fall 4.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (1.0 GB), Texas (2.0 GB), and Minnesota (4.5 GB) also in the mix.

👉 The current losing streak is the team's longest since May 14 (G1)-20, 2025... Prior to this current stretch, the O's won eight of 10 from August 21-31...Baltimore has dropped five consecutive home games for the first time since losing eight straight at Camden Yards from May 3-18, 2025.

👉 The Birds have lost their first six games of September for the first time since 2001 (10 G)...Minnesota dropped the first six games of September last year with the last MLB team to lose 7+ to open the final month of the season being Kansas City in 2020 (7 G).

👉 The Orioles were swept in a series for the first time since August 18-20 vs. New York-AL (3 G) and for the second time in a four-game series, joining May 1-4 at New York-AL... The O's are now 6-17 (.261) combined against the Red Sox and Yankees this season and 63-58 (.521) against the rest of the majors.

👉 With a run in the first inning yesterday, the Birds snapped a season-high-tying 18-inning scoreless streak (also 7/27-29).

👉 The Orioles struck out 17 times yesterday, their most in a game since May 6, 2025 at Minnesota (also 17 K) and the most in a home game since May 14, 2023 vs. Pittsburgh (also 17 K).

👉 On Sunday, Baltimore lost a game without allowing an earned run for the first time since June 28, 2022 at Seattle (2-0) and for the first time at home since May 21, 2017 vs. Toronto (3-1).

POLAR BEAR SIGHTING: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (2nd, 94), home runs (4th, 33), total bases (4th, 267), slugging percentage (5th, .495), OPS (5th, .853), extra-base hits (6th, 57), runs (8th, 86), and hits (T-8th, 144).

👉 Alonso has started all 144 O's games this year, tied for the most in the majors this year with SF's Rafael Devers...The only other player in the AL to start each of his team's games this year is TB's Junior Caminero (143 GS)...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.

👉 He's played in 560 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (925 G).

👉 Alonso trails HOU's Yordan Alvarez by one for the AL lead in RBI...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has hit safely in a career-high 10 straight games since August 25 while slashing .306/.375/.500 (11-for-36) with one double, two homers, and eight RBI during that time...That's the third-longest active hitting streak in the majors behind COL's TJ Rumfield and ATH's Tyler Soderstrom (both 11 G), though Soderstrom has been on the 10-day Injured List since August 16...Mayo is the third Oriole (4th occurrence) with a 10-game hitting streak this year along with **Pete Alonso** (2x, 14 G, 8/8-22 & 10 G, 5/27-6/6) and **Samuel Basallo** (10 G, 5/5-17).

👉 Mayo is batting .321/.382/.733 (42-for-131) with nine doubles, 15 home runs, and 32 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.115) against lefties.

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 38 homers since August 9, tied for the second most in MLB with the Reds behind the Cubs (55)...Baltimore has not homered in three straight games, tying the season high from May 3-5...The last time an O's team failed to hit a home run in four straight games was July 10-13, 2024...The Orioles had homered in 10 straight games at Camden Yards until Friday.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 531 walks this season behind the Cubs (607 BB), Brewers (598 BB), and Dodgers (541 BB)...The White Sox are second in the AL with 517 free passes.

👉 The team's 30 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).

👉 The Birds are averaging 3.98 pitches per plate appearance, ranked second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.99).

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen has allowed 11 runs (9 ER) in the last six games, but the team's 2.05 ERA (13 ER/57.0 IP) in 17 games since August 20 ranks second in the majors during that period behind the Braves (1.98 ERA).

👉 **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 13 games (11.0 IP) since August 6...That's the longest scoreless streak by an Oriole since Danny Coulombe from July 28-September 17, 2023 (also 13 G)...**Félix Bautista** was the last Oriole with a 14-gamer from June 25-August 6, 2023...Walker's current stretch is tied for the sixth-longest active stretch in the majors and tied for third in the AL with CLE's Erik Sabrowski, behind HOU's Josh Hader (21 G) and TOR's Mason Fluharty (19 G).

👉 **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 13 appearances (10.1 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5.

👉 **Yennier Cano** surrendered a home run on Thursday, snapping a streak of 48 consecutive appearances without allowing one.

👉 Ten Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, tying the 1987 Orioles for the most in franchise history (since 1954)...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 46-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors this year with the Guardians (51-46)...The .474 winning percentage in those games ranks 20th in the majors.

👉 Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage ranks 25th in the majors.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY	
September 7, 1974 - The Orioles win their 10 th straight game but their consecutive scoreless innings streak is stopped at 54 when Ross Grimsley allows a two-run homer to Cleveland's Charlie Spikes in the ninth inning before winning, 3-2. The scoreless innings streak breaks the AL record of 47 set by Cleveland in 1948 but is 2 shy of the big league mark of 56 set by Pittsburgh in 1903.	
September 7, 1996 - Mike Mussina tosses a six-hit shutout at Camden Yards to beat Detroit, 6-0, the only Orioles shutout of the season.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 27th start of the season and 129th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002).

- LAST TIME OUT:** Didn't factor into the decision on September 2 at Colorado despite allowing two runs in 6.2 innings on six hits and zero walks with a career-high 11 strikeouts...Threw 94 pitches, 71 strikes.
- His 11 strikeouts were the second most by an Oriole this year behind Kyle Bradish's 12 on June 17 at Seattle and the most punchouts by an O's lefty since John Means recorded 12 in his no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle.
 - Was the first Oriole with 11+ strikeouts and no walks since Corbin Burnes on March 28, 2024 (11 K)...Means' no-no on May 5, 2021 at Seattle was the last time a lefty did so.
 - Struck out six batters in a row from the second out in the fifth inning until the first out of the seventh...Over the last 20 years, only two Orioles struck out at least six batters in a row: John Means (7) on September 20, 2020 vs. Tampa Bay and Keegan Akin (6) on September 16, 2020 vs. Atlanta.

THE LAND: Rogers is set to make his fourth career start opposite Cleveland, going 0-2 with a 6.91 ERA (11 ER/14.1 IP).

- Suffered the loss earlier this year in his last start at Cleveland on April 19, allowing six runs (5 ER) in 5.0 innings on six hits (2 HR) and two walks with five strikeouts.

HOME COOKIN': Rogers has recorded a quality start in each of his last six games at home...That is the longest streak of home quality starts by an Orioles pitcher since Corbin Burnes had nine straight from April 26-July 30, 2024.

- In those six home starts, he is 3-1 with a 2.58 ERA (11 ER/38.1 IP), .216 opponent average (30-for-139), and 0.91 WHIP.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Rogers owns a 1.04 ERA (3 ER/26.0 IP) in the first inning, allowing two home runs and five walks.

- In the second inning, however, he has posted a 5.61 ERA (16 ER/25.2 IP), allowing two long balls and seven free passes.

EBBS AND FLOWS: Over his last 16 starts since June 4, Rogers is 7-3 with a 3.01 ERA (32 ER/95.2 IP) and 1.07 WHIP.

- He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).
- Over his first three starts of the season, Rogers went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) and a 1.05 WHIP.

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In 13 starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 26.8 percent strikeout rate and 25.3 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.

- Over his last 13 starts, he owns a 32.6 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 26.5 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

THORN IN THE SIDE: Opposing nine-hole hitters are 16-for-53 (.302) off Rogers, the second-highest batting average of any spot in the batting order behind the three-hole (.304, 21-for-69).

- Rogers has had the most success against two-hole batters, limiting them to a 8-for-68 (.118) clip with zero extra-base hits.

TWO-OUT TALK: Opponents are slashing .272/.328/.383 (49-for-180) with seven doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 34 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

- Over his last 16 starts since June 4, however, he has limited the opposition to a .200/.254/.291 (22-for-110) line with two outs after they slashed .386/.442/.529 (27-for-70) over his first 10 outings.

PINPOINT: On July 24 vs. Atlanta, Rogers' 81.8 percent strike rate (72-of-88) marked the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of MIL's Jacob Misiorowski on August 2 at Los Angeles-AL (79.5%, 66-of-83).
