**A LITTLE SLOW ROLLER...:** The Giants and Rockies play the series finale here at Coors Field this afternoon...after dropping the first two games, SF needs a win to avoid being swept here at Coors Field for the first time since 2018, when the club went 0-3 in two straight visits to Denver on July 2-4 and September 3-5.

- ▶ The Giants enter today 14 games under .500 for the first time since ending the 2018 season 16 games under (.73-89).
- ▶ SF's 22-36 record marks their worst start to a season since also starting the 1985 campaign at 22-36...there have only been six other instances in franchise history of the team recording 22 wins or fewer through 58 games.
- ▶ The 22-36 (.379) record is tied with the Royals for the third-lowest winning percentage in MLB this season, ahead of only the Rockies and Tigers (both at 22-37, .373).

**CHAPMAN...BARE-HANDED...GOOOOT HIM!!!:** The Giants have made the following roster moves prior to today's game:

- ▶ **OF Jonah Cox** (#53) selected to the Major League roster.
- ▶ **RHP Tristan Beck** (#43) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **OF Will Brennan** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **LHP Ryan Borucki** designated for assignment.

**IT IS...GOOOOONE!:** The Giants selected **OF Jonah Cox** from their Double-A affiliate, the Richmond Flying Squirrels today...Cox has yet to appear in a game at the Triple-A level but has been dominating Double-A this season, slashing .400/.453/.644 (1.097 OPS) in 44 games with 11 doubles, five triples, six homers, 35 RBI and 27 stolen bases.

- ▶ Entering today, his .400 average this season is best in all Majors or MiLB full-season affiliates, while his 27 steals are tied for seventh-most across all levels this year.
- ▶ Cox is ranked as the Giants' No. 21 prospect on *Baseball America* and has 163 stolen bases since his professional debut in 2023...the 163 steals are the fifth-most of any player across all MiLB levels in that span.
- ▶ The 24-year-old grew up in Louisville, CO, a suburb just 25 minutes north of Denver.
- ▶ He was acquired by SF from the Athletics on February 2, 2024 in exchange for RHP Ross Stripling and cash.

**HE'S DONE IT AGAIN: LHP Robbie Ray** takes the hill for SF today to face the Rockies for the 23rd time in his career, his second-most starts against any team in his career behind the Dodgers (26 starts).

- ▶ The lefty is 6-6 with a 5.24 ERA in the 22 outings and struck out 142 batters over the 111.2 innings (11.44 K/9ip).
- ▶ Ray's 142 strikeouts vs. Colorado are second-most among active pitchers, trailing only Patrick Corbin (162), and are 11th-most all-time.

**THIS ONE IIIIISSSSS.... OFF THE THE TOP OF THE WALL:** The Giants recorded another four doubles in last night's loss to put them at 59 doubles this month...the 59 doubles are tied with the Nationals for most in the Majors this month and are SF's most in a single month since recording 65 doubles in September/October 2021.

- ▶ It also marks SF's most in a single May since recording 61 doubles in 2018 (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ **IF Rafael Devers** leads all MLB players this month with 11 doubles...with another double this weekend, Devers could become the first Giants player in nearly a decade to record at least 12 doubles in a month...the last Giant to achieve the feat was **Brandon Belt**, who doubled 13 times in June 2016.

**... AND IT RICOCHETS! AND IT'S ROLLING ON THE WARNING TRACK:** Giants play-by-play announcer **Dave Flemming** celebrates his 50th birthday today...Flemming has been a fundamental part of the Giants since joining the club in 2003, splitting his time between TV and radio broadcast duties.

- ▶ Flemming has won three Northern California Area Emmy Awards for his Giants play-by-play work and was named California's 2019 Sportscaster of the Year.

## THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

MAY 31, 1964

At Shea Stadium, the NY Mets and the SF Giants play the longest doubleheader in Major League history: 9 hours and 52 minutes. The 23-inning nightcap game was won by the visiting Giants 8-6. The game took 7:23 to play. In the opener, **Juan Marichal** pitched a complete game and **Orlando Cepeda** went 3-for-4 with two runs and one RBI for a Giants 5-3 victory.

**WITH THE GIANTS:** The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

**LAST START:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 24 vs. the White Sox...threw 4.0 innings and allowed four runs on two hits with a career-high seven strikeouts...he had issues with his command and threw just 47 strikes on 92 pitches...it marked the third straight start that Ray has not made it past the 5th inning.

**PAGING DR. ROBBY:** Over his first eight starts this season, Ray posted a 3-4 record with a 2.76 ERA (14er, 45.2ip) and a 1.09 WHIP...in his last three outings, he's gone 0-2 with an 11.08 ERA (16er, 13.0ip) and a 2.38 WHIP.

**SLIP AND SLIDE:** Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 88mph to 85mph, which led to six inches more vertical movement...he's also allowed four HR with it compared to seven all of last year...his strike rate on the pitch has also dropped from 63% to 55% (SIS).

**LACK OF SUPPORT:** Has received one or zero runs of support in six of his 11 outings...the Giants are 5-6 over his 11 starts...his 3.07 run support average is the sixth-lowest figure...overall, Giants pitchers have received 3.74 runs of support this year, the lowest average in the Majors.

**AGAINST THE ROCKIES:** Will make his 23rd career start against the Rockies, the second-most starts he's made against any team in his career behind the Dodgers (26 starts)...he's posted a 6-6 record with a 5.24 ERA over his 22 career outings against the Rockies... tonight will mark his 12th career start at Coors Field, where he's gone 2-2 with a 5.33 ERA and a .318 opponents average over his 11 games...Ray pitched well against Colorado last season, posting a 3.45 ERA (6er, 15.2ip) over three starts.

**HOME VS. ROAD:** Has pitched better in his six starts at home, going 3-1 with a 2.78 ERA and a .188 opponents average, compared to a 0-5 record with a 6.84 ERA in five starts on the road...San Francisco has won five of his six starts at home and dropped all five of his starts on the road...last season Ray posted virtually equal stats at home vs. the road.

**LEFT ON READ:** Left-handers are 7-for-their-last-20 (.350) off him with two doubles and a triple...lefties were just 4-for-28 (.200) with no extra base hits off him to start the year.

**Last Game:** 5/29 at RNO (AAA); 2.0ip, h, bb, k (32 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today, taking the place of LHP Ryan Borucki...has gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role... recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25.
- ▶ Left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/30 at COL; 1.0ip, 2k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 7.0 scoreless innings over his last three outings.
- ▶ Has a 0.69 ERA (1er, 13.0ip) in 10 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 11 of 19 contests (4.76 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .200 (6-for-30) off his slider, .238 (10-for-42) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 5/29 at COL; 0.2ip, h (6 pitches)

- ▶ Gage's 27 appearances this year are tied for fourth-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered six runs (five ER) in 23.0ip this year (1.96 ERA).
- ▶ Has allowed only nine of his 24 (37.5%) inherited runners to score.
- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-31 (.065) against him this season, and 19-for-114 in his career (.167).
- ▶ His 27.7% hard hit rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB while his 85.2 mph average exit velo is in the top 5%.
- ▶ Opponents are just 2-for-16 (.125) off his changeup and 3-for-22 (.136) off his four-seamer.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 5/30 at COL; 1.1ip, 2h, r, er, 2bb, k (32 pitches)

- ▶ Has made eight appearances with SF, logging 7.2 innings, allowing four hits and eight walks with nine strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-13 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 5/29 at COL; L, BS, 0.2ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 2hr, k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Gave up season-high five runs and five hits on two homers in 9th inning Friday...marked his first career outing at Coors Field.
- ▶ Has allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 11.0 innings this month...had allowed one run in 14.0 innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 9-for-50 (.180) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-39 (.205) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/29 at COLP 1.0ip, h, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed one home run in his last 61.1 innings pitched, dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 13 walks in his 16.1ip (7.16 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Right-handers are 5-for-30 (.167) off him while left-handers are 5-for-29 (.172).
- ▶ Holding opponents 0-for-20 off his slider and 5-for-31 (.161) off his sinker.

### #63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/29 at COL; 0.2ip, h, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 10.0 innings since returning from the IL, allowing four runs (three earned) on eight hits in 10 games (2.70 ERA).
- ▶ Activated on May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Batters are 4-for-17 with four singles off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 34.3% of the time and are 3-for-8 (.429) off his slider.
- ▶ Averaging 99.8 mph with his four-seam and 98.9 mph with his sinker

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

**Last Game:** 5/29 at COL; 1.1ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, hr (18 pitches)

- ▶ Leads SF with 11 holds, which is tied for the fourth-most in MLB.
- ▶ 19 of his 25 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 15-for-88 (.170) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 6-for-47 (.128) with 17 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 85.6 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 7% of the league while his 26.9% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4%.
