#### They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 105-58 (.644) since 2022 during Interleague Play, which marks the best record in the majors....the team brings a 6-game Interleague winning streak into tonight.

The Brewers are currently in a stretch to begin the season in which they play 12 consecutive games against American League opponents....the team is facing AL opponents in 18 of its first 24 games of the season.

#### ABSolutely Perfect!

**Jeferson Quero** recorded the first ever successful ABS challenge for the Brewers yesterday as he challenged a ball called in the second inning with **Brandon Sproat** on the mound on a pitch to **Austin Hays**....he notched a second successful challenge on a ball called in the sixth with **Jared Koenig** pitching to **Tristan Peters**.

#### RISP Management

Through 3 games, the Brewers are batting .354 (17-for-48) with runners in scoring position.

#### Fine 'Penmanship

Through 3 games, Brewers relievers have posted a 0.61 ERA (14.2ip, 1er) with opponents batting just .146 (7-for-48, 6bb, 25k)....the bullpen has thrown 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings entering tonight.

**THIS EVENING'S GAME:** Is the fourth game (3-0) a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Chicago-AL (3-0) and Tampa Bay (3g) to open the 2026 season....following this homestand and an off day on Thursday, the team begins its road schedule with a 6-game trip to Kansas City (3g) and Boston (3g).

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** **OF Akil Baddoo** (left quad), **OF Steward Berroa** (right shoulder), **OF Jackson Chourio** (left hand), **RHP Quinn Priester** (right thoracic outlet), **1B Andrew Vaughn** (left hand), **RHP Craig Yoho** (right calf) and **LHP Rob Zastryzny** (left shoulder) are on the injured list....Baddoo is on the 60-day IL.

**MANAGER:** **Pat Murphy** (327g, 193-134, .590) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made one replay challenge this season, going 1-0....their challenge came on 3/29 vs. Chicago-AL as an out call at first base involving Gary Sánchez was overturned.

**2025 IN REVIEW:** The Brewers went 97-65 to finish in first place in the NL Central, 5.0 games ahead of the Cubs....Milwaukee had the best record in baseball for only the second time in franchise history (1982) and set a franchise record for regular-season wins....the team beat the Cubs, 3 games to 2, in the National League Division Series before getting swept by the Dodgers in the National League Championship Series.

**BREWING SUCCESS:** The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 766 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (856), Astros (808) and Yankees (791).

**HARRISON AT A GLANCE:** Kyle Harrison, 24, will make his Brewers debut....he was acquired from Boston with LHP Shane Drohan and INF David Hamilton on February 9 in exchange for INF Caleb Durbin, INF Andruw Monasterio, INF/C Anthony Seigler and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round B selection.

**LAST SEASON:** Harrison went 1-1 with a 4.04 ERA in 11 games/6 starts between San Francisco (8g, 4gs) and Boston (3g, 2gs)....he was traded to Boston on June 15 as part of the deal that sent INF/DH Rafael Devers to the Giants....Harrison also went 5-2 with a 3.66 ERA in 18 starts between Triple-A Sacramento (6gs) and Triple-A Worcester (12gs).

**CAREER:** Harrison has gone 9-9 with a 4.39 ERA in 42 games/37 starts (194.2ip, 95er)....he is in his fourth Major League season pitching for San Francisco (2023-25), Boston (2025) and Milwaukee (2026)....he was selected by San Francisco in the third round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of De La Salle (CA) High School.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** His only career outing in Milwaukee came in a start for the Giants on 8/28/24....he took a 5-3 loss (4.2ip, 4h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 7k, 1hr).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 4-7 with a 4.43 ERA in 22 games/19 starts (101.2ip, 50er).

**CAREER vs. RAYS:** Harrison had no decision in a 6-3 win for Boston last 9/20 at Steinbrenner Field (6ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 5k, 1wp)....it is his only outing against the Rays.

**ODDS & ENDS:** Harrison committed to play at UCLA prior to being drafted....his younger brother, Connor "Bear" Harrison, is a junior catcher at Texas A&M....his grandfather, Skip Guinn, pitched in the Major Leagues with Atlanta (1968) and Houston (1969 and 1971)....Harrison enjoys hiking, golf, traveling and cooking.
