

## San Diego Padres (4-5) vs. San Francisco Giants (2-5) RHP Dylan Cease (0-1, 3.86) vs. RHP Jordan Hicks (1-0, 0.00)

**'24 AT 24:** Fresh off their first road trip of the year, the Giants return to Oracle Park today for their first home game of the 2024 season...SF will host the first of a three-game set against the Padres this afternoon, kicking off a homestand that will also welcome the Washington Nationals to town next Monday-Wednesday.

- The Giants have won 16 of their 23 (.667) home openers since Oracle Park was inaugurated in 2000...in the San Francisco era (since 1958), the team has gone 40-26 (.606) in home openers.
- The Giants have played good baseball on the Shores of Mc-Covey Cove in recent years, going 162-114 (.587) at Oracle Park since 2020...SF's .587 winning percentage at home is sixth-best in MLB and third-best in the NL in that stretch... only the Dodgers (195-86, .694) and Braves (168-104, .618) have been better at home since 2020.
- ▶ SF went 45-36 (.556) here at home in 2023.

**TRIP RESET BUTTON:** After winning two of the first three games of the year, the Giants have dropped four straight (Sunday in San Diego and the three-game series in LA) entering play this afternoon.

The Giants longest losing streak a season ago was a pair of six-game skids from July 19-24 and September 1-6.

**BYE BYE BABY:** The Giants have hit at least one home run in all seven of their games to start the season...it is San Francisco's longest streak of games with a homer to start a season since homering in 10 straight in 2016.

- OF Michael Conforto paces the team with three home runs this season, tied for the third-most in MLB...Conforto has reached base safely in each of his first seven games, slashing .370/.414/.778 with eight runs scored, two doubles, three homers, nine RBI and two walks.
- Conforto's .778 slugging percentage early in the season is fourth-best in the Majors, with his 1.192 OPS ranking sixth.

**GET YOUR KICKS WITH HICKS: RHP Jordan Hicks** takes the ball for SF today to make his second start of the season...the new Giant is slated to face the Padres for a second consecutive time after throwing 5.0 shutout innings last Saturday at Petco Park...Hicks held San Diego batters to just three hits while striking out six en route to his first career win as a starter.

The right-hander had an outstanding Spring Training, posting a 2.65 ERA (5er, 17.0ip) with 28 strikeouts over five starts.

**WHAT'S NEW? A LOT, ACTUALLY:** The Giants will host a pregame ceremony today at 12:45 p.m. that will unveil the numerous updates made to Oracle Park this offseason and highlight the promotional events of 2024...starting with the grand opening of Mission Rock's China Basin Park, the pregame festivities will show off upgrades in the sound and light systems and the addition of 11 LED video displays throughout the ballpark that add over 3.5k square feet of incremental video capacity.

► In addition to that, Oracle Park has welcomed a new concessionaire, Diamond 58, implemented the cutting edge technology of MLB's Go-Ahead Entry and did major renovations to the Suite level and Dugout Store.

**SEND HELP!:** The Giants have allowed 46 runs in the first seven games of the season...the 46 runs are their most in SF-era through seven games and fourth-most in franchise history, trailing just the 1947 (51), 1927 (49) and 1950 (47) clubs... only the Marlins (59), Rockies (58) and Padres (54) have allowed more runs than the Giants this season.

 The SF era record through eight games is 51 runs allowed (1983).

**BULL'S EYE:** After a tough start to the season, the Giants bullpen has performed much better in recent days...SF relievers have allowed just one run (a HR) on five hits with eight strikeouts over their last two games in 7.1ip (1.23 ERA), as opposed to a 10.00 ERA (20er, 18.0ip) with four homers and 10 walks over their first five contests.

The Giants have had four relievers make their MLB debuts in the past week (RHP Nick Avila, LHP Erik Miller, RHP Landen Roupp, RHP Kai-Wei Teng).

**SWING STATES:** According to *Sports Info Solutions*, the Giants currently rank 26th in how frequently they are swinging overall (45%) and 29th of 30 MLB teams in how often they swing on pitches taken in the strike zone (64%).

- ▶ However, when the Giants are swinging they rank third in the percentage of swings ending in a hard-hit ball (18%).
- ▶ Overall, the Giants have a 46.1% hard-hit rate through their first seven games, third-highest in the Majors behind Colorado (47.0%) and Cincinnati (46.9%).
- The Giants 91.1 mph average exit velocity early on this season leads the Majors, slightly ahead of the Kansas City Royals (91.0 mph).

**DEBUT DAY: Bob Melvin** announced that 2023 NL Cy Young Award winner **LHP Blake Snell** will make his Giants debut this Monday against the Washington Nationals at Oracle Park... Snell signed a two-year, \$62 million contract with the Giants exactly two weeks ago on March 19

**THE REAL BAY AREA BOB: Bob Melvin** was named the 39th manager in club history on October 25, 2023..the Bay Areaborn and raised Melvin played with the Giants from 1986-1988, appearing in 265 games.

# JORDAN HICKS RHP#122024 RECORD: 1-0, 0.00 ERA

Height/Weight: 6-2/217 Born: Houston, TX Age: 27 (September 6, 1996) Signed Through: 2027

**WELCOME TO SF:** Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

**PUSH TO START:** Is transitoning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made just nine career starts entering today... Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

**FIRST IMPRESSION:** Had an outstanding Spring Training, posting a 2.65 ERA (5er, 17.0ip) with 28 strikeouts over five starts...in his last outing against the Athletics on March 25, he tossed 5.0-score-less innings and struck out 10 Oakland batters.

**LAST OUTING:** Carried momentum from his stellar spring training into his first start last Saturday in San Diego...threw 5.0-score-less, allowing three hits with six strikeouts in the Giants 9-6 victory over the Padres.

**SMOKE:** 17 of Hicks' 81 pitches in his debut outing last Saturday were tracked at 98 mph or higher...that is the fourth-highest amount of pitches at 98+ mph by a Giants starter in a single game in the pitch tracking era (since 2008)...the only Giants staters to throw more pitches at 98+ in a single start were **Tim Lincecum** (43 such pitches on April 24, 2008 at San Diego), **Carlos Rodón** (22 pitches on May 21, 2022 vs. San Diego) and Rodón again (21 pitches on June 12, 2022 against the Dodgers).

**VS. THE PADRES:** Has made five career appearances (one start) against the Padres and tossed 9.2-scoreless innings...has struck out 14 Padres batters over 9.2ip (13.03 SO/9.0).

**2023 SEASON:** Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals (40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2ip) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, 11.1 K/9.0ip, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH (42.2% off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

**RISP MANAGEMENT:** Last season, opponents combined to hit just .211 (16-for-76) off him with runners in scoring position and just .121 (4-for-33) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

**FEEL THE HEAT:** Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,181 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (40.2%) clocked at over 100 mph.

**LIMIT THE LONGBALL:** Has allowed just 13 home runs over 248.1 career innings (0.47 HR/9.0ip).

**MISSED TIME:** Missed the majority of three Major League seasons due to injuries (2019 and 2021) and opting out as a high-risk individual during the shortened 2020 season due to his Type 1 diabetes.

**DIABETIC PHENOM:** Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself... Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise.

#### #58 NICK AVILA > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball Last Game: 4/1 at LAD; 2.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2k (38 pitches)

- Had his contract purchased from Triple-A Monday and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games
- Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach...would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

#### **#75 CAMILO DOVAL > RHP**

#### Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 3/30 at SD; 0.2ip, 1h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 1hr (17 pitches)

- Made his third Opening Day roster...pitched just once on SF's opening seven-game road trip (3/30).
- Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only Rod Beck in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44). The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since Brian Wilson (48 in '10).

#### #68 ERIK MILLER > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/3 at LAD; 1.0ip, 2k (16 pitches)

- Made his first career Opening Day roster...the southpaw made his debut on Opening Day, striking out one in 1.0 inning in San Diego. Appeared in four games on SF's road trip, allowing five runs in 3.2ip.
- Is ranked the Giants No. 30 prospect according to MLB.com.
- In five spring outings, Miller gave up one earned run (a HR) on four hits (.211 avg) with six strikeouts in 4.2 innings.
- Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#### **#33 TAYLOR ROGERS > LHP**

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

- Last Game: 4/3 at LAD; 1.0ip, h, r, er, hr (21 pitches) Made his eighth OD roster, second with SF...made three appearances on the Giants trip, allowing a run in two of his three outings.
- Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced. Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with
- a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).

#### **#71 TYLER ROGERS ► RHP**

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/3 at LAD; 1.0ip, 2h (11 pitches)

- Made his fifth Opening Day roster (all w/SF)...appeared in four of SF's first seven games, allowing two runs (both on HRs) in 3.0ip.
- Averaged just 5.64 pitches per inning this spring. Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ 45 of his 60 strikeouts last year came with his slider, with batters hitting .187 off the pitch.
- Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (266g).

#### #65 LANDEN ROUPP ► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter Last Game: 4/2 at LAD; 2.0ip,h, bb, 4k (43 pitches)

- Made his first career Opening Day roster and made his MLB debut last Friday...has tossed 4.0-scoreless innings, over three outings to start his career.
- Roupp struck out 13 of the 29 batters he faced this spring (44.8%).
- ▶ Is the Giants No. 12 prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 14 according to Baseball America.
- Was selected by SF in the 12th round of the 2021 draft and appeared in his first big league camp this year.
- Had never pitched above Double-A and has only made 15 total appearances at the Double-A level prior to this year.
- Roupp struck out 42 batters over 31.0 innings (12.2 K/9ip) with Double-A Richmond in 2023 and held opponents to a .206 average.
- His 1.74 ERA prior to hitting the IL last season ranked as the fourthlowest in all Double-A (min. 30.0ip).
