IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), LHP Jared Koenig (left elbow), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (396g, 235-161, .593) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (85 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 47, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 5.5 games.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 25-15 at home, going 9-3-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 20-12 on the road, going 7-3-1 in series play....the team is 12-4 in its last 16 road games and had a season-high 5-game winning streak from 5/31-6/8.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 22 replay challenges this season, going 16-6....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/8 at Athletics as an out call at first base involving Brice Turang was confirmed.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 808 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (901), Astros (841) and Yankees (833).

MISIOROWSKI AT A GLANCE: Jacob Misiorowski, 24, will be making his 15th start of the season.....Misiorowski last started last Friday vs. Philadelphia and picked up a 6-0 win as he threw the first complete game of his career (9ip, 1h, 0bb, 15k, 95 pitches)....he became the seventh pitcher in Major League history to have a game with 15+ strikeouts while allowing one or no hits and issuing no walks.....the team is 9-5 in his starts.....he has 9 quality starts (seven in a row)....opponents are batting .140 (42-for-299, 4hr)....he has 131 strikeouts in 87.0 innings (13.55 K/9IP)....he is 7-0 with a 0.17 ERA in his last 8 starts (54.1ip, 19h, 2r, 1er, 9bb, 80k, 0hr)....he was named National League Player of the Week for 5/25-5/31....he was the team's Opening Day starter.....Misiorowski was selected by Milwaukee in the second round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from Crowder (MO) College, where he pitched one season (2022) and became the highest drafted player in school history.....name is pronounced "miz-uh-RAO-skee."

LAST SEASON: Misiorowski made his Major League debut and went 5-3 with a 4.36 ERA in 15 games/14 starts.....the team went 9-5 in his starts....he had 3 quality starts....opponents batted .213 (51-for-239, 8hr)....he recorded 87 strikeouts in 66.0 innings (11.86 K/9IP)....Misiorowski was named an All-Star after just five games under his belt, the fewest in Major League history....he was on the 15-day injured list from 8/3-8/14 with a left tibia contusion, retroactive to 7/31....he went 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA in 2 games in the NLDS against the Cubs with both outings coming in relief (7ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 7k, 1hr)....he appeared in Game 3 of the NLCS against the Dodgers out of the bullpen and took the loss (5ip, 3h, 2r, 1er, 1bb, 9k).

CAREER: Is 13-5 with a 2.65 ERA in 29 games/28 starts with Milwaukee (153ip, 93h, 50r, 45er, 53bb, 218k, 12hr) during two seasons (2025-26).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-0 with a 2.35 ERA in 16 games/15 starts (88ip, 23er)....is 4-0 with a 1.58 ERA in 8 starts this season (51.1ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 6-5 with a 3.05 ERA in 13 starts (65ip, 22er)....is 4-2 with a 1.01 ERA in 6 starts this season (35.2ip, 4er).

CAREER vs. BRAVES: Misiorowski has not faced Atlanta.

ODDS & ENDS: Misiorowski graduated from Grain Valley (MO) High School....he got engaged to his fiancée, Elle, this past January and is scheduled to be married this coming winter....he is a supporter of the Wisconsin Parkinson Association....his father, Tom, was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease when Jacob was growing up....Misiorowski enjoys hunting, fishing and collecting baseball and Pokémon cards....he is a Kansas City Chiefs fan.

LHP Kyle Harrison will make his 14th start of the 2026 season.....Harrison last started last Sunday vs. Philadelphia and picked up a 4-0 victory (6ip, 3h, 0bb, 3k, 1hbp, 80 pitches).....the team is 11-2 in his starts.....he has 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .220 (54-for-245, 7hr).....he surrendered 8 runs in just 2.1 innings pitched on 6/8 at Athletics (Las Vegas).....his season ERA without that outing goes from 2.47 to 1.42 (63.1ip, 10er).....his only outing against the Braves came in a start with the Giants on 8/13/24 at AT&T Park in San Francisco.....he had no decision in a 4-3, 10-inning loss (5ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 6k, 2hr).
