TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 6-game homestand with the first of 3 games against the Los Angeles Angels...Seattle opened the homestand with a 3-game series vs. the Houston Astros (1-2) over the weekend...tonight's game against the Angels will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Dave Sims** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Aaron Goldsmith** on the call.

<u>ODDS AND ENDS</u>...the Mariners won yesterday's series finale against the Astros by a 6-4 score, snapping a season-high 5-game losing streak...the Mariners are 38-6 (.864) when out-hitting their opponent this season...Seattle is 34-29 in night games and 19-19 in day games.

- Last Time Around The Mariners starting rotation has posted a 1.99 ERA (7 ER, 31.2 IP) with 3 walks and 30 strikeouts over their last turn through the rotation (5 G, 7/13-c), while holding opponents to a .171 average during that span.
- **Defending Home** The Mariners have allowed 4-or-fewer runs in 40 of their 51 games at T-Mobile Park this season...the 40 are most in the Majors...Seattle is 30-10 (.750) in those contests.
- Cooperstown Former Mariners third baseman Adrián Beltré was inducted into the National Baseball
 Hall of Fame Class of 2024 yesterday...Mariners Hall of Famers Ichiro Suzuki and Félix Hernández are
 both set to appear on the Hall of Fame ballot for the first time this winter.

ROSTER MOVES...the Mariners made the following roster moves earlier today:

- Jason Vosler (#35), INF, selected from Triple-A Tacoma.
- Ryan Bliss, INF, optioned to Triple-A Tacoma (post-game July 21).

MILLER TIME...Bryce Miller is making his 3rd career start against the Angels tonight, having gone 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER, 11.0 IP) with 1 walk and 19 strikeouts over his previous 2 outings vs. the Halos... Bryce is also set to make his 8th career start vs. a division foe at T-Mobile Park tonight...in 7 home starts vs. the AL West, Bryce is 4-2 with a 2.48 ERA (11 ER, 40.0 IP) with 8 walks and 44 strikeouts, while recording a quality start in 6 of 7 contests.

POLO HEATING UP...Jorge Polanco went 2-for-4 with 1 home run, 2 runs scored and 1 RBI in last night's game, checking in with his first home run since May 3 at Houston...the homer snapped a stretch of 31 consecutive games without a home run, 4th-longest HR drought in a single season of his career and his longest stretch without a home run since 32 games from July 2-Aug. 8, 2018...over his last 9 games (7/9-c), Polanco is batting .294 (10x34) with 1 double, 1 home run, 4 RBI and 3 walks, while reaching base at a .351 clip and slugging .412 with a .763 OPS.

HISTORIC HURLERS AT HOME...Seattle pitchers are 31-20 with 16 saves and a 2.75 ERA (142 ER, 465.0 IP) with 100 walks and 479 strikeouts in 51 games at T-Mobile Park this season...among teams pitching at home, the Mariners lead MLB in ERA (2.75), opponent batting average (.203), WHIP (0.95), hitsper-9 innings (6.66), walks-per-9 innings (1.94), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.79), FIP (3.01) and opponent OPS (.577)...the 4.79 strikeout-to-walk ratio is on pace to be 2rd-best at home in MLB history, trailing the 2017 Guardians (4.81), while ranking ahead of the 2019 Dodgers (4.75)...the 0.95 WHIP is on pace to be 3rd-best at home in MLB history, trailing the 1910 White Sox (0.92) and 1908 White Sox (0.93).

<u>PITCH PERFECTS</u>...the Mariners pitching staff is 53-48 with 27 saves and a 3.47 ERA (344 ER, 893.0 IP) with 238 walks and 849 strikeouts this season...Seattle leads the American League in ERA (3.47), ranking 3rd in MLB to Philadelphia (3.44) and Atlanta (3.46)...Mariners pitchers <u>lead the Majors</u> in opponent batting average (.218), WHIP (1.07), walks-per-9 innings (2.40), hits-per-9 innings (7.26) and rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.57) behind Minnesota (3.61).

MUNY MAKER...right-handed reliever **Andrés Muñoz**, who was named a 2024 American League All-Star for the first time in his career, has recorded 16 saves, 6 holds and a 1.37 ERA (6 ER, 39.1 IP) with 18 walks and 49 strikeouts in 39 appearances this season...Muñoz sports a 1.02 WHIP and 11.21 strikeouts-per-9 innings...Muñoz leads MLB with 6 saves of 4+ outs and is 1 of only 3 MLB pitchers with 10+ saves and 5+ holds, joined by José Alvarado-PHI and Jason Foley-DET...Muñoz is 1 of 3 AL relievers with a sub-2.00 ERA and 10+ saves, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE and Kirby Yates-TEX.

<u>CAL DOES IT ALL</u>...Cal Raleigh has 20 home runs, 61 RBI and 5 stolen bases this season...Cal leads MLB catchers in both home runs and catcher caught stealing (18), while he is tied for the lead in stolen bases...Cal could become the first player to lead catchers in HR, CCS and SB since they began tracking catcher caught stealing in 1974...Cal could also become the first player to lead catchers in both HR and SB in a season since JT Realmuto-PHI in 2020 and the first to lead catchers in a full 162-game season since Carlton Fisk-CWS in 1985.

TRYING TO MAKE IT FOUR...Seattle started the season with 3 consecutive winning months for the 5th time in franchise history (others: 2001-03, '18)...this season, Seattle went 17-13 in March/April, 15-14 in May and 15-12 in June...Seattle is 6-9 so far in July, with 9 games remaining in the month.

2025 SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED... the 2025 Major League Baseball schedule was announced Thursday... the Mariners are set to open next season with a 6-game homestand that begins with Opening Day on March 27 against the Athletics... Seattle will finish the regular season with a National League opponent (3-game home series vs. the Dodgers) for the first time in franchise history.

2024 MLB DRAFT RECAP... the Mariners drafted 20 players in the 2024 MLB First-Year Player Draft from July 14-16... Seattle selected 14 pitchers, 5 position players and 1 two-way player... the class includes 1st rounder (15th overall), switch-pitcher **Jurrangelo Cijntje** (jurr-angelo SAIN-jah) from Mississippi State University and 2nd rounder, right-handed pitcher **Ryan Sloan** from York High School in Elmhurst, Illinois.

AS YOU KNOW...Victor Robles went 2-for-4 with 1 double in last night's game, reaching base safely for the 5th-consecutive game, while batting .500 (8x16) with 2 doubles, 2 walks and 5 stolen bases during that span (7/13-c), and...AS YOU MAY KNOW...Robles is batting .455 (10x22) with 4 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run, 2 RBI, 3 walks, 1 hit-by-pitch and 6 stolen bases in the month of July, while reaching base at a .539 clip and slugging .727 (1.266 OPS), but...DID YOU KNOW?...Robles holds a 1.053 OPS over his first 25 games with Seattle?...his 1.053 OPS is the best mark over a player's first 25 games with Seattle since Nelson Cruz's 1.175 OPS through his first 25 games with the Mariners (April 6-May 3, 2015).

ABOUT BRYCE MILLER ...

- The 25-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 20th start of 2024 and his 2nd against Los Angeles-AL...marks his 45th career start and 3rd against the Angels.
- Selected by Seattle in the 4th round (113th overall) of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Derek Miller.
- Spent 3 seasons at Texas A&M from 2019-21...also spent 2 seasons playing for Brazos Valley Bombers of the Texas Collegiate League in 2018 and 2020, and 1 season with the Falmouth Commodores of the Cape Cod League in 2019.
- Was born in Mount Pleasant, Texas and attended New Braunfels High School in New Braunfels, Texas.
- LAST TIME OUT...W#7 on 7/10 at San Diego...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed 5 hits with 0 walks and 1 strikeout...his 14th consecutive start with 3-or-less walks allowed.
- HOME SWEET HOME...in his last 9 starts at home (4/12-c), he has a 4-2 record, a 1.64 ERA (10 ER, 55.0 IP), 65 strikeouts and 14 walks...in each of the outings he has allowed 2-or-fewer runs and has quality starts in 7 of the 9 starts...his 2.10 ERA (14 ER, 60.0 IP) across all home starts this season is the lowest on the Mariners pitching staff.
- AGAINST THE HALOS...in each of his 2 previous career starts against the Angels, he has gone 5.0+ innings and allowed 1-or-fewer runs...Los Angeles-AL is 1 of 3 teams Miller has thrown 10.0+ innings against with 1-or-fewer runs allowed in his career (also: Chicago-AL and Detroit).
- YOU GOTTA EARN IT ... has given up 2 ER or fewer in 13 of 19 games this season and 1 ER or fewer in 7 games... George Kirby leads Mariner starters with 15 games of 2 or less ER allowed.
- EVERYTHING IS ALL LEFT...left-handed batters are slashing .220/.282/.423 (50x227) with 20 walks, 50 strikeouts, 10 doubles and 12 home runs, in 2024.
- HIT LIMITER...his start on 6/12 vs. Chicago-AL was his 12th career game with 6.0+ innings pitched and 3-or-fewer hits allowed...since his debut on May 2, 2023, he has the 6th-most such games in the Majors and tied for the 2ndmost in the AL...he has done so on 6 occasions this season, tied for the 4th most in MLB while trailing Tyler Glasnow-LAD (9), Dylan Cease-SD (8) and Tarik Skubal-DET (7).
- IT WORKS 80% OF THE TIME, EVERYTIME...hitters this season are batting .206 (70x340) against his 4-seam fastball, splitter and sinker combined...80.2% of his pitches thrown this year have been one of those three...89 of his 98 strikeouts this season have come via a 4-seam fastball (41), splitter (30) or sinker (18) and he has allowed 12 doubles and 10 home runs on those pitches.
- HAVING SUPPORT...this season, when Miller receives 3 runs of run support while he is still in the game, he is 5-0 this season in 7 such outings...in those 7 outings this season, the Mariners are 6-1.
- SOME QUALITY TIME...has tossed 18 quality starts (6.0+ IP, 3 ER or less) in 44 career outings...in games where he tosses a quality start the Mariners are 16-2.
- NO APRIL SHOWERS...in his 5 starts in April, he held a 1.19 ERA (4 ER, 30.1
 - IP) with 3 wins, 4 quality starts and an opponent batting average of .127
 - (13x102)...this marks the lowest ERA and the lowest batting average against in a single calendar month during his career...it is also tied for the most wins in a month (May 2023, 3) and 2nd-most quality starts during a single month in his career (May 2023, 5).
- YOU SHALL NOT SCORE... tossed 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings starting in the 5th inning of his start vs. Boston (3/31) and ending in his start vs. Chicago-NL (4/12) in the 7th.
- 200 AND COUNTING...recorded his 200th career strikeout in his start against Cleveland on 6/18 after striking out Bo Naylor-CLE in the 2nd inning... through his first 40 career starts, he tallied 201 strikeouts, the 11th-most in franchise history through 40 starts.
- AMONG THE BEST OF THEM...finished in the top 10 among rookies with a minimum of 100.0 innings pitched in various pitching categories in 2023, including BB/9 (1st, 1.78), SO/BB (1st, 4.58), WHIP (3rd, 1.14), GS (4th, 25), wins (T-6th, 8), IP (7th, 131.1) and ERA (9th, 4.32).
- MAKING MORE HISTORY...became the 1st pitcher since at least 1901 to go 6.0+ innings pitched and allow 2-or-fewer hits in at least 4 of his first 10 career appearances.
- MAKING IT LOOK EASY...he became the only pitcher in MLB history to have 6.0+ innings pitched and allow 3-or-fewer baserunners in his first 3 career starts...his 3-game streak of 6.0+ innings pitched and 3-or-fewer baserunners allowed is tied for the longest since 1901...Blake Snell-SDP and Corbin Burnes-MIL were the most recent pitchers to achieve this feat, both doing so in 2021.
- AN ALMOST PERFECT BEGINNING...took a perfect game into the 6th inning in his first career Major League start at Oakland on 5/2/23 before a
