THE TWINS: The Twins finished their six-game, eight-day roadtrip with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 at Baltimore and 1-2 at Kansas City...today, Minnesota will open its 17th season at Target Field with a three-game weekend series against the Tampa Bay Rays...following the Rays series, the Twins will host the Tigers for four games from Monday-Thursday.
 ☞ Today marks day three of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on April 16.

HAPPY FLIGHT NUMBER ONE UNLOCKED: The Twins earned their second win of the season yesterday afternoon with a 5-1 victory over the Royals at Kauffman Stadium...Taj Bradley (1-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with five hits, one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, out-hitting their opponent for the first time this season...Minnesota held a 1-0 lead through seven innings until scoring four runs in the eighth and ninth innings combined...Luke Keaschall and Kody Clemens each had two hits...Clemens (1), Matt Wallner (2) and Josh Bell (2) each homered, all solo shots in the ninth inning.

MINNESOTA NICE: The Twins are opening their 17th season at Target Field today...they are 36-29 all-time in Home Openers, going 12-9 at Metropolitan Stadium from 1961-81, 16-12 at the Metrodome from 1982-2009, and 8-8 at Target Field since 2010...Twins have won six of their last nine Home Openers.
 ☞ Twins lost their Home Opener last season, a 5-2 defeat by the Astros...their last Home Opener win was April 7, 2023, a 3-2 victory over Houston.
 ☞ Twins are hosting Rays in a Home Opener for the second time in their history; the previous time came on April 3, 2000, a 7-0 defeat at the Metrodome...Steve Trachsel was the winner over Brad Radke...Johan Santana pitched a scoreless ninth inning.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: The Twins went 38-43 at Target Field last season...they won their final game at Target Field on September 21 at Cleveland (6-2) but went 18-32 in their final 50 in Minnesota to finish last season.
 ☞ The Twins have an all-time record at Target Field of 632-614 (.507).
 ☞ Minnesota slashed .248/.321/.401 (.722 OPS) and scored 4.4 runs-per-game at home last season, compared to .229/.300/.394 (.694 OPS) with 4.0 runs-per-game on the road.

WHO'S HOUSE, BUCK'S HOUSE: Over his final 43 games of 2025, Byron Buxton slashed .273/.337/.553 with an .870 OPS at Target Field...in that span, he hit 13 doubles, three triples, eight home runs, 21 RBI and 32 runs scored, while going 9-for-9 in stolen base attempts...he enters today with 84 career home runs at Target Field, tied with Max Kepler for the most in the ballpark's history (top 10 - lower right margin).
 ☞ Buxton's other rankings in Target Field history (since 2010): first in stolen bases (67), fourth in runs (264) and RBI (215), fifth in hits (382), and sixth in doubles (80).
 ☞ Buck's .878 OPS at Target Field last season was the 10th-highest in the AL among players with at least 275 plate appearances in their home ballpark...his .541 slugging percentage ranked sixth in that same group.

RAY AREA: The Twins went 3-3 against the Rays last season, going 1-2 at George M. Steinbrenner Field from May 26-28 and 2-1 at Target Field from July 4-6.
 ☞ Twins are 94-99 all-time against the Rays...they were 44-29 against Tampa from 1998-2006, but have gone 50-70 since 2007.
 ☞ Derek Shelton was the hitting coach for Tampa Bay from 2010-16 under Joe Maddon and Kevin Cash...Shelty has a managerial record of 2-10 against his former team.
 ☞ Twins have homered in 16 of their last 17 against Tampa Bay, hitting 27 total in that span.
 ☞ Matt Wallner has a career OPS of .861 in nine games against the Rays, including a .517 slugging percentage...he has reached base in all eight career starts against Tampa Bay.

HEAD BANGERS: Twins enter today having used the ABS challenge system 26 times, the most in baseball...Twins have won 19 of those challenges, posting an 86% success rate...they have won 10 of 13 on the hitting side and nine of 13 on the pitching side.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers has challenged eight calls and won five...his 63% success rate is tied for fourth-best in baseball among catchers who have challenged at least five times...Victor Caratini is 4-for-5 in successful challenges, posting an 80% rate, the best in baseball in that same group.
 ☞ Minnesota leads baseball in strikeouts gained by challenges with four.

TWINS TAKE ACTON: The Twins announced yesterday that they acquired right-handed pitcher Garrett Acton from the Marlins in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Logan Whitaker...Acton, 28, recently appeared in two games for Triple-A Jacksonville, pitching 2.1 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and three strikeouts for the Jumbo Shrimp...the 6-foot-2, 215-pound lefty spent most of 2025 with Triple-A Durham, going 5-1, 3.68 ERA (58.2 IP, 24 ER), 27 walks, 71 strikeouts, three saves and a 1.13 WHIP in 45 games (4 starts)...the Naperville, Illinois native was originally selected by the White Sox in the 35th round of the 2016 MLB Draft and has appeared in seven major league games, six in 2023 with Oakland and one in 2025 with Tampa Bay...he will report to Triple-A St. Paul...Whitaker, 25, was selected by the Twins in the 19th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of North Carolina State University and pitched in parts of two minor league seasons in Minnesota's system from 2024-25, going 4-0, 2.13 ERA (42.1 IP, 10 ER), 10 walks and 38 strikeouts in 27 games...to make room for Acton on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher David Festa (right shoulder impingement) to the 60-day Injured List.

 ☞ **Pregame Happy Hour (1:00-3:10 pm):** Enjoy \$2 beers (21+), \$2 hot dogs and \$2 snacks at select stands.
 ☞ **Olympic Rings (Pregame):** A celebration of the 2026 Milano Cortina Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games...Cory Thiesse, Korey Dropkin and Mike Schultz will throw out ceremonial first pitches...the Twins will also recognize the gold medal-winning U.S. Olympic Women's Ice Hockey Team and U.S. Paralympic Sled Hockey Team.
 ☞ **"The Star-Spangled Banner"** will be performed by Aniya Bostick and Harriet Spencer, who alternate in the role of Dorothy in the Children's Theatre Company production of The Wizard of Oz, running April 21 through June 14.

OBER AND OUT: Ober made his season debut on March 29 at Baltimore, allowing three runs through 4.0 innings with one walk and one strikeout in an 8-6 Twins loss; he did not factor into the decision. Ober's 56 pitches were the least he has thrown in a start since March 31, 2024 against the Kansas City Royals (excluding rain delays). Tyler O'Neill's fourth inning home run marked Ober's third straight season debut giving up a home run (2024 at Kansas City and 2025 at St. Louis).

SPRING TRAINING RECAP: Ober made four starts in spring training, going 0-1 with a 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP, 6 ER), six walks, six strikeouts, a 1.77 WHIP and a .327 (17-for-52) BAA...made spring debut on March 6 after spending first few weeks of spring working on mechanics.

2025 SEASON RECAP: Made 27 starts in the 2025 season, going 6-9 with a 5.10 ERA (146.1 IP, 83 ER), 31 walks and 120 strikeouts. Finished second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1), quality starts (8) and strikeouts (120). Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed and one walk in final start on September 25 at Texas...also recorded his 600th career strikeout, fanning Joc Pederson in the first inning. Battled discomfort in left hip for majority of season after starting to feel it in spring training...eventually on July 2, went on 15-day Injured List, his first time on IL in three seasons (2022).

CAREER VS. TAMPA BAY: Made his lone start against Tampa Bay on June 8, 2023, earning the loss in a 5.1 inning effort...he surrendered four runs (three earned) on three hits - one being a two-run long ball via Harold Ramirez - with two walks and seven strikeouts. Ober's career 5.1 innings pitched against Tampa Bay is his second lowest against any American League opponent, more than only his 5.0 career innings pitched against the New York Yankees.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In five MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 16-15 with a 4.18 ERA (314.0 IP, 146 ER), 75 walks, 310 strikeouts, a .238 (284-for-1191) BAA and a .728 OPS against in 59 starts at home compared to 15-15 with a 4.01 ERA (307.2 IP, 137 ER), 59 walks, 295 strikeouts, a .240 (280-for-1165) BAA and a .700 OPS against in 57 road starts. In 2025, went 2-6 at home with a 5.12 ERA (82.2 IP, 47 ER), 18 walks, 70 strikeouts and a .783 OPS against in 15 starts, compared to 4-3 on the road with a 5.09 ERA (63.2 IP, 36 ER), 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and a .837 OPS against in 12 starts. Allowed 17 of his 30 home runs at Target Field in 2025. In his last three home starts of 2025, Ober went 0-2 with a 7.88 ERA (16.0 IP, 14 ER), 4 walks and 13 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In 2025, left-handed hitters slashed .274/.312/.481 (85-for-310), while righties hit .275/.315/.509 (74-for-269). Lefties posted an average exit velocity of 87.2 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 31.0, compared to righties 91.6 mph and 49.0 percent. Ober generated a 34.0 chase percentage against left-handed hitters and a 33.6 chase percentage against right-handed hitters...his combined 33.8 chase percentage ranked in the 94th percentile among all MLB pitchers.

WALK THIS WAY: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owned just a 5.0 walk percentage last season, ranking in baseball's 93rd percentile...ranked first on the Twins pitching staff, followed by Joe Ryan (5.7), Pablo López (6.4) and Cole Sands (6.4).

THE ARSENAL: Ober used a six-pitch mix in his first start of the season, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.
