SNAKEBITES

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 3-1 vs. Astros last night.

- Eduardo Rodriguez (0 ER in 6.1 IP) had his second scoreless start (also: June 23 @ White Sox; 0 ER in 6.0 IP)...retired 8 of his first 10 batters.
- **Corbin Carroll**, with his first-inning double, hit safely in his fourth straight game at a .389 clip .389 (7-for-18) with 2 doubles, 3 triples, 2 RBI and 2 stolen bases.
- Randal Grichuk had his third 3-hit game (also: May 31 vs. Nationals and July 11 @ Angels)...has hit safely in 5 of his last 10 games at a .333 clip (9-for-27) with 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 6 RBI and 1 walk.
- Geraldo Perdomo had his third multi-hit game in his last 5.
- **Kevin Ginkel** had his fifth straight scoreless appearance (0 ER in 4.2 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K)...has held opponents scoreless in 9 of his last 11 outings (1.69 ERA, 2 ER in 10.2 IP, 10 K).

SNAKEBITES: Corbin Carroll is 1 triple shy of a career high...in the last 10 seasons, since 2016, is 1 of 3 players with 13+ triples in a season...since 2010, the most triples in a season was 16...since 2008, the most triples in a season was 19.

- **Ketel Marte** is 2 games shy of 1,000 games as a D-back...will be the third D-back all-time to reach the feat, joining Paul Goldschmidt (1,092) and Luis Gonzalez (1,194).
- Eugenio Suárez has hit each of the D-backs' last 7 home runs, tied for the longest streak of a team's homers by 1 player in the expansion era (1961), with Sammy Sosa/CHC (Aug. 11-20, 2000) and Mike Schmidt/PHI (May 3-15, 1979) [h/t@SlangsOnSports, Elias Sports Bureau].
- D-backs offense has recorded 3+ extra-base hits in 10 straight games since July 9, leading the Majors with 41 extra-base hits.
- Against lefty starting pitchers, the D-backs' 17.2% strikeout rate ranks second lowest in the Majors, behind the Blue Jays (16.9%) while their 9.3% walk rate is fifth highest, behind the Padres (9.7%), Yankees (9.7%), Blue Jays (9.4%) and Tigers (9.4%).

STARTING RHYTHM: D-backs' starting pitchers are 4-2 with a 2.48 ERA (10 ER in 36.1 IP), opponent .192 AVG/.579 OPS, 13 walks and 30 strikeouts in their last 6 games.

• D-backs starters have 12 starts this season pitching 6.0+ scoreless frames, tied for third most in the NL, behind the Phillies (15) and Cardinals (15)...in those 12 starts (team is 11-1), starters are 10-0 with an opponent .161 AVG/.408 OPS, a 0.82 WHIP, 21 walks and 86 strikeouts

3-4-5 COMBO: D-backs' 3-4-5 batters in the lineup, since July 1, ranks among NL teams in hit-by-pitches (1st, 5, ahead of Brewers/4), homers (T-1st, 14, with Marlins), walks (2nd, 28, behind Mets/30), fewest strikeouts (2nd, 41, behind Padres/35) and OPS (3rd, .834, behind Cubs/.918 and Braves/.902).

RELIEVERS RECENTLY: D-backs relievers, in their last 14 games since July 4, are fifth in the NL with a 2.76 ERA (14 ER in 45.2 IP)...are scoreless in 9 of the games and limited to 1 run in 2 of the games.

 The D-backs bullpen's 3.13 ERA in July is currently their lowest of any month, ahead of April (4.26), June (4.99) and May (5.87)...their last month finishing with a sub-3.00 ERA was Sept. 2023 (2.16).

VS. OPPOSING STARTERS: The D-backs' 308 runs vs. opposing starting pitchers are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Yankees (296), Red Sox (291) and Dodgers (290).

- In the last 9 games, opposing starters have pitched to a combined 6.25 ERA (31 ER in 44.2 IP) vs. D-backs...Arizona is hitting .326 (62-for-190)/.379 OBP/.579 SLG/.958 OPS with 16 doubles, 4 triples, 8 homers and 17 walks.
- Last night, the D-backs ended their streak of opposing starting pitchers lasting fewer than 6.0 innings at 8 games, their second longest streak in 2025, behind 9 games from June 18-27.
- Since July 1, the D-backs' offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among the NL in runs (1st, 57, ahead of Cubs/47), times on base (1st, 142), walks (1st, 43), pitches seen (1st, 1,561, ahead of Giants/1,517), doubles (1st, 24), triples (1st, 4) and homers (3rd, 16, behind Dodgers/17 and Braves/17).

GENO'S 85+ RBI IN FIRST 100 GAMES: Eugenio Suárez's 86 RBI in his first 100 games of the season were 2 shy of surpassing his 88 RBI thru 100 games in 2018 (Reds).

 Is 1 of 4 Venezuelan-born players all-time to have multiple seasons of 85+ RBI thru their first 100 games: Eugenio Suárez (2025 with AZ and 2018 with CIN), Miguel Cabrera (2010 and '13 with DET), Magglio Ordóñez (2000 with CWS and 2007 with DET) and Andrés Galarraga (1996-97 with COL and 1998 with ATL).

GENO LEADING JULY: Since July 1, **Eugenio Suárez's** 10 homers are the most in the Majors, ahead of Kyle Stowers/MIA (9), José Ramírez/CLE (8), Randy Arozarena/SEA (8), Salvador Perez/KC (8) and Kyle Schwarber/PHI (8).

- Is the second D-back all-time with 55+ homers in any 162-game span (2024-25), joining Luis Gonzalez (2000-01).
- His 6 multi-homer games are second in MLB, behind Cal Raleigh/SEA (8).
- Since the 2024 All-Star break, Suárez's 56 homers are third in the Majors, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (61) and Aaron Judge/NYY (60).

AT CHASE: Josh Naylor has reached base safely in 14 of his last 17 home games since June 1, hitting .302 (19for-63) with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 12 RBI and 7 walks.

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 home games, since June 28, with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 11 home games, since June 27, with 1 double, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 6 walks.

ON DECK - PITTSBURGH PIRATES: Following today's series finale, the D-backs head to Pittsburgh for the first 3 games of a 9-game, 11-day road trip.

- Since 2022, the D-backs are 13-9 (.591) vs. Pirates, including 5-4 on the road.
- The D-backs are 3-3 vs. Pirates in their last 6 games (2-1 road series from Aug. 2-4, 2024, 1-2 home series from May 26-28, 2025).

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (6-2, 3.52)

- The D-backs are 6-1 in his last 7 starts.
- On July 19 vs. Cardinals, had his third quality bid in his last 4 starts, allowing 1 run on 4 hits over 6.0 innings with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts.
- In his last start vs. Pirates on May 26 @ Chase Field, earned the win following 6.2 scoreless innings with 4 hits, 0 walks and 4 strikeouts.

LAST START: Earned the win on July 18 vs. Cardinals (0 ER in 7.0 IP, 4 H, 0 BB, 6 K) after tossing his third scoreless start and second straight without a walk.

VS. ASTROS: Second career start.

• Made his lone start on Sept. 6, 2024 @ Astros (L; 4 ER in 4.2 IP).

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: In his last 4 interleague starts (team is 3-1), is 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA (5 ER in 22.0 IP), opponent .256 AVG (21-for-82)/.749 OPS, 4 walks and 15 strikeouts.
