**THE MANUSCRIPT:** The St. Louis Cardinals open a six-game homestand tonight at Busch Stadium against the division rival Milwaukee Brewers (April 19-21) and defending National League Champion Arizona Diamondbacks (April 22-24) ... St. Louis recently split its six-game road trip through Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (2-1) ... The Cardinals play 19 of their first 28 games against teams who made the 2023 Postseason.

**IMGONNAGETYOUBACK:** The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 3.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (11-6) ... St. Louis has been at .500 six times this season and was a season-best one game over .500 (5-4) on April 6.

- The Redbirds begin divisional play tonight in their 20th game, latest in the regular season since the 1998 Cardinals (27th game).
- Only three of the Cardinals first 37 games are against divisional opponents ... Prior to this season, the fewest divisional games for St. Louis through the first 37 games was six in 1996. - *Elias*

**LOML:** In remembrance of the late Hall of Famer and World Series Champion Manager **Whitey Herzog**, the Cardinals will play a tribute video and hold a moment of silence at 6:53 p.m. CT before the start of tonight's game.

**THE BOLTER:** Outfielder **Victor Scott II** will be presented with his 2023 Minor League Rawlings Gold Glove Award during tonight's pregame ceremonies ... Scott was one of three outfielders awarded a Gold Glove Award with **Kenedy Corona** (Astros) and **Nelson Rada** (Angels) ... Scott combined to record a .992 fielding percentage in 129 games in center field between Peoria (A+) and Springfield (AA), 10th-best among minor league outfielders.

**WHO'S AFRAID OF LITTLE OLD ME?:** **Masyn Winn** leads all rookies and ranks 12th in MLB with a .347 (17-49) batting average this season ... Among primary shortstops, only **Orlando Arcia** (.377) has a higher batting average in 2024 ... Winn is also the 7th Cardinals shortstop in the Divisional Era (1969-present) to bat .340 or better through 19 team games.

**THE ALBATROSS:** In 29 career plate appearances against **Freddy Peralta**, **Nolan Arenado** is slashing .360/.429/.840 (9-25) with four home runs ... **Paul Goldschmidt** is hitting .333/.407/.750 (8-24) with two homers in 27 plate appearances ... No other opposing batter has more home runs and RBI off Peralta than Arenado.

**I HATE IT HERE:** The Cardinals own the most wins against the Brewers (239-189, .558) since St. Louis and Milwaukee began regular season play in 1997, and since the Seattle Pilots joined MLB as an expansion team in 1969, only the Minnesota Twins (255-240, .515) have more wins over Pilots/Brewers than St. Louis.

**GUILTY AS SIN:** **Willson Contreras** has reached base safely in a career-high 23 straight games dating back to Sept. 6, 2023, tied with **Christian Yelich** for MLB's longest active on-base streak ... Contreras is also riding a career-best 11-game hitting streak since April 1 (.350/.435/.650, 14-40), T-2nd longest active in MLB behind **Marcell Ozuna** (16) ... **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 17 consecutive games since March 30, MLB's 4th-longest active on-base streak.

**HOW DID IT END:** **Ryan Helsley** leads MLB this season with five one-inning perfect saves (retiring all three batters), which already surpassed the All-Star's total from last season (4 of 14 total saves) ... Hall of Famer **Lee Smith** (19 in 1992) holds the single-season franchise record of perfect saves ... Overall this season, Helsley shares the MLB lead in saves (7) with **Kyle Finnegan** and **Clay Holmes**.

**I CAN FIX HIM (NO REALLY I CAN):** The Cardinals have scored exactly three runs in five straight home games (April 6-present), one shy of the Major League record shared by the 1993 Indians and 1984 Astros ... Overall this season, St. Louis has scored exactly three runs in nine games and three or fewer in 13 (2nd-most in MLB to the White Sox with 14) ... The 13 games with three or fewer runs by the Cardinals through 19 games is their most since 14 by the 2007 Redbirds.

#### MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

**Ryan Helsley** made his MLB debut on April 16, 2019 at Milwaukee...his first strikeout victim was **Ryan Braun** (swinging) that night.

**Willson Contreras'** younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

**Devin Williams** was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

**Joe Ross'** older brother **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

**Turner Ward** played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

**Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

**Trevor Megill** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

**Steve Dillard**, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

- Tonight marks his 298th career start, two shy of becoming the 9th active pitcher with 300 or more games started. **Justin Verlander** leads the list with 509.
- Is one of 23 MLB pitchers and the only Cardinal to pitch 6.0 or more innings in three or more starts this season. **Seth Lugo** and **José Berríos** share the MLB lead with 4.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November.
- Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Joins his fifth Major League team Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Came away with his second defeat after allowing four runs in 6.0 innings in a 4-2 loss to the Diamondbacks last Saturday at Chase Field. Yielded a go-ahead three-run homer to Lourdes Gurriel Jr. in the 6th inning.
- Pitched 6.0 or more innings for the third time this season.

**CAREER**

- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in ground into double plays (208), which is 2nd-most among all active pitchers behind **Zack Greinke** (266), who has been pitching since 2004.
- Has career marks of 105-102, one of 17 active pitchers with 100 or more wins. Ranks 11th among active pitchers with 105 wins, two behind **Carlos Carrasco** (107) for 10th.
- Durable starting pitcher, has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has posted eight 10-win seasons since his MLB debut in 2013, tied for 4th-most among over that period trailing only **Max Scherzer** (10), **Gerrit Cole** (9) & **Clayton Kershaw** (9).
- One of four pitchers since 2014 to record 100 or more strikeouts in 9-of-10 seasons with **Jacob deGrom**, **Clayton Kershaw** and **Max Scherzer**.

**2024**

- On April 7 vs. Miami, became the most recent Cardinal to allow six runs in the 1st inning and still pitch 6.0 or more innings since **Bob Tewksbury** at Chicago Cubs (June 29, 1991 - 6.0 IP, 6 R, 1 ER). The six 1st inning runs set a personal opening frame record and was the second time in his career (May 10, 2014 at Detroit, 2nd inning) in any inning.
- Made his Cardinals debut on April 1 at San Diego, earned a win while throwing a season-high 7.0 innings for a Cardinals pitcher in the 6-2 win at PETCO Park. Allowed home runs to Jackson Merrill and Fernando Tatis, Jr., as his only blemishes.
- Was 1-2 with a 7.80 ERA in four Grapefruit League starts this spring. Led the Cardinals pitching staff with 16 strikeouts, including nine in his final Spring start.
