FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a nine-game, 10-day road trip with the last of a three-game series against the Cincinnati Reds at Great American Ballpark. The Cardinals play three three-game series in Cincinnati (May 27-29), Philadelphia (May 31-June 2) and Houston (June 3-5) with an open date in Philadelphia (May 30) on this longest road trip of their 2024 season. St. Louis enters today in 3rd place, 4.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and one game behind 2nd place Chicago. A win today would give the Cardinals their 5th straight series win and 3rd straight series win over the Reds.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals earned their largest win of the season, a six-run cushion in a 7-1 victory over Cincinnati at Great American Ball Park last night. **Kyle Gibson** carried a no-hitter five innings deep en route to his 4th win of the season. **Nolan Gorman** (#9) and **Nolan Arenado** (#4) each homered while **Masyn Winn** ran his hitting streak to 17 games.

WHEN THE NOLAN'S GET ROLLIN': Since **Nolan Gorman** debuted in May 2022, he and **Nolan Arenado** have homered in the same game 10 times, most recently last night in Cincinnati. Of the 10 games, the Cardinals are 8-2 with the two losses both coming against Arenado's drafting team, the Colorado Rockies (8/11/22 & 8/4/23).

A BIG SWING: Last night's home run by **Nolan Arenado** was a big home run in many different categories. It was his first home run against a left-handed pitcher in 111 plate appearances dating back to July 18, 2023, when he hit a walk-off three-run home run off Miami's **A.J. Puk**. It was also his first home run against an N.L. Central club since last June 10, when he homered off the Cincinnati Reds, a span of 32 games against division opponents without a longball. The home run was his hardest hit ball of the season, registering at 107.5 MPH.

IVÁN THE CHEER-ABLE: With three knocks last night, **Iván Herrera** tied his career-high for hits in a game. Since **Willson Contreras** went on the Injured List (fractured left arm) on May 7, Herrera is batting .352 with a .441 on-base percentage, highest among MLB primary catchers over that period. Herrera leads the Cardinals in May batting average (.328), ranking 7th in the National League and is batting .471 (8-17, HR, 4 RBI) when starting in the cleanup position in the order (5 starts).

STILL CHASIN' MASYN: Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** extended his hitting streak to 17 games last night going 1-for-5 with his first game-winning RBI of the season on a two-out RBI double in the 3rd inning. Winn's streak is tied for 2nd-longest active this season with **J.T. Realmuto** (17, PHI), trailing only **Anthony Volpe** (20, NYY). The 17-game streak tied **Albert Pujols** (2001) and **Jordan Walker** (2023) for 2nd-longest by a rookie in Cardinals franchise history with **Joe McEwing** leading the list (25 in 1999). Winn leads all rookies with a .297 batting average and all of MLB with a 37.5 line drive percentage.

MY 3RD HOME: The home run by **Paul Goldschmidt** Monday was his 20th career at Great American Ball Park. His 20 HR at GABP (13 w/STL) ranks 3rd in any MLB park and most which he did not call "home" (Chase Field, AZ, 105 & Busch Stadium, STL, 77). He has 19 career home runs at Dodger Stadium (LAD) and American Family Field (MIL).

CATCHING THE CANADIANS: **Paul Goldschmidt's** home run on Monday moved his RBI total to 1,144 career, now in a 2nd place tie with former Reds' All-Star first baseman **Joey Votto**. Only **Freddie Freeman** has more among actives with 1,176 RBI, making Goldschmidt the active leader among those MLB players not holding Canadian citizenship.

SUNNY DAZE: The Cardinals are 7-16 this season in day games, ranking 28th in MLB winning percentage, while the Cincinnati Reds reside in 21st place with a .435 winning percentage (10-13).

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

David Bell served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiser** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Sonny Gray pitched three seasons with Cincinnati (2019-21)...named a 2019 NL All-Star.

Turner Ward served as hitting coach for Cincinnati during the 2019 season.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Willie McGee (May 10, 1982 at Busch II), **Nick Robertson** (June 7, 2023 at GABP), and **Steven Matz** (June 28, 2015 at Citi Field) made MLB debuts vs. the Reds.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ. (1995-97)...was **Sonny Gray's** pitching coach at Vanderbilt University.

Conner Capel appeared in nine games for St. Louis during his 2022 MLB debut season.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over two seasons (2022-23).

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Nick Martini was selected by St. Louis in the 7th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons in the Cards organization (2011-17).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds Hitting Coach **Joel McKeithan**, is a brother of minor league catcher **Aaron McKeithan** in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, **Jerry Sr.**,

spent seven years in the Cardinals organization ... Brother, **Tim**, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Drew Rom was born in Cincinnati...graduated from Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Kentucky...resides in Fort Thomas.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds Executive Advisor **Walt Jocketty** served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-'06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06).

Reds Senior Advisor to the GM **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St. Louis as a professional scout

TODAY'S GAME

- Was recalled on Sun. (5/26) from Memphis (AAA), and is set to make his first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington. Last made a Major League appearance on April 20 of this season.
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine MLB relief appearances before his option.
- Recorded a 65.8% ground ball percentage this season in the Major Leagues, 2nd only to John King (66.7%) among Cardinals pitchers.
- Only pitched with human umpires making ball/strike calls in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- His last start in MLB was a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings of five-hit ball at Nationals Park (7/31/22). Was moved to the bullpen after the Cardinals acquired LHP **Jordan Montgomery** and LHP **José Quintana** at the 2022 trade deadline.
- Since his last start in MLB, is 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA over 90 relief appearances with 19 Holds and 63 strikeouts over 104.0 innings pitched.
- Leads Cardinals with 90 appearances since his last start. Giovanni Gallegos ranks 2nd with 89.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his most recent start (5/17). Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 100 vs. PHI on July 10, 2022.
- Has been known as a reverse split pitcher holding left-handed batters to a .240 opponent BA as opposed to .321 vs. right-handed batters. Continued that trend in 2024 with lefties batting .231 (6-26, 1 XBH) and .444 vs. righties (8-18, HR).

- Threw 4.1 innings allowing two runs on a season-high six hits in a no decision vs. Gwinnett at Autozone Park in Memphis. Threw a season-high 84 pitches, ramped up from 64 three starts earlier vs. Jacksonville (4/27).

- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Was the only player from the Cardinals non-roster invite list to make the Opening Day roster in 2022. Made the Opening Day roster in St. Louis each year from 2022-24.
- Pitched over 50.0 innings as both a starting pitcher and relief pitcher during the 2022 season, making him one of two pitchers in MLB to do so in that season along with Nick Martinez (SD). Was the first Cardinals rookie pitcher since John Urrea in 1977 to accomplish the feat and the first rookie in MLB since Hisanori Takahashi for the New York Mets in 2010.
- Ranked 3rd among National League rookies with 108.0 innings in 2022.
- Led all MLB rookies with 17 ground into double plays in 2022.
- Finished the 2021 Arizona Fall League season with 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings. Named an Arizona Fall League All-Star with a 1.29 ERA, 2nd in the league.

2024

- Made nine relief appearances in St. Louis after making the Opening Day roster before getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
- Took his only loss on 4/10 vs. PHI while not recording an out, the only time in his 118 career appearances in which he did not record an out.
- Recorded his one Hold of the season at LAD (3/31) allowing a home run (his only home run allowed this season) to Teoscar Hernandez, as the Cardinals fell to the Dodgers 5-4.
