**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY  
JULY 5**

**1985** - In a 4-2 win over Montreal, **OF José Cruz** drives in two runs to set what was then a franchise record for career RBI with 783...he would finish his Astros career with 942 RBI, which currently ranks fourth in club history, behind **1B Jeff Bagwell** (1529), **2B Craig Biggio** (1175) and **1B Lance Berkman** (1090)...**2B Jose Altuve** ranks fifth all time on that list with 911 RBI.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Astros will conclude their six-game homestand today with another rubber game, this time opposite the top team in the AL, the Rays...**RHP Peter Lambert** (6-5) will get the start for Houston as he looks to secure the series win opposite the Rays, who will start an opener in **RHP Mason Englert** (0-1).

**THE SLOW TURNAROUND:** After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 24-16 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

1. Astros 24-16 (.600)

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** With a win today, the Astros would win the series, which would secure them six series victories in their last seven chances...prior to the Astros losing two of three to the Twins earlier this week, the club had won five straight series from June 12-28, their longest streak in 2026.

**WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS:** The Astros are 9-5 in one-run games and 20-11 in two-run games...each of the Astros last eight wins and 13 of their last 14 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs.

**GET 'EM EARLY:** The Astros lead the AL in 1st inning runs with 63 runs scored in their 91 games...overall, the Astros rank fifth in the American League in runs scored (411), while the Rays check in ranking seventh in the AL with 396 runs scored.

**HEAVEN'S 27:** A year after the flooding that took place in the Texas Hill Country on July 4, 2025, a portion of the proceeds from today's Share2Care 50/50 Raffle will go to **Heaven's 27 Foundation**, which was established by the families of the 27 girls who lost their lives at Camp Mystic...the foundation's mission is to carry forward the spirit, generosity, and joy of these girls by funding scholarships, youth programs, and other charitable initiatives that reflect their values and passions.

**LAST NIGHT'S W:** Trailing 6-2 early, the Astros rallied back for a 10-8 win over the Rays which ended on a walkoff homer by **DH Yordan Alvarez** (3x4, 2HR, 6RBI) in the 9th...**2B Jose Altuve** (2x3, 3R) and **C Yainer Diaz** (1x4, HR, 2RBI) chipped in on the offensive side...**LHP Josh Hader** (0ER/1IP) pitched a scoreless 9th for his 3rd win of the season.

**WALKOFF FIREWORKS:** **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit his second career regular season walkoff homer last night, with the other also coming on the Fourth of July in 2022 vs. KC...he is the first player in MLB history with two career walkoff homers on July 4.

**FIREWORKS ON THE 4TH:** The Astros have won on the Fourth of July for nine consecutive seasons (since 2016), which is the longest active streak in the Majors...per Elias, only three other teams in Major League history have won nine consecutive game on July 4th, the Indians (13 straight, 1916-1923), the White Sox (14 straight, 1934-1941) and the Pirates (9 straight, 1901-1905).

**TODAY'S TELECAST:** Peacock and the NBC network will televise every game across Major League Baseball today, including the Astros-Rays game from Houston...**Todd Kalas**, **Doug Waechter**, and **Julia Morales** will be on the call for Peacock today.

**ALL-STAR ALVAREZ:** Major League Baseball announced yesterday that **DH Yordan Alvarez** was voted by the fans as the starting designated hitter for the American League All-Star team...this marks the fourth All-Star selection for Alvarez (2022-24, 2026) and the second time that he has been voted as a starter (also in 2024).

**MVP-CALIBER:** **DH Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid first half to his season, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.078), OBP (.433), SLG (.645), RBI (67), and total bases (207)...additionally, he ranks first in the AL in extra-base hits (45), first in homers (29), first in hits (104), first in runs (62), second in batting average (.324), and fourth in walks (59).

**THE LONG BALL LIST:** **DH Yordan Alvarez** has hit 199 career home runs, needing just one homer to become the sixth player in franchise history to reach the 200-homer plateau.

**RIDING THE LAMBO:** Today's starter **RHP Peter Lambert**, who was a minor league free agent signing this offseason, has posted a 4-1 record in his last seven starts dating back to May 24, which ties him for fourth in the AL in wins in that span...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan.

**PEN PALS:** Since May 15 the Astros are 27-19 thanks in part to their bullpen, which has posted the lowest ERA in the AL in that span at 2.63 (51ER/174.1P)...since that date, that group has been led by **LHP Josh Hader** (0.64 ERA), **LHP Bryan King** (0.89 ERA), **LHP Steven Okert** (1.57 ERA) and **RHP AJ Blubaugh** (1.78 ERA).

**WHAT A RELIEF:** **LHP Josh Hader** is 3-0 with eight saves (in eight chances) and a 0.64 ERA (1ER/14IP) in 14 appearances...he has 22 strikeouts in his 14.0 innings with a .045 (2x44) opponent average and a 0.57 WHIP...Hader has not allowed a hit in seven consecutive appearances (7IP since June 21).

**OUT ON ASSIGNMENT:** The Astros have three starters on minor league rehab assignments:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) last started on Wednesday for Double A Corpus Christi at NW Arkansas (2ER/4.1IP), tossing 60 pitches (45 strikes)...he is expected to make his next rehab start on Tuesday.
- **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (rt. shoulder inflammation) last started on Wednesday for Triple A Sugar Land at OKC (1ER/4IP), tossing 60 pitches (41 strikes)...he is expected to make his next rehab start on Tuesday.
- **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) began a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday for the FCL Astros (0ER/3IP), tossing 25 pitches...he is expected to start today for Corpus Christi.

**LAST START, JUNE 29 vs. MIN:** Started the opener of this current homestand on Monday and allowed 4 runs on 5 hits through 5.2 innings with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts...retired 11 of the first 13 batters he faced in the outing prior to allowing back-to-back homers to **IF Royce Lewis** and **C Victor Caratini** with 2 outs in the 4th inning...allowed 3 total home runs in the outing, marking the most homers he's allowed in a start this season...recorded his 1st losing decision since May 17 vs. TEX.

**THE LAMBO:** A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has become a stabilizing force in the Astros rotation since making his season debut in mid-April...has recorded a quality start in 5 of his 13 outings, including 2 scoreless outings...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 6 of his 13 starts...among AL pitchers with 70.0+ innings pitched this season, Lambert ranks 7th in H/9IP (6.82) and 7th in opponent batting average (.209)...began the year at Triple A Sugar Land before being added to the Major League roster on April 17.

**STREAK SNAPPED:** Had his career-long 4-game winning streak snapped in his last start, spanning 6 starts from May 24-June 23...within the streak, he's posted a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...the streak ties as the longest by an Astro this season, also reached by **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (April 15-May 2).

**HIGH FIVE:** Has worked 5.0+ innings in 9 of his last 10 starts (since May 5) and 11 of his 13 starts this season...worked 5.0+ innings in a career-best 8 consecutive starts from May 5-June 17, surpassing a 6-game streak from Aug. 12-Sept. 10, 2023.

**SLIDER COMBO:** Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .171 average on the pitch (7x41)...is the 9th-lowest opponent batting average among AL pitchers this season (min. 40 batters faced)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

**TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO':** Logged the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory...matched his career-high with 7.0 innings, which he's now accomplished 5 times (last on June 17 vs. DET).

**WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS:** Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

**2025 SEASON:** Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

**ABOUT LAMBERT:** Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

**FAMILY TIES:** Has an older brother, **RHP Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

**LAST APPEARANCE (7/1 vs. MIN):** Worked the final 2.0 innings Wednesday night vs. MIN and struck out 3 batters while allowing 1 run on 1 hit (solo HR by **IF Luke Keaschall**)...tossed a season-high 34 pitches (24 strikes) and matched his season high of 2.0 innings for the 2nd time (also, May 3 at BOS)...were his most pitches since tossing 44 pitches on Sept. 27, 2023 at SEA.

**ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS:** Made his 349th career appearance on Wednesday vs. MIN, surpassing **LHP Joe Sambito** for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros franchise history...now trails **RHP Brad Lidge** (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (485) and 10th in innings pitched (358.2).

**TURNING THE PAGE:** Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.75 ERA (6ER/19.2IP) in his last 21 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind **LHP Steven Okert** (14-game streak).
