**RAYS REPORT**—The Rays conclude a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Astros (2-1), Blue Jays (3-0) and Twins (1-1, one to play) today at Steinbrenner Field...following today's game, they will travel to Houston for a four-game set with the Astros starting tomorrow night...are 6-1 in their last seven games, 8-4 in their last 12, 11-6 in their last 17, 13-9 in their last 22 and 18-13 in their last 31...have gone 9-5 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days (May 13-June 1) and 6-2 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19-June 8)...following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60.8%) will be on the road...have already played a majors-most 36 home games)...are at .500 for the sixth time this season...are second in the AL East, a season-high 7.0 GB the first-place Yankees (34-20)...have spent two days in first, seven in second, 18 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays season-high six-game winning streak came to an end with last night's 4-2 loss to the Twins...they had gone 44 innings without trailing before allowing a sacrifice fly in the 1st frame, their longest streak since June 3 (G2)-8, 2023 (48 inn.).
- ✦ Since the winning streak began on May 20, the Rays postseason odds have increased from 11.2 pct. to 28.3 pct., the second-highest mark among AL East clubs behind the Yankees (97.8%), according to FanGraphs.
- ✦ Tampa Bay is 8-3 over its last 11 games at Steinbrenner Field since May 9, tied for the third-best home record in the AL over that span...this comes on the heels of a 1-11 stretch at home from April 15-May 8.
- ✦ The Rays have hit 19 HR in their last 14 games since May 13, third in the AL behind the Angels (24HR) and Astros (20HR), and have out-homered opponents, 11-6, over their last six games.
- ✦ Despite allowing the opening tally last night, the Rays have scored first in four of five, six of 10 and 10 of their last 15 games compared to 12 of their first 39 games.
- ✦ The Rays are 12-9 in day games, going 10-4 after a 2-5 start...they have scored a combined 21 runs across their last two daytime affairs.

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Earlier today, the Rays added **C Matt Thaiss** to the active roster and designated **C Ben Rortvedt** for assignment...Thaiss will wear No. 34.

**WHAT'S AT STAKE**—With a win today, the Rays would:

- ✦ Improve to 5-1 in their last six rubber games after splitting their first four (2-2).
- ✦ Win a season-high three straight, five of six and eight of their last 11 series.
- ✦ Claim their fourth straight series win at Steinbrenner Field on the heels of a four-series skid at home from April 14-May 8.
- ✦ Improve to 4-0-1 in their last five series vs. the Twins since June 6-8, 2023, avoiding their first series loss to Minnesota since June 10-12, 2022 at Target Field.
- ✦ Record seven wins or more on a nine-game homestand for the fifth time in club history, first since going 8-1 from June 22-July 1, 2018 (Stats Perform).

**DAY N' NITE**—The cumulative offensive numbers at Steinbrenner Field have been notably higher in day games compared to night games:

**ALL ABOUT THAT BASE**—The Rays are 25-for-28 (89.3%) on stolen base attempts over their last 12 games, recording multiple steals in eight of those contests...their 73 SB on the season are tied with the Brewers for the major league lead and mark their second most through 54 games in franchise history, trailing 2009 (84SB)...**José Caballero** has been successful on eight straight stolen base attempts, bringing his season total to 17 SB, third in the AL behind CWS **Luis Robert Jr.** (21SB) and KC **Bobby Witt Jr.** (20SB)...since his April 19 major league debut, **Chandler Simpson's** 14 SB are tied for second most in the majors behind Robert Jr. (15SB).

**DAWG POUND**—**Brandon Lowe's** 10-game hitting streak is tied for the fourth-longest active run in the AL and ties the second-longest streak of his career (also: Aug. 9-10, 2020) behind a 12-game streak from April 22-May 8, 2019...during the current streak, Lowe is 14-for-35 (.400) with 3 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI, 3 BB and 4 SO...he has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games overall, slashing .404/.446/.769 (21-for-52) with 4 2B, 5 HR and 11 RBI...over that span (since May 13), he leads the majors in OPS (1.215), ranks second in average and slugging pct., and is tied for second in hits...his 40 total bases in that stretch are tied with LAD **Shohei Ohtani** for third most in the MLB behind CWS **Miguel Vargas** and LAA **Taylor Ward** (both 42).

- ✦ Last night, Lowe tallied his 112th career double, tying **Toby Hall** for 10th in franchise history...he is one double shy of **Randy Arozarena** and **Carlos Peña**, who are tied for eighth with 113 two-baggers.

**FROM A LAND DOWN UNDER**—**Curtis Mead** is batting .391 (9-for-23) with 1 2B, 3 HR and 4 RBI during a career-high eight-game hitting streak...the streak includes a run of three consecutive games with a homer from May 21-25—he entered that stretch with 2 HR in his first 90 career games.

**THE THRILL ON THE HILL**—Rays pitchers have allowed 3 ER or fewer in a season-high-tying five straight games (also: April 25-30), turning in a 1.40 ERA (45.0IP, 7ER) while holding opponents to a .172 (26-for-151) average...their last longer streak was eight games from Sept. 15-24, 2024...the staff has issued only two walks over the last three games after walking 13 batters in their previous two games from May 23-24.

- ✦ The rotation has permitted 2 ER or fewer in seven straight outings, their longest streak since a 12-start run from Sept. 11-24, 2024...Rays starters have a 1.13 ERA (32.0IP, 4ER) over their last turn through the rotation (5GS), allowing one or zero runs in four of five outings.
- ✦ The Rays bullpen has logged an AL-best 1.93 ERA (28.0IP, 6ER) over their last 10 games since May 17...the pen has registered a 2.90 ERA (133.2IP, 43ER) across the Rays last 40 games dating back to April 13, third in the majors behind the Astros (2.39) and Giants (2.68).

**TWINNING**—The Rays and Twins continue a six-game season series today, wrapping up the first of two individual series...the clubs will meet in Minneapolis from July 4-6...the Rays went 4-3 against them last season, claiming back-to-back season series wins (2023-24) for the first time since winning three straight from 2016-18 to improve to 11-3-3 in season series since 2007...six of the seven meetings were one-run games, and all three road games were decided in the final at-bat...eight of the last 11 matchups overall have been decided by one run dating back to Sept. 12, 2023, Tampa Bay's most one-run affairs vs. any opponent in that span...the Rays are 11-5 in the last 16 meetings dating back to June 12, 2022 and 7-3 in their last 10 home games against the Twins.

- ✦ **Josh Lowe** is a career .300 (18-for-60) hitter in 16 games against the Twins.
- ✦ Last season, **Yandy Díaz** went 3-for-7 with 1 2B against Twins starter **Pablo López**...**Brandon Lowe** was 2-for-5 with 1 HR and 1 BB.

**THIS DAY IN RAYS HISTORY**—On May 28, 2017, the Rays beat the Twins, 8-6, in a 15-inning, 6:26 marathon at Target Field, which remains the second-longest game by time in Rays history behind Sept. 20, 2013 vs. BAL (6:54)...**Evan Longoria** and **Logan Morrison** hit back-to-back homers in the 15th inning, becoming the third teammates in major league history to do so in the 15th or later, according to Elias...they joined HOU **Brian Hunter** and **Craig Biggio** (15th inn.) on June 16, 1995 at NYM and BOS **Frank Malzone** and **Dick "Dr. Strange" Stuart** (15th inn.) on June 11, 1963 at DET.

**TODAY'S START**—**Drew Rasmussen** will make his 11th start of the year and eighth at Steinbrenner Field in today's series finale...marks his 61st career start (110th appearance) and 29th at home (55th appearance)...has a 12.0 scoreless inning streak...has earned the win in back-to-back starts for the first time since April 3-9, 2023...is looking to win three straight starts for the second time in his career (last: Aug. 14-25, 2022)...has a 1.59 ERA (17.0IP, 3ER) in his last three starts...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Earned his second straight win after firing six scoreless innings in a 3-1 win over the Blue Jays on May 23 at Steinbrenner Field (W, 6.0IP, 4H, OR, 2BB, 3SO)...retired seven straight batters to open the game before working around back-to-back base hits in the 3rd...allowed a pair of two out baserunners in the 4th and allowed the first two batters to reach in the 5th, but stranded all four runners...concluded the outing by retiring the side in order on only nine pitches in the 6th frame...threw 43 of his 76 pitches for strikes and limited Jays hitters to a 3-for-12 (.250) clip in at-bats ending with his four-seam fastball, tallying all three of his strikeouts on the pitch.

★ The Rays have won each of his last two starts after going 1-6 in his previous seven from April 6–May 11.

**TWINS TALK**—Today marks Rasmussen's fifth career appearance/second start opposite Minnesota...he made one appearance against them last season, working scoreless 7th and 8th frames while fanning half of his batters faced in a 2-1 win at Tropicana Field on Sept. 3, 2024 (2.0IP, 3SO)...his lone start against the Twins came on June 10, 2022 at Target Field, when he departed midway through the 5th inning after allowing a career-high seven runs, including a career-high three unearned runs after a **Harold Ramírez** fielding error.

★ He is 4-3 with a 3.82 ERA (61.1IP, 26ER) in 20 career appearances (11GS) against AL Central opponents...this includes a 3.06 ERA (50.0IP, 17ER) in the 11 starts.

**LOCKED IN**—Rasmussen's 12.0 scoreless inning streak is tied with three other pitchers for the second-longest active streak among MLB starters, trailing PHI **Zack Wheeler** (26.2IP)...he has recorded back-to-back scoreless starts of 6.0 IP or more for the second time in his career, joining April 3-9, 2023...Rasmussen has thrown 81 and 76 pitches in those outings, becoming the second Rays pitcher to record consecutive scoreless starts of 6.0 IP or more on 81 pitches or fewer, joining **Zach Eflin** from April 15-20, 2024.

**DAYTIME DREW**—He has pitched to a 1.71 ERA (21.0IP, 4ER) in four day starts, recording a 0.86 WHIP and 19 strikeouts against three walks...min. 100.0 IP, Rasmussen's 1.91 career ERA (117.2IP, 25ER) in day games is third-lowest mark by any pitcher since earned runs became a statistic in 1913, trailing **Brendan Donnelly** (1.68), who pitched for five clubs during his seven-year career (2002-10) and CLE **Emmanuel Clase** (1.83)...he has held opponents to a .174/.217/.249 (58-for-333) with a 0.78 WHIP over his 20 career starts in day games...in 40 nighttime starts, he has posted a 3.22 ERA (195.2IP, 70ER) and a .233/.279/.361 (171-for-735) opp. slash line with a 1.10 WHIP.

**MAY FLOWERS**—He has made 18 career appearances (12GS) in the month of May, pitching to a 6-3 record and a 2.30 ERA (70.1IP, 18ER) with a .193 (49-for-254) opp. average, the lowest over any calendar month in his career...his six wins are tied with September for his most in any month...this year, Rasmussen is 2-2 with a 2.53 ERA (21.1IP, 6ER) across his four starts in May.

**HEAT CHECK**—In 21 appearances (13GS) since the beginning of the 2024 season, Rasmussen has thrown fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 90.5 pct. of the time...min. 500 pitches, only PHI **José Alvarado** (98.6%), NYY **Tim Hill** (95.2%), TOR **Jacob Barnes** (94.9%) and BOS **Kenley Jansen** (91.6%) have higher fastball usage rates over that span.

★ Opponents are hitting .201 (35-for-174) against his fastballs in 2025, including a .145 (8-for-55) clip against his cutter.

**BEST OF THE BEST**—Min. 250.0 IP, Rasmussen's 2.70 ERA (330.1IP, 99ER) since debuting with the Rays on June 19, 2021 ranks third in the majors behind CLE **Emmanuel Clase** (1.91) and NYY **Max Fried** (2.56)...over that timeframe, he also ranks second in the AL in opp. slugging pct. (.323) and opp. OPS (.588), third in home runs per 9.0 IP (0.65), and fourth in opp. on-base pct. (.265) and WHIP (1.03).

★ Rasmussen (3.00 ERA) is one of 13 active major league pitchers with 300.0 IP or more and an ERA of 3.00 or better in his career...he is one of four to accomplish the feat while starting in at least half of his appearances, joining LAD **Clayton Kershaw** (2.51), TEX **Jacob DeGrom** (2.52) and NYY **Max Fried** (2.94).

**POWER OUTAGE**—With a home run allowed to **Tim Tawa** in the 5th inning in his start on April 24 at AZ, Rasmussen snapped a homerless streak of 66.0 IP dating back to May 6, 2023...it marked the sixth-longest streak in franchise history, trailing runs by **Alex Cobb** (82.1IP, 2014), **Jake McGee** (76.0IP, 2013-14), **Alex Colomé** (69.0IP, 2015-16), **Scott Kazmir** (68.0IP, 2007-08) and **Roberto Hernandez** (68.0IP, 1999-2000).

★ Rasmussen did not yield an extra-base hit in 21.2IP from March 31–April 24...per Stats Perform, his streak with 0 XBH was the longest by a starting pitcher to begin a season in Rays history, and tied for second longest by any Rays pitcher with **Kyle Farnsworth** (21.2IP) in 2012...it trails only **J.P. Feyereisen** (24.1IP) in 2016...it marks the fourth-longest streak by a Rays starter at any point in a season.

**MR. RELIABLE**—Rasmussen threw 5.0 IP or more and allowed one or zero runs in each of his first four starts of 2025, tying **Tyler Glasnow** (2021) for the longest season-opening streak in franchise history...it marked the second-longest streak of his career at any point in a season, trailing a five-start run from April 27–May 18, 2022...was also the longest streak by a Rays pitcher since **Shane McClellan**'s five-start streak from June 20–July 13, 2022...he joined TOR **Chris Bassitt** as the only major league pitchers to accomplish the feat in each of his first four starts of 2025.
