FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and San Francisco Giants play the finale of a season-ending three-game series today at Oracle Park as the Redbirds conclude their regular season on the West Coast for the 4th time in history (1958, 1960, 1962, 2024) ... St. Louis is 3-2 on its six-game road trip through Colorado (2-1) & San Francisco (1-1).

EARLY BIRDS: The last Cardinals game in the Pacific Time Zone with a scheduled first pitch as early as today was Sept. 10, 1997 at 12:05pm Candlestick Park (L 7-6 in 10 inn). - Elias

• The Cardinals and Giants once played doubleheader before noon local Pacific Time on July 4, 1984, before The Beach Boys performed a concert at Candlestick Park ... Dubbed by manager Whitzey Herzog as the only Cardinal to be awake at the scheduled 10:05 a.m. first pitch, starting pitcher **Ricky Horton** allowed two runs over 7.0 IP for the win in the opener; Willie McGee doubled twice in the 5-1 win in the finale for the twinbill sweep.

THAT'S A WRAP: The Cardinals are 71-60-1 all-time on the final day of the regular season (26-28-0 on the road) since 1892 ... Today marks the 7th season that the Cardinals have ended regular seasons against the Giants franchise (4-4), 3rd time in San Francisco (1-1), but only the first in the Expansion Era with the expanded 162-game schedule:

- September 30, 1928 at Polo Grounds V: L, 2-4
- October 3, 1943 at Sportsman's Park: W, 5-4
- October 1, 1944 at Polo Grounds V (DH): L, 6-5 and W, 10-6
- September 28, 1958 at Seals Stadium: L, 7-2
- September 27, 1959 at Sportsman's Park (DH): W, 2-1 & W, 14-8
- October 2, 1960 at Candlestick Park: L, 8-2

COMEBACK CARDS: St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the NL Central Division, 1.0 game behind 2nd place Chicago ... The Cardinals have finished with a winning season for the 23rd time since 2000 and 84th since joining the National League.

• Since 1913, St. Louis has experienced six 90+ loss seasons (1913.

9/29 at SF2:05 p.m. 1916, 1976, 1978, 1990, 2023), and then finished above .500 every year following: 81-72 in 1914; 82-70 in 1917; 83-79 in 1977; 86-76 in 1979; 84-78 in 1991; and 82-79 in 2024. - Elias

· After its 71-91 finish last season, St. Louis has improved by double-digit wins for the 33rd time in franchise history (excluding 1981-82 and 2020-21) ... Their 13-win gain (thru 161 games from last season) is tied for MLB's 4th-best improvement.

THE CITY BY THE BAY: St. Louis leads San Francisco by a slim 363-362 margin in the all-time series since the Giants moved from New York in 1958 ... The Cardinals have won the season series over the Giants for the 9th time since 2013.

LONGBALL LORE: Paul Goldschmidt (22 HR) and Alec Burleson (21 HR) are the top two home run leaders for the Cardinals.

- If 37-year-old Goldschmidt leads, he would become the oldest to pace St. Louis in homers since Roger Connor did it in back-to-back seasons during the 19th century in 1895 (8 HR at age 38) and again in 1896 (11 HR at age 39).
- If Burleson homers once today to tie Goldschmidt, it will mark the first time left-handed batters led or shared the team lead in home runs in consecutive seasons (w/ Nolan Gorman, 27, in 2023) since Ray Lankford (19 in 1994 and 25 in 1995).
- If Burleson homers twice to pass Goldy and lead St. Louis, it will mark the first time left-handed batters outright led the team lead in homers in consecutive seasons since **Stan Musial** (10 seasons in a row from 1948-57).

STEAK DINNER: Alec Burleson's team-leading 75 RBI this season is the fewest total to lead the Cardinals since 1986 when Tommy Herr & Andy Van Slyke shared the team lead with 61 runs batted in ... The only other Cardinals with the same or fewer team-leading RBI are George Hendrick (69 in 1984) and Ted Simmons (75 in 1976). - Elias

SOUTHPAW HIT LEADERS: Brendan Donovan is the first left-handed batter to lead St. Louis in hits since Jason Heyward (160 in 2015), while Donny's 161 hits are most by a Cards left-handed batter since Matt Carpenter's team-leading 162 in 2014.

SAN FRANCISCO CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt made his MLB debut at San Francisco (Aug. 1, 2011)...singled in first career PA off **Matt Cain** (Aug. 1, 2011)...homered off **Tim** Lincecum for first MLB home run (Aug. 2, 2011).

Jordan Hicks was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd Round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2018-23).

Nolan Arenado's brother, Jonah Arenado, was selected by San Francisco in the 16th round of 2013 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons (2013-19) in the Giants organization.

Willie McGee played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond..played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...resides in Hercules...worked as an asst. coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, CA.

Hayden Birdsong was born in Mattoon, III...pitched at Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, III.

Nolan Arenado and Matt Chapman were high school teammates at El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA...In 2009 as a senior shortstop, Arenado's backup was Chapman, who only played shortstop when Arenado pitched.

Cardinals Bullpen Coach Julio Rangel was the Giants Minor League Pitching Coordinator in 2018.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Keith Hernandez** was born in San Francisco, CA...graduated from Capuchino High School in San Bruno, CA.

Late Hall of Famer Orlando Cepeda played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (1966-68)...in 1967, was NL All-Star, NL MVP and won the World Series...traded by the Cardinals to Atlanta for Joe Torre (March 17, 1969).

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City and resides in Danville, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004... played college baseball at UC-Davis (2005-07).

Giants Special Asst. Will Clark played in 51 games in his final season (2000) with St. Louis...slashed .345/.441/.621 in eight Postseason games.

Duane Kuiper is a graduate of Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, III.

Cardinals broadcaster Ricky Horton made his MLB debut at San Francisco (April 7, 1984).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Matt Morris pitched two seasons in San Francisco (2006-07).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Tommy Herr played 32 games for the Giants during his final season (1991).

Cardenales broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played parts of four seasons with the Giants (2007-10).

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** is a native of Santa Rosa, Calif. who also worked for Oakland.

Athletic writer **Katie Woo** is a native of Vacaville, Calif...previously covered the Giants, 49ers, & Warriors for NBC Sports Bay Area & California.

TODAY'S GAME

- Rookie right-handed makes his 3rd start and 4th appearance of the season and his MLB career. The Cardinals have won all three games he's appeared in this season.
- Facing his second straight National League West opponent on this road trip and the first for the California native to face a team from his home state.
- Is the only Cardinal in franchise history to earn a win as a starter and then as a reliever in his first two career appearances. Elias
- Made his Major League debut vs. Texas (July 31), hurling 7.0 innings of one run ball for the victory as the Cardinals won 10-1.
- Earned a win in his 2nd Major League appearance, a 3.0-inning relief job to close out a 10-5 win vs. Pittsburgh (Sept. 18).
- Was the second Cardinal to make his Major League debut against the Texas Rangers, but the first to start a game as a pitcher. Michael Blazek was the other, coming in relief at Busch Stadium on June 22, 2013 in a 4-2 loss.
- First Cardinals pitcher to throw 7.0+ innings and earn the win in his Major League debut at home since Jason Simontacchi vs. Atlanta on May 4, 2002 at Busch Stadium II (7.0 IP, 2 ER).
- First Cardinals pitcher to throw 7.0+ innings with 1 ER or less in their debut since Michael Wacha vs. KC on 5/30/13 (7.0 IP, 1 ER) and first to do so and earn a win since Tyler Lyons at SD (7.0 IP, 1 ER) on 5/22/13.
- First Cardinal to allow no runs through 5.0 frames in his first MLB start since **Austin Gomber** at CIN on July 24, 2018 (6.1 before allowing first run...**Daniel Ponce de Leon** also did so the day prior at CIN on 7/23/18 7.0 IP, 0 ER).
- Became the 8th to make his MLB debut with the Cardinals in 2024 and the 6th pitcher.
- Posted a 9-8 record with a 4.02 ERA in 27 starts at Memphis (AAA). Posted a career-high 138 strikeouts to lead the Redbirds and an International League leading three complete games, tied with lan Mejia (Braves) for the minor league lead upon recall. Ranked 5th in MiLB with 150.0 innings pitched.

LAST TIME OUT

• Did not factor into the decision for the first time in three appearances. Pitched 5.0 innings allowing three runs on four hits with his first home run allowed as the Cardinals rallied for a 7-3 win.
